# History

In April 1967 the Chan family approached the Jesuits to ask if they would be interested in taking over the running of a secondary school and move to the building which they intended to contribute in memory of their father, Mr. Chan Sui Ki, a successful merchant and one time President of the Tung Wah Group of Hospitals -- a well known charitable organization in Hong Kong. Not wishing to accept the offer themselves, Rev. Fr. Cronin, the Provincial, proposed the offer to the La Salle Brothers. Eventually, it was decided that La Salle College accept the offer and transfer the existing evening school operating in La Salle College to the new building. The evening school under the supervision of Brother Herman Fenton operated from 3:00 until about 8:00 p.m. The government would provide the site and an 80% subsidy. The Chan family would donate H.K. \$500,000

In December, 1968 work began on the site. In April 1969 the foundation stone was laid by the then Director of Education, Mr. Gregg, and on September 3 the school moved into the classroom block -- 951 students and 34 teachers all together. All the while work on the school hall and the laboratories, library, Geography Room, Art Room, etc. and the Brothers' Quarters (which unhappily provide an accommodation for only four) continued until December 12 when the Building Authority inspected the completed building in preparation for giving the final occupation permit. The official blessing and opening ceremony was performed on February 12, 1970 by Rev. Fr. Colombo P. P. and the Hon. J. Canning, Director of Education, respectively.

# Supervisor's Message



The 2013 school year started in an unusual context in which the community focus was centered at the student assembly in Admiralty. The student movement inevitably marked its significance in education history in Hong Kong. The Lasallian Education Council held its meeting and issued an instruction to Lasallian schools stating that, in essence, "...Hong Kong Lasallian Schools have all along been promoting a wholesome moral and civic education to their students, training them for good, responsible citizenship both locally and globally.....Our schools may, at their discretion, wish to incorporate some appropriate elements of national education which fits in with their overall plan for Moral and Civic Education/Religious Studies. There is no need for any of our Lasallian schools to introduce a separate subject for national education.". As such, CSK will continue to adopt a balanced approach towards the teaching of Moral and Civic Education as well as Religious Studies.

I would like to welcome the four new teachers who join us this year, namely Mr. Au Chi-kwong (Maths), Mr. Chan Pak-lam, Bosco (English, RS), Mr. Li Ka-kit (English, RS), and Mr. Lam Shun-hong (Visual Arts). I hope they will find CSK an exciting and warm environment to work in.

Our school achieved satisfactory overall results in the 2012 HKDSE Examination. Ku Ka Chun and Cheung Kwok Yuen both achieved the most outstanding results in CSK. I would like to congratulate the students who obtained satisfactory results. Meanwhile I would also like to encourage the other students to make more effort to achieve good results. The HKDSE Examination is still in an initial implementation stage and needs input and comments from the public on its format and quality. We expect to see some fine-tuning of the DSE in the near future.

The School Management Committee, the present school management body, will turn into the Incorporated Management Committee on August 31st, 2013. The new IMC will have a new membership composition, with expanded school sponsoring body managers, and an independent manager. Representatives from teachers, parents and Old Boys will be duly elected by respective organizations. The new IMC will have a legal status in its own right when it becomes fully operational in the new school year.

From the year 2012 the school has revised its focus to the following areas: academic achievements, student character development, and fostering an English-rich environment. I would like to stress that these are the key concerns that CSK will focus on for some time.

After a razor-thin loss in last year's athletics competition, we came back this year with even better overall results. Naturally we are promoted to Division 1 again in the coming year. Our target is to keep us close to the forerunners and stay in the top division.

Once again I need to thank all the students and the teachers who have put tremendous effort into the production of this wonderful magazine for our students to keep as a record of part of their student life.

# HKALE 2012

## *Hong Kong Advanced Level Examination (HKALE)*

61 students sat for the HKALE 2012 and obtained a total of 60 credits and distinctions. There were one student attaining 3 distinctions, two students attaining 2 distinctions and three students attaining 1 distinction.

Eight subjects had a passing rate higher than the territory figure. The passing rate of Chinese Language and Culture was 98.4% (HK 94.3%) and that of Use of English was 98.4% (HK 69.0%). Students also achieved a good pass result of 91.2% in total subject entries with 20.2% being awarded credits or distinctions. Outstanding students are:

# HKDSE 2012

## *Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSE)*

179 students sat for the first HKDSE examination. Results of all different levels of attainment were better than the territory ones e.g. Level 4 or above 35.6% (HK 31.8%), Level 3 or above 70.4% (HK 59.1%) and Level 2 or above 91.1% (82.4%).

Percentages of Level 4 or above in 10 subjects, including all core subjects, were higher than the territory figures e.g. Mathematics Compulsory Part 52.5% (HK 33.8%), Mathematics Module I 72.7% (HK 43.3%), Mathematics Module II 69.6% (HK 56.1%), Biology 69.4% (HK 40.7%), Information & Communication Technology 62.5% (HK 25.1%).

