 - **no more than three** items under A) Teams, Groups and Instrumental Classes, B2) Interest Groups, B3) Religious and Service Groups and B4) Art Groups

Form 2 to Form 5

1. Students should choose
 - **at least one** but **no more than two** items under B2) Interest Groups, B3) Religious and Service Groups and B4) Art Groups
2. Students may participate in
 - A1) School Teams but team selection is at teachers' discretion;
 - A2) Uniform Groups and A3) Instrumental Classes

Form 6

1. Students should choose
 - **no more than two** items under B2) Interest Groups, B3) Religious and Service Groups and B4) Art Groups;
2. Students may participate in
 - A1) School Teams but team selection is at teachers' discretion;
 - A2) Uniform Groups
