Producing a high quality school magazine is no easy job, especially for one which is mainly prepared by students who have no previous experience in publishing. I need to thank the editorial team for their endeavor, and teachers who have given them valuable advice and guidance.




Visit from Primary Schools



Sports Report

The Inter-class Swimming Gala was held in a sunny and hot weather this year. Our team members could achieve HKSSF standards in most of the events. Wu Ho Ming (2D), our C Grade swimmer, did particularly well. He took three gold medals and broke three CSK swimming records (50 m Free, 100 m Free, and 50 m Butterfly) on the same day. Mr. Ronald Chan was the Guest of Honour for our Swimming Gala this year. Mr. Chan, who graduated in 1987, was a member of our swimming team. His sons are also members of our swimming team. Therefore, Mr. Chan has contributed to our school, and particularly the swimming team, for two generations.

Our team members continued to perform well in the Inter-school Swimming Championships 2010-2011 in the following month. Most of our swimmers not just achieved standards but many of them were also qualified for the Finals. Eventually, our C Grade Team was Champion and our A Grade Team was 3rd. Unfortunately, our Overall Position was 3rd again although our Team Total improved from 197 to 219 this year.

The Inter-class Cross Country races followed closely our Swimming Gala as usual. A total of 148 students, 5 old boys and 8 teachers took part in the races. However, the performance times of our team members were not satisfactory. Eventually, our Cross Country teams could not get any trophy in the Inter-school Cross Country Championships this year, and we were only 8th in the Overall result.

The Inter-class Athletics Meet started really early this year. Day one was held on 30th September 2010. However, due to the Severe Typhoon Megi, which attacked Hong Kong in October, Day two

of our Inter-class Athletics Meet had to be rescheduled to 7th April 2011. This also affected the selection of team members (particularly for the C Grade Team) very much. We had recruited some C Grade boys who were interested to join our team training but the inter-school results were still not encouraging. Our C Grade Team was only in the 16th place. Even though our B Grade team took the Champion title, our Overall position was still 5th and we had to stay in Division Two for another year.

Our A Grade Football Team took the 2nd place in the Inter-school Football Competition this year but the B and C Grade teams could only get the 7th and 8th places respectively. After the victory in Division Two last year, our Basketball teams had to play against much stronger opponents in Division One this year. As a result, we were only 10th in the Overall but we can still stay in Division One.

Comparatively, our racket sport teams had better performances this year. Our A Grade Badminton Team took the 2nd place in the Interschool Badminton Competition. Besides, Cheung Kong Shing (6B) took the 3rd place in the Hong Kong Schools Jing Ying Badminton Tournament 2010-2011. Our C Grade Table-tennis Team took the Champion title in the Inter-school Table-tennis Competition this year. With the combined efforts of the A and B grade team members, our school was eventually Champion in the Overall and will be promoted to Division One next year.

We continued to have good results in the Inter-school Tenpin Bowling Competition this year. Our Bowling Team improved from the 6th to 4th place this year. Besides, Lee Yi Hin (5B) was Individual 6th in the competition.



For other open competitions, Chan Chun Yuen (1D) took part in the 2010 ISI Skate Hong Kong Competition, and took the Champion title in the Solo Compulsory FS2 Competition (12-13) and 2nd place in the Freestyle 2 Competition (11-12). Tang Ho Man (2D) took the Champion titles in the Hong Kong Junior Outdoor Archery (C-D Grade) Competition and the Hong Kong Archery Association Junior Indoor Archery Knock-out (C-D Grade) Competition. Yu Tsz Wai (7A) continued to achieve very good results in orienteering competitions again. Besides taking the 2nd place in the Elite Category of the Hong Kong Junior Orienteering Championships 2010-2011, he also took three Champion titles in the CrossStraits cum HK & Macau (海峽兩地暨港澳) Orienteering Championships 2010 for the Junior Boys M18 100 m, Sprint, and Long Distance categories. Chun Sing (3E) was 3rd in the Secondary School Taekwondo Competition 2011.

Last but not least, another event worth mentioning this year was the Standard Chartered Hong Kong Marathon 2011. Altogether, we had 61 students, teachers, old boys, and parents running in CSK team uniform in the 10K and Halfmarathon races. Mr. T. L. Lee, our new Principal, also ran in the 10K race with us. A lot of thanks must be given to Mr. Theodore Lai for sponsoring our team uniform. Besides, we must also thank the CSK Old Boys' Foundation to for sponsoring the Pun-choi Dinner held as a gathering function after the race. We also had our internal prize presentation ceremony during the dinner. We are looking forward to having more CSK members running in our team uniform next year.