The first motto that I will share with you is self-learning. Personally, I have been a true beneficiary of self-learning, and am here encouraging you to become one. The last HKCEE in 2010 did not catch my eyes at first sight of the news until I noticed that an 63-year-old lady did take part in the exam. I guess most of you would share the same queries as I do: "Why did the old lady bother to study at such an old age? What compelled the older lady to excel?" The answer is simple as that: The lust for learning is age-independent. From my 35-year working experience, I can guarantee you that the knowledge acquired at school is far from adequate to meet the demand of your future career and life. We live in a world that is changing in such an amazing speed that is well beyond our imagination. Some years ago we were still struggling with new models of notebook computers. Nowadays we have already switched to new computer technologies like iphones and ipads. We must all adapt and equip ourselves well. Otherwise, we would unquestionably fall behind the fast-paced world.

Thanks to the school which offers comprehensive teaching on mastering the skills of self-learning. However, you are reminded to practice it from time to time. Learning without actual practicing serves nothing at all. Prominent teachers ever lived on this earth always advice to invest our efforts to study on our own because once we are able to fully conquer our will, we will be able to conquer many other things as well.

There are well-proven and convincing grounds which fully support the habit of self-learning. People learn anything best when they are able to construct their own learning and lessons. Let me give you an example to illustrate this. A kid spent endless time on a video game and finally ended up beating it. The steps and skills taken to beat the game are profoundly drilled in his mind because it was he who discovered and grasped these techniques. Self-learning shows the way to a brand new experience. Whenever you discover things on your own, you often find out something strangely new and fascinating.

Therefore, starting from today, you need to stay vigilant about the currency of your knowledge and ask yourself every day: Am I really up to speed? Or am I still stagnating intellectually? Or even worse, am I falling behind? Am I still learning? Or am I just doing the same stuff every day?



The second motto is: Communication skills. Most of people overlook the significance of communication skills and in fact this turns out to be one of the most crucial elements of success. Communication can be an organization's strongest partner or its worst enemy.

We need to appreciate that communication is a very complicated process which involves individual perceptions and interpretations of meaning. Say, when I am talking to you all now, there are at least four concurrent conversations taking place: (i) What I say. (ii) What I mean by what I say. (iii) What you hear. (iv) What you think I mean by what I say. With this level of complexity, it is crystal clear that we definitely can't presume our ability to communicate properly. Any problems arise in any one of the above would lead to communication failure.

Poor communication can be detrimental and lethal - it can result in a loss in efficiency, financial implications and even fatalities. For instance, in hospitals, pharmacists misread or can't read the doctor's handwritten prescription instructions, thus increasing the risk of committing a potentially fatal error. On the contrary, good communication could always bring the whole issue to life. I guess most of you still vividly remember the impressive slogan of "Change" by Barack Obama which won him the President in the United States presidential election in 2009.

Given the importance of proper communication, I appeal to you all to think about how frequent you communicate with others in a day. We write emails and SMS, facilitate meeting, devise presentation, negotiating with others etc. We can spend most of the entire day communicating and we communicate almost without stop. So, how can we provide a huge boost to our performance through communication? How can we make sure that we communicate in the clearest and the most effective way? Indeed you are the one who should dig up the answers, and with these answers in your mind, you should sharpen and polish your communication skills right away to meet the challenges in the days to come.



Finally, I come to the last motto: innovation and creativity. I previously read a famous quote by Albert Einstein and it went something like that “When I examine myself and my methods of thought, I come to the conclusion that the gift of fantasy has meant more to me than my talent for absorbing positive knowledge.” It made a lasting impression on me as it pinpointed the importance of creativity. Indeed, when I look back at my engineering career over the past thirty-five years, I can hardly deny that innovation and creativity is the pathway to success. In fact, Hong Kong will not be able to compete with our neighbours in terms of scale without creativity.

Before I further proceed, I intend to share with you an inspiring story. On one occasion, a fresh graduate attending a job interview noticed that there was a long queue of 20 persons lining up before him. He immediately brainstormed a creative idea in which he approached the clerical officer registering the interviewees and handed a piece of paper to her for passing to the interview board. He wrote “Please do not make a decision to employ any person before you interview the 21st Interviewee.” on the paper. At last, he really got the offer because of his creative idea. You may have the talent to make you stand out. You may have the intelligence to outshine your competitors. You may have the work ethic and competitiveness to excel. But the real

question is: do you have the creativity and innovation to continuously come up with big ideas so as to boost up your performance? Imagination fuels your viewpoint which in turn puts you in touch with a bigger picture. The bigger picture permits more possibilities and generates more sounded and brilliant suggestions. However, if you have a limited creativity—a limited concept of what is possible, then performing in a truly exceptional manner at any level is almost improbable. Performing at one's best always starts with innovation and ends up with the formulation of an idea—nothing more and nothing less.

I am sure that most of you must have built jigsaw puzzles before and no doubt experienced the dreaded missing puzzle piece scenario. One may appreciate that life is simply a puzzle with missing pieces of important elements like self-learning, communication and creativity. You must try hard to look for these missing pieces in order to complete the whole puzzle and make your life and career shine!

And remember that you're not just kids. You are the major pillars of Hong Kong. Whether we fall behind or race ahead our neighbours in the coming years is up to you. Hong Kong's future depends on you!

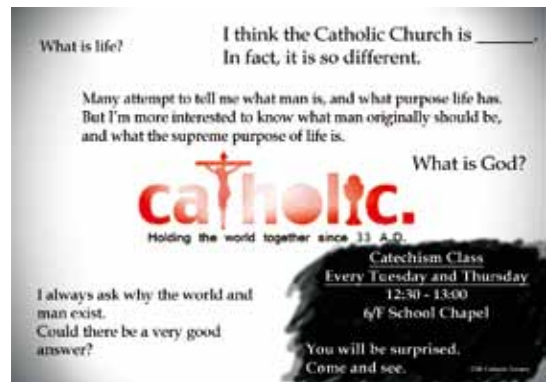
### Prayer Services

# Sports Report

The CSK PE Department and our boys were almost out of breath due to the extremely tight inter-class sports schedule in late September 2012. We had our Inter-class Swimming Gala on 21st September 2012 at Tai Wan Shan Swimming Pool. As in the previous years, this was our first inter-class sports event. Ms. Venus Lai, the Chairlady of the CSK PTA 2011-2012 was our Guest of Honour. St. Joseph's College set a new record in the 4 x 50 m Invitation Relay with an excellent performance time of 1:46.67.

Our Swimming Gala was closely followed by Day 1 of our Inter-class Athletics Meet. Almost one week before the first school day of our new school year, we were informed by Wanchai Sports Ground that the dates and venues for our Inter-class Athletics Meet needed to be rescheduled due to emergency repair work on the sports ground. Eventually, the dates of our Inter-class Athletics Meet were moved forward to 25th September 2012 and 19th October 2012 respectively.

For the first time, Day 1 of our Inter-class Athletics Meet was held in Tseung Kwan O Sports Ground and Day 2 was held in Tsing Yi Sports Ground. Both students and teachers needed some adaptation due to the traffic and the facilities in the two sports grounds. Eventually, we finished the competitions with some outstanding results, and Mr. C. K. Law, our former Vice-Principal as well as our Guest of Honour presented the prizes to the winners.

The inter-school competition results were not very encouraging in the first school term. Our Swimming Team which usually brings home some trophies could only get a few individual medals in the Inter-school Swimming Championships this year. The best position achieved was 5th by the B Grade Team. The A Grade Team was 13th and the C Grade team came 6th. Our overall position was 6th.

The Inter-school Cross Country Championships were held really early this year. The Division One competition was held on 8th October 2012 at the Hong Kong Golf Club. We had finished our Inter-class Cross Country competitions just one week before the inter-school races. Furthermore, we had our own C Grade race on 27th September, 2012 which was two days after Day 1 of our Inter-class Athletics Meet. It was then tightly followed by our B and A Grades races which were held on 28th September, 2012. Our A Grade Team was actually quite strong this year and should have had a very good chance of bringing home a trophy and some medals from the inter-school competitions. Unfortunately, our team members did not perform very well on the race day and could only achieve a disappointing 8th place in the A Grade race.

The inter-school results of A Grade Badminton, Basketball, and Table-tennis were also not satisfactory. It seemed that we disappointed in the first school term until our A Grade Football Team brought home the first trophy for this school year. Although we lost to Wah Yan College, Kowloon by 1:2, we beat Salesian School by 1:0 and took the 3rd place in the A Grade competition.

For individual events, two of our team members, Pong Lap Yan (5A) and Tang Ho Hin (4A) were selected to represent Hong Kong to play in the Inter-port Badminton Competition because they both made the final eight in the Hong Kong Schools Jing Ying Badminton Tournament Singles Competition. Ng Wang Lok (1C) was also selected to represent Hong Kong to play in an international baseball competition held in Taiwan in October, 2012.

Starting from the second school term in 2013, our team members had much improved performances in the inter-school sports competitions. Our Basketball Team took 4th place in B Grade, C Grade, and Overall Inter-school Basketball Competitions. Our B Grade Football Team also took 4th place in the Inter-school Football Competition. Furthermore, our B Grade Badminton Team took 2nd place in the Inter-school Badminton Competition. We lost narrowly to Ying Wa College by 2:3 and missed the Champion title.

Another great encouragement was obtained by the Athletics Team. Having been relegated to Division Two in 2009 and missing promotion to Division One last year by losing 5.5 points to West Island School, our Athletics Team eventually showed that we are good enough to play in Division One. Although we were 4th Overall after Day 1 of the Inter-school Athletics Championships, we moved up to the 1st place, leading the school in 2nd place by 21 points after Day 2. With the support of our students, teachers, parents and old boys, our team members continued to try their best on Day 3 and obtained more points for our school in order to be promoted. Eventually, we took the Champion titles in A Grade, C Grade, and Overall and will be promoted to Division One in the coming inter-school sports season. A lot of thanks should be given to our team members who trained very hard throughout the year, and to those who came to support our team. The old boys alone, who came to cheer for our team, occupied a whole column of the spectators' stand in Wanchai Sports Ground on Day 3 of the Inter-school Athletics Championships.

Finally, the results of the table-tennis team were a little bit disappointing. The B Grade Team qualified to play in the Final Round but could not proceed any further and the C Grade Team lost all their matches. Eventually, we took second last place and most probably we will be relegated to Division Two next year.

On the whole, the inter-school sports results were satisfactory this year, particularly after the beginning of 2013. We came 9th in the Boys Section of the BOCHK Bauhinia Bowls Award this year. We hope that our team members can continue to work hard and play hard whether in studies or sports participation in the years to come.