President's Report 2010-2011

6th April 2011

A new group of executive committee members were elected at the annual general meeting held in CSK on 27 June, 2010, for the term of 2010/2011. I am honored to be elected as the President of our Association. Together with my fellow committee members, we will endeavor to contribute our greatest effort to serve all the CSKOBA members as well as to assist the School in its development for the benefit of our CSK boys.

During our term of office, CSK has ventured into the post-40 era. By turning a new page in the CSK history, we see change and new challenges ahead. For a start, I would like to take this opportunity to extend my warmest welcome to our new principal, Mr. Lee Ting Leung, who has taken up office in CSK since last September.

I would also like to congratulate our expresident, Mr. Lau Po Wah Chris (1980), who has commenced his duty in CSK as School Supervisor from January 2011 through the appointment by Brother Patrick together with the Lasallian Education Council (LEC). Mr. Chris Lau has been a member of the LEC for many years and actively involved in the management of the school as well as the CSKOBA.

In order for the CSKOBA to operate more efficiently and systematically, we have identified three key tasks for the coming years:

- Enhancing communication among members and improving the CSKOBA membership database;

Both the CSKOBA and the PTA have joined the school in organizing many events such as the Form 1 New-comers' Day, Open Day for Primary Schools, career talks by Old Boys etc. We also co-organized the 2011 Spring Outing to the Hoi Ha Wan Marine Park. Nearly 250 parents, students, teachers and Old Boys took a day out in the picturesque Sai Kung in early March.

As stated in the report issued by the Education Bureau after the External School

Alumni representatives, Brothers, and principals from all the Lasallian secondary schools in Hong Kong attend the lunch meetings. Furthermore, our school representatives including myself attended the 40th Anniversary Dinner of Chong Gene Hang College held in the Kowloon Bay Convention and Exhibition Centre on 22 January 2011.

The CSKOBA, following the practice in previous years, has donated ten scholarships to CSK students to commend their distinguished academic achievements during the school year. The prizes were presented on the Speech Day in November 2010.

On 10 December 2010, a group of energetic Old Boys headed for Nansha Golf Club, PRC to compete in the 2010 CSKOBA Golf Tournament. Many of them have enjoyed this golfing event so much that they become regular participants every year. I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate Mr. Leung Suet Lung, William (1988) winner of the Brother Herman Cup (2-Day Gross Champion) and Mr. Yuen Yung Hon, Dennis (1982), winner of the Brother Eugene Cup (2-Day Net Champion), as well as other Day Champions and Runners-ups. The prizes, together with those for the winners from the CSK Standard Chartered Marathon Team, were presented during our annual gathering held at the School Hall on 12 March 2011.

Nearly 300 Old Boys, parents, and current as well as retired teachers took part in the annual

gathering with "Pun-choi" being served at the School Hall. The hall was filled with alumni from the 60s' to the new millennium. Towards the end of the evening, a special session called "Surprise of Thanks" was given to Mr. Or Chun Ching, vice principal, who earns great respect in the school and will retire after his nearly 30 years of teaching in CSK at the end of the school year. The gathering finished in high CSK spirit with the singing of the two school songs - the old one (1969-1975) and the new one. (since 1976). The old school song is now renamed the school sports song. With its marching rhyme and cheering lyrics, the school sports song should add a desirable push when cheering for the school teams in competitive sporting events.

To enhance communication among members, we have set up a CSKOBA facebook linkage. We are now testing our revamped website and its integrated membership database. I am confident that after the launch of the new website, members can access more up-to-date information about the Association as well as our Alma Mater.





He took the bronze medal for high jump in the inter school athletics meet. Every year thereafter John represented the school mainly in football (which was his favourite sport) and athletics. In 1973 he was a member of the B grade team when we won our first athletics trophy in the inter school division two competition. Again in the following year he helped CSK win promotion to division one athletics when he won the 400m Hurdles event and was second in the 400m. While in form 5 John won the A grade inter class cross country race and also took the silver medals for the 400m Hurdles and 400m events in the Hong Kong Junior Athletics championships. His athletic career with CSK continued even while he was in Form 7 when he again took silver medals in his favourite events the 400m Hurdles and the 400m.