Before concluding this report, I regret to announce that Mr. C.T. Leung is leaving CSK at the end of this school year. Mr. Leung has been working in our P.E. Department and coaching our Basketball Team since 2004. Under his coaching and leadership, our Basketball Team has achieved a lot in the inter-school basketball competitions. We hope that Mr. Leung will find great success in his new job.

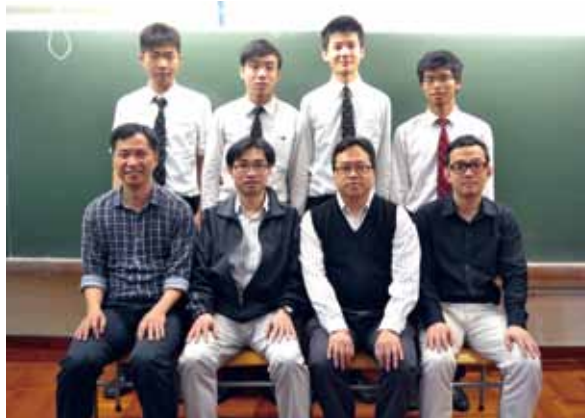

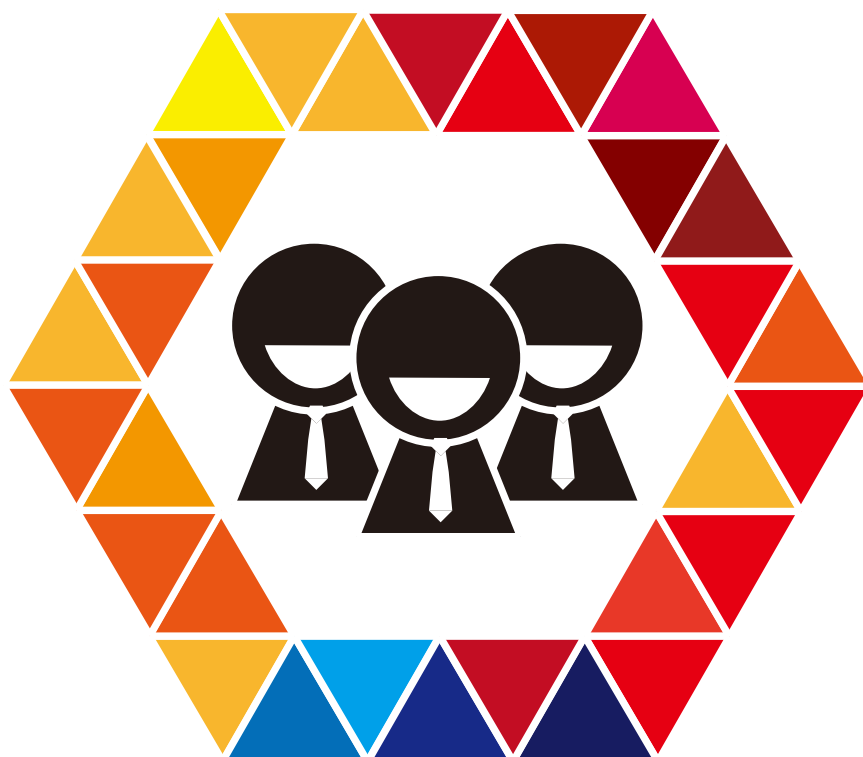

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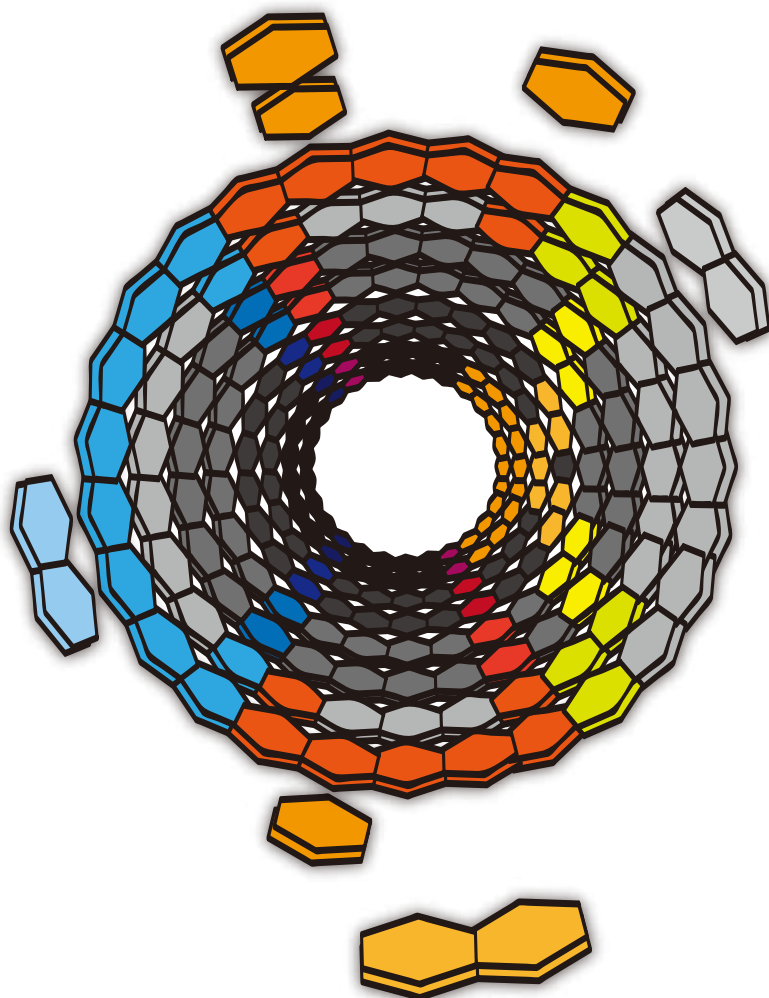

就個人層面而言，社交網絡會令我們，特別是自制能力較低的小孩和學生沉迷於網上世界。據一項統計結果顯示，超過一半學童瀏覽社交網絡的時間超越溫習以及其他休閒活動的時間，可見沉迷社交網絡會影響我們日常生活。

而在社交網絡上，人與人的溝通和聯絡雖然方便快捷，但就是因為過於便利，令我們只顧在社交網絡上作日常交際，減低了人與人直接接觸和交流的機會，甚至在社會上形成了一層無形的隔膜，把各人的交流封存了。

社交網絡對社會也帶來弊端，例如網絡欺凌。由於在社交網絡上，匿名的發言往往不用負責任，導致一些人在社交網絡上肆意以言語攻擊他人。以早前的「港女五百」為例，事情被網友廣傳後，有人不斷在事主的「臉書」上留言批評她，令她刪除「臉書」帳戶，更有人到她的婚禮表達反對她的行為，令她飽受困擾，這就是

社交網絡帶來網絡欺凌的例子。

而社交網絡為我們帶來最新的資訊，但這些資訊中，有機會出現錯誤或不當的訊息。這會令我們接受了錯誤的訊息，影響我們的判斷。當多數市民被錯誤資訊誤導時，判斷錯誤足以影響社會的運作。由此可見，社交網絡傳播錯誤訊息對社會的弊端。

其實社交網絡改善了我們的生活，但亦有其弊，我們要在兩者中取得平衡，才能成為一個精明的服務使用者。

## 社交網絡的利與弊

近年，社交網絡發展日益蓬勃，在我們身邊，差不多每一位都擁有社交網絡的帳號。究竟社交網絡對我們個人以及社會有甚麼利處，又有甚麼弊處呢？

「社交」顧名思義是指人與人在社會上的交際，而「社交網絡」就是將人與人的交際放在電腦網絡上進行。目前最廣為使用的社交網絡包括「臉書」、「谷哥」、「微博」等。當中，單是「臉書」的使用人數達十億人，稱它為全球「第二大國」亦毫不過份。由此可見，社交網絡是何等普及。

社交網絡的出現為我們帶來了莫大的利處。在個人層面而言，社交網絡的出現

令人與人的溝通、交際更便利，例如想與地球另一端的親友溝通，郵遞需時長，費時失事；而電話通訊則有時差的限制，還要繳付昂貴的長途電話費用。社交網絡令天各一方的親朋好友能不受限制，隨時隨地聯絡對方。

另外，社交網絡是一個讓我們抒發個人感受的渠道。在社交網絡上，我們可以自由發言，抒發感情。而網絡上的朋友可以給予發言者安慰，或是一些解決難題的辦法，這樣令我們在遇困難時，有朋友為我們分憂。

而在社會的層面上，社交網絡能充當召集和溝通的工具。先以去年下旬，反國

民教育為例，最初社會大眾不清楚、不瞭解運動的意義和目的，但運動的大推手：學民思潮不斷在社交網絡上發表不同的評論文章、資料，最終成功號召市民上街，迫使政府撤回國民教育科。

再以近期貨櫃碼頭工潮為例，碼頭工人以往曾多次召集工人罷工，但因工人工時長，見面時間短，令他們互相溝通有難度，往往不能組織罷工，更莫說要市民了解他們的慘況。但他們於去年成立了「臉書」的專頁：「碼頭的辛酸」，成功令社會大眾關注到貨櫃碼頭工人待遇差，薪酬低的問題，以及令市民支持他們向無良的僱主追討辛勞成果，由此可見，社交網絡可以有效地，令我們接觸社會上的不同資訊，亦能成為號召和溝通的渠道。

但是，鏡子有兩面，社交網絡亦有利弊兩方面。以下我亦以個人和社會兩方面說明社交網絡的弊處。

直到我看見放在桌上的小蛋糕，旁邊有張紙條寫道：「搏盡，無悔，共勉之！媽媽字。」我的心事像一下子被戳穿了，眼淚不由自主的湧下來。

從前的我凡事過於勉強自己，事事都追求完美，生活如是，學習更如是。為了迎接文憑試，只顧死背爛讀，與其他人的來往越趨減少，失去了人情味，以致整個人變得功利，更忽視了身邊朋友家人的鼓勵和支持，劃地自囚，壓力倍增。也許生命本來是一條充滿荊棘的道路，失足跌倒不重要，更重要的是懂得重新爬起，慢鏡重溫自己當日曾付出的努力，再三回味，學會反思才會進步。而悔恨，相信不會再停留在心中，因為我們都已盡心盡力，再沒有任何藉口了。「失敗乃是成功之母」一句，所言甚是。

戰事之成敗與天時、地利、人和有  
着直接之關係。孫子特別指出將士兵敗

主謂之疑，必亂！」

敗之六道：「以寡敵眾曰走，卒強  
吏弱曰弛，吏強卒弱曰陷，懟而自戰曰  
崩，軍無綱紀曰亂，不能料敵曰北。」

故孫子強調「慎戰」。「勿擊堂堂  
之陣，毋邀正正之旗。」以眾欺寡，戰  
則勝。以寡敵眾，戰則負，逃則保，故  
三十六計中走為上計，先自保而後求  
勝，切不可愠而致戰，君子報仇，不爭  
朝夕。

現今流行一術語：「輸人不輸陣」，  
筆者試以孫子兵法之精神，將之延續下  
去：

## 既戰佈其陣

戰事既已發生了，應善於用兵：間諜、哨兵、前鋒、主力、側翼、後衛、補給等，各司其職，互相配合，信息相通，軍力互補便可產生倍數之軍勢及威力。

採取主動：靈活用兵，因時制宜，攻則衝其虛，眾則擊其寡，退則敵不能追，戰則敵不能避，守則敵不能攻。

謀算敵人：形敵而我無形，盡量知悉用間、謀算敵方之虛實、強弱之處，挑動而知其機動性，虛張聲勢而探其必救之處，角力而知其虛實。同時間，己方之軍力，虛實，分佈，委積一定要保密，或虛則實之，實則虛之，令敵人困惑，不敢冒進。

以逸待勞：先處戰地而待敵者逸，後處戰地而趨戰者勞。用兵貴速，以迂為直，以患為利，後人發，先人至，創

造時勢，先敵而至可佈其陣。據地利而用天時，以逸待勞，以靜待譁，以近待遠，以飽待飢，「毋邀正正之旗，勿擊堂堂之陣。」打有把握之仗。

實戰行軍：「兵以詐立，以利動，以分合為變。」兵不厭詐，於我軍有利者才行動，靈活用兵，以分擾敵，以合制敵之虛，攻其不備，出奇制勝。

行軍六法：「其疾如風，其徐如林，侵略如火，不動如山，難知如陰，動如雷震。」行軍靈活，善攻能守，萬眾一心。

軍爭八要：「高陵勿向，背丘勿逆，佯北勿從，銳卒勿攻，餌兵勿食，歸師勿遏，圍師必闕，窮寇勿迫。」審時度勢，避免敵方之暗算而中伏。

知地之利：「圯地無舍，衢地合交，絕地無留，圍地則謀，死地則戰。」簡單來說，在沼澤之地不可駐紮，在多國

交界之地則要結交，在險要之絕地不可逗留，在受包圍之地則要設謀奇攻，在無生路可走之死地則要決戰。

九變之術：權宜時勢、敵我勢力，不可墨守成規而喪失先機，故途有所不由，軍有所不擊，城有所不攻，地有所不爭，君命有所不受。

## 已戰鼓其氣

孫子曰：「殺敵者，怒也。取敵之利者，貨也。」怒者，士氣也。貨者，獎賞也。軍隊破敵，重其形與勢。

兵形者：員之足、器之利也。

軍勢者：士氣也。一鼓作氣，再而衰，三而竭。氣勢強則克敵，氣勢弱則軍心散渙，無心作戰。

以現代物理學來解說：  
戰鬥力 = 軍形 × 軍勢

田單火牛陣用的是牛

敵眾我寡時則擾敵、間敵、分敵、形敵而我無形、我專而敵分。製造時勢，以石投卵，先勝而後戰，戰無不勝也。

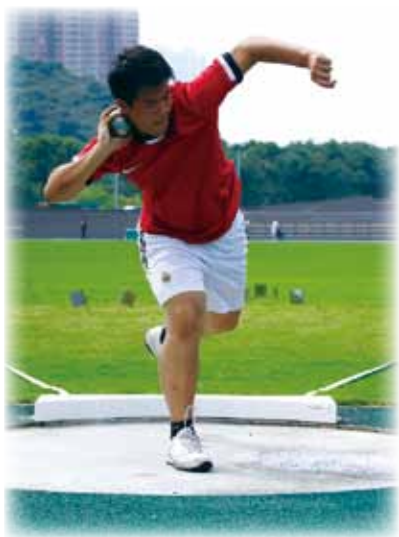

老一輩開始退下來，始終要有人填補空缺。我建議對航海有興趣的同學投身這一行，可以在香港或者外國進修。如在香港讀可選擇 IVE（即現時的香港專業教育學院）或者理工大學。相對來說，理工大學的收生要求會較高。我認為航海也是一個好的職業，假若考取遠洋船船長牌，便可以有很多選擇，不一定是領港員。現在的科技也比較先進，發生意外的機會也較低。航海可以訓練一個人的獨立，船長要處理船上發生的所有問題，學會的東西也會較多，如滅火、救生等，總括來說是一個好職業。」

正如領港員有一些青黃不接的問題，陳師兄認為新一代有一些不足之處：「我認為現在的年青人抱怨的事會較多，可能是政府支援不足，可能是父母未能給予所需，不像以前的社會。因為以前的社會實在是太艱辛，所受的資源可謂極之有限，很多東西都要靠自己爭取。現在父母給予子女的一定比以前多，但我感覺現在有一部分年青人經常抱怨，卻不會自我反省，反省自己為何不努力一點走自己的路呢？」

問到師兄對於成功人生的看法，可見他的人生觀很正面：「開心、可以做到自己想做的事，這就是成功。因為人生並不是一個很長的時間，你除了要照顧好自己的工作，還有婚姻、家庭、子女，有很多事要照顧。在照顧這些事情的日子當中，你自己過得開心與否是相當重要的。如果過得開心，這已經是成功的一半。還有做自己想做的事，例如學樂器，但有很多條件不容許你這個想法，例如金錢、時間不許可。假如能做到自己想做的事，又不影響家庭，我覺得已經很完美。」

最後師兄寄語水記師弟：「不要抱怨太多，珍惜自己擁有的東西，努力做好自己。開心與否，成功與否，很多時候都是取決於自己，不要太依賴別人的幫助。如果學校有需要我幫忙的地方，我也會回來幫忙。」

# 水上的紅色

## 陳德基師兄專訪

陳德基，一九八五年於本校畢業。  
現時於香港領港會擔任高級領港員。

問到陳師兄是否初回母校，原來他很熱心於學校的活動：「我畢業後已回來過很多次。我以前在這裡當童軍，也參與了不少童軍的活動，有時也會受到雷健泉先生的邀請回校幫忙。最近的一次盆菜宴，我也有參與。」

提及於母校的回憶，他對於往事感到快樂：「陳瑞祺給了我很多好的回憶，因為這是一所好學校。她不像一些名牌要拿很多獎很多好成绩的學校，但這裡的校風、氣氛都是好的。同學間、師生間的感情都很融洽。我在校時當過學長，在童軍也代表過二零五旅出外比賽，回想起也是一些開心的回憶。」

師兄於八五年畢業，畢業後的經歷亦不是一帆風順：「因為我當時會考的成績只屬於中游，家裡又負擔不起我讀私立中學，於是我早上送飛機餐，晚上在夜校

讀書，重讀了一年。那年重讀的成績稍有進步，其間，聽說理工大學有一個航海系課程，入學資格門檻低，五科合格便可入讀該課程。當時我聽見「航海」二字，感覺很新鮮，於是抱著一試的心態去報讀，開始了航海的第一步。」

說到領港員日常工作的職務、資格和一些點滴，其實十分精彩：「香港有很多遠洋船出入，我們的工作就是帶領這些船隻停泊碼頭或者把船隻拖走，就如代客泊船一般。做領港員的基本資格要有一個遠洋船的船長牌，考牌後就可以回來等機會，有人退休或招聘人手時便可應徵。領港員的工作每天都是一個挑戰，因為船有很多種，大小小，重重輕輕，目的地也不同，每一次都是一個新體驗，不會太死板。對我來說是一件有挑戰性和有趣的工作。」

領港員正面臨人手短缺的問題，師兄會否建議水記仔入行呢？「我很贊成學生投身航海業，這一行正開始缺乏人手，當

記：師兄為何你會投身酒店業的呢？

鄒：當時會考成績不理想，十七歲畢業後看到酒店業不多人修讀，再加上我個人健談，在家人的鼓勵下報讀現在的（NE）（香港專業教育學院）課程，即當時的工業學院，取得酒店及飲食文憑。然後我任職過醫院和飲食業，不斷進修，當了八年酒店業工作，又轉職至教育，教授酒店及飲食業課程，最後又返回酒店工作。

記：能不能簡單講解你工作範圍和職責？

鄒：表面上我的職責是負責培訓員工。先說人事上，我要分配人手，那裡不夠人，我就要調配人手。務求提升生產力和服務質素，處理文書是我重點的工作，例如：整理教材、統計、內部評估。酒店中員工約一百八十人，每人都有一個檔案，每人都要有記錄，記錄他們的工作時數。同時做統籌審核，評審，看一些統籌需求的文件和場地，都是我的工作範圍。

記：如果師弟想投身酒店業，有什麼建議給他們？

鄒：首先，不要想到酒店業好理想，這個想法是錯誤的，因為酒店業是無法預計的，不可怕辛苦。現在社會和以前很不同，以前我讀書年代很多東西都是自己發掘，同時投身酒店最基本要有熱誠，也就要主動去發掘。同時體力的消耗也是很基本的，所以欲投身酒店要有心理準備，每天工作九至九個半小時，有超時工作甚至工作十二小時。因為酒店業要「追更」，要有心理準備處理突發事情，所以態度一定要正面。要有輪班的心理準備，不應計較，你做多了一定有得著的。另外，知識有很大幫助，讀書豐富知識。以往只需服務客人，令他們開心，但現在要求更多，更多文書的工作。總結而言，如果想投身酒店業的話，一定要刻苦，肯犧牲和努力讀書，豐富自己。

記：最後有沒有說話寄語師弟？

鄒：知識改變命運，這一句說話我讀書時也不信，但當投身社會後就切身感到這句話的重要性。由於現在社會富裕，青少年沒有比以往更刻苦，由我中五會考畢業後，這句說話便成了我的座右銘。最基本要珍惜自己任何讀書的機會，如果當年會考後我不繼續進修，今天便不會回來接受訪問了。雖然讀好書不一定擔保你能找到好工作，但你不讀好書便一定找不到好工作，這句說話雖然很俗套，但事實證明這是事實。讀書時不相信這句說話，到將來便很自然明白。在此，我寄語師弟們應把握進修學習的機會，不要浪費光陰！

## 鄒啟泰師兄專訪

記：師兄你是那一年的畢業生？

鄒：我是一九九六年的文科畢業生。

記：這麼久沒有回來母校，感覺有什麼不同？

鄒：判若兩地，現在的校園，比起我讀書的年代設備更齊全更寬敞。當年的校園給我的印象是質樸的灰磚牆；現在，校內設施完善，十分現代化。回來後感到學校與時並進，因為畢業後搬到將軍澳，很少回來母校的關係，感覺截然不同，但仍然感受到一份家的溫暖！

記：讀書時期有沒有什麼特別難忘事？

震，為此，有人邀請吳師兄參與「五二二步行籌款」，參與五次的步行籌款活動，在他工作時間上是不容許的，故此，吳師兄便放下工作，投身參與義工服務。

不僅如此，當時大學還邀請吳師兄為大學生擔任歷奇導師，這使他日後以自由身的身份去賺取收入，維持生活。吳師兄仍言道：儘管日後的收入及工作機遇是不穩定、不肯定，足夠生活即可，這樣反之令他有更多的時間服務更多的人。

## 堅持信念

「能力所及，能幫多少就幫多少」，是吳師兄一直堅持的信念。他認為四肢健全、接受高等教育已不比別人差，現在是回報社會，自己有足夠的能力，何樂而不為？再者，吳師兄認為自己能夠幫到人，其實即表示自己比其他他人幸福。問到吳師兄有否想過放棄社工或義工的工作，他說如此刺激和有意義，使他找不到放棄的理由。而且，每次活動後的滿足感，讓他知道是值得的。

## 寄語「水」記

正所謂「施比受，更有福」，吳師兄不但沒有後悔過投身義工服務，更坦言義工一職給了他很多的機會去接觸不同的人 and 事，利用自己擁有的經驗來幫助有需要的人，這點吳師兄認為是非常值得和有意義，因此吳師兄更寄語「水」記的師弟，要用功讀書之餘，更要在課餘時間多嘗試，尋找自己的生活目標，努力發奮，豐富自己的人生，令自己活得更精彩！

## 背後辛酸

身為社工，需要隨時代不斷進步、自我增值，十八般武藝集於一身當然不可缺少。非洲鼓、歷奇、話劇、啦啦隊、書

讀書的心態

在每個人的學習生涯中，中學階段無疑是最重要的。「我現在還記得中學時背誦

過的詞語，但是已記不清大學時特意學習的詞彙。」李先生笑說。同時，他認為老師與學生的溝通很重要。因為與學生的溝通中，可以慢慢地灌輸和分享讀書的重要性。然而，他亦指出學生的決心才是最重要。假若學生並不願意付出努力，即使有再多改善也只會是徒勞無功。

「當年，自己也是受一位表兄弟的決心所感染，才會放下在銀行那份穩定的工作，離鄉別井，到外國苦幹及完成大學學位。」李先生回憶道。的確，不論任何事也好，最重要的是自己的心態。如果一個人是重視自己的學業成績，無論如何，他會盡自己的努力來達到。所以，如果想自己的成績更上一層樓，第一步先要勇敢地提昇自己及接受挑戰：調整自己的心態。

## 學習方法

成績退步，並不只是我校面對的問題，而是每個人及每間學校都需要面對的

情況。李先生認為面對這種狀況的時候，學校應扮演一個更積極的角色，鼓勵學生努力學習，讓他們明白到學習的重要性。同時學生亦應力爭上游、自強不息，學習不同的事物。

最後李先生以五個C的理論來寄語我們，希望我們能為母校增光、為自己作好準備，為日後踏上更光明的大道。

**Change**：首先要改變的，就是要提升自己。要改變對讀書的態度；要相信讀書是一件樂事，而不是苦差。所謂「樂是樂事學，學是學事樂」不樂不是學，不學不是樂。「換句話來說，我們應該快樂地學習。論語也曾說，子曰：「學而時習之，不亦說乎？」明白了，就要改變上課時懶散的態度，改變一切令自己不能全神貫注溫習的事情。當我們獲取豐富的知識時，我們自當充滿自信。有信心自然帶來滿足和快樂。

## 李振宇博士專訪

### 回校的感覺


我校已建成了四十多年，雖說不上有悠久的歷史，但亦經歷了許多變遷。然而，今天我們仍然在校的水記仔，若要得知建校以來的變化，與舊生對話或許會是一個最直接的方法。

時隔數十年，李振宇先生於去年（二零一二年十一月三十日）以頒獎典禮嘉賓的身份重回校園。對李先生來說最大分別無疑是校園內外的變化。因為李先生是陳瑞祺（喇沙）書院的首屆畢業生，當他還在校的時候，華英中學和基督教女青年會丘佐榮中學還未建成。整個紅燈山山頭除了我校之外，就只有一片片的荒地。從前附近的荒地都變成新的建築物，路旁的小灌木也變成大樹了。真是十年樹木，百年樹人。校園內的建築也由天然的灰色加添了不少色彩。
