MESSAGE OF HIS HOLINESS POPE FRANCIS FOR THE 30TH WORLD YOUTH DAY 2015

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God (Mt 5: 8)

This year we will reflect on the sixth beatitude: “Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God” (Mt 5:8).

The desire for happiness

The word “blessed”, or “happy”, occurs nine times in this, Jesus’ first great sermon (cf. Mt 5:1-12). It is like a refrain reminding us of the Lord’s call to advance together with him on a road which, for all its many challenges, leads to true happiness. Dear young friends, this search for happiness is shared by people of all times and all ages. God has placed in the heart of every man and woman an irrepressible desire for happiness, for fulfillment. Have you not noticed that your hearts are restless, always searching for a treasure which can satisfy their thirst for the infinite?

Blessed are the pure in heart...

In what does the happiness born of a pure heart consist? From Jesus’ list of the evils which make someone impure, we see that the question has to do above all with the area of our relationships. Each one of us must learn to discern what can “defile” his or her heart and to form his or her conscience rightly and sensibly, so as to be capable of “discerning the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect” (Rom 12:2). We need to show a healthy concern for creation, for the purity of our air, water and food, but how much more do we need to protect the purity of what is most precious of all: our heart and our relationships. Our hearts can be attached to true or false treasures, they can find genuine rest or they can simply slumber, becoming lazy and lethargic. The greatest good we can have in life is our relationship with God. I hope, dear young friends, this loving gaze of Christ will accompany each of you throughout life.

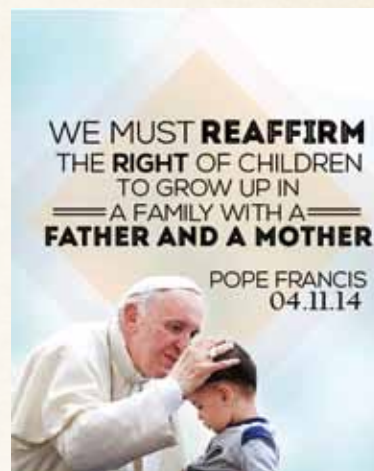
Youth is a time of life when your desire for a love which is genuine, beautiful and expansive begins to blossom in your hearts. How powerful is this ability to love and to be loved! Do not let this precious treasure be debased, destroyed or spoiled. That is what happens when we start to use our neighbours for our own selfish ends, even as objects of pleasure. Hearts are broken and sadness follows upon these negative experiences. I urge you: Do not be afraid of true love, the love that Jesus teaches us and which Saint Paul describes as “patient and kind”.

...for they shall see God

In the heart of each man and woman, the Lord’s invitation constantly resounds: “Seek my face!” (Ps 27:8). At the same time, we must always realize that we are poor sinners. We are all sinners, needing to be purified by the Lord. But it is enough to take a small step towards Jesus to realize that he awaits us always with open arms, particularly in the sacrament of Reconciliation, a privileged opportunity to encounter that divine mercy which purifies us and renews our hearts.

The Lord wants to meet us, to let himself “be seen” by us. I invite you to encounter the Lord by frequently reading sacred Scripture. If you are not already in the habit of doing so, begin with the Gospels. Read a line or two each day. Let God’s word speak to your heart and enlighten your path (cf. Ps 119:105). Encountering God in prayer, the reading of the Bible and in the fraternal life will help you better to know the Lord and yourselves. Never forget: God’s will is our happiness!

“Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God” (Mt 5:8). Dear young people, this beatitude speaks directly to your lives and is a guarantee of your happiness. So once more I urge you: Have the courage to be happy! May the maternal gaze of the Blessed Virgin Mary, full of grace, all-beautiful and all-pure, accompany us at every step along the way.

SUPERVISOR'S MESSAGE

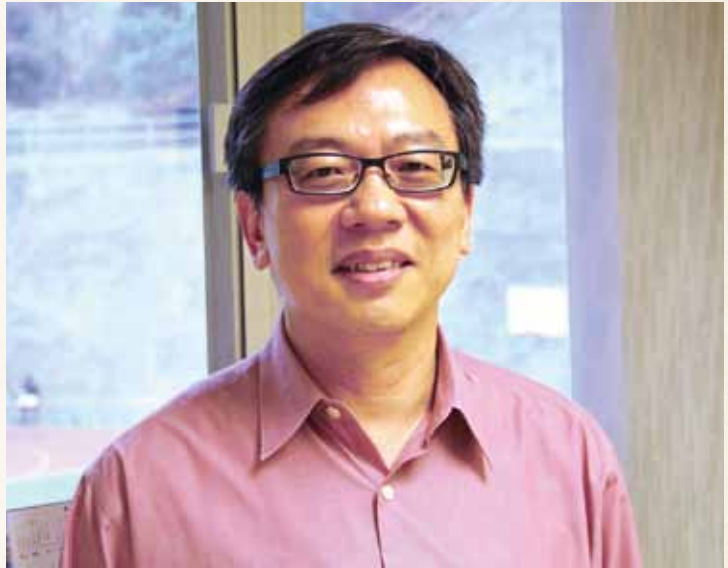
Following the recommendation of Brother Alvaro, former Brother Superior on the composition on Hong Kong Lasallian Education Council, which is an advisory body to the Sector Leader of Lasallian Family in Hong Kong, Brother Patrick has invited several new members to serve at the HKLEC, including two lady school supervisors. The new structure of the LEC connects the schools more closely to the LEC.

CSK, a Catholic school conducted by the De La Salle Brothers, strives to uphold and pass several Core Values advocated by the Church on students. We are committed to stress that search and desire for the "truth" is of utmost importance in our life. The wisdom to distinguish right from wrong, and good from evil prevails all other forms of knowledge. This is a virtue we have to keep throughout our lives. There is much more than wealth for one to live for a meaningful life, and the desire to quest for the truth keeps our spirit up.

Throughout 2014-15, CSK is celebrating its 45th anniversary of founding of the school by Brother Herman. Festive activities include an anniversary logo design competition, the open day, a grand dinner and a mass. The open day drew hundreds of visitors who came to familiarize themselves with CSK, and those who came back for a reunion with old friends. The open day is also a showcase of what CSK is offering and what we have achieved in 45 years.

More than 600 Old Boys, students, Brothers, parents, current staff and retired teachers, guests, and friends flocked to the venue for the 45th anniversary dinner on January 31st. Familiar faces and memories were once again recognised and treasured. Every participant left with a memento in hand and a fond memory in mind. We all look forward to the golden jubilee celebration after five years.

The Student Association organised a series of activities this year. From the Christmas Ball to the Variety Show, all these activities which attracted audience have demonstrated the ability and experience of our students in these extra-curricular activities. CSK is always maintaining academic standard as the

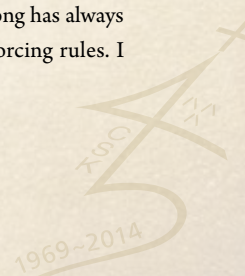


prime focus and providing extra-curricular activities as an important complement to our students' learning process.

Old Boys ranging from graduation in the 1970's to the 2000's and from various professions gave information about their own fields of expertise to students in small groups. Students had ample time to talk with individual Old Boys from different professions.

Mr KC Wong, our academic vice principal, is retiring this year after serving CSK for more than 20 years. Mr Wong has always been very kind to students yet stringent in enforcing rules. I wish him an exciting yet healthy retirement.



PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

2014-2015 marks the 45th Anniversary of CSK. It has been very eventful since we kicked off the celebration for the 45th Anniversary with the Opening Mass on 1st September, 2014. Other celebratory events include the Open Days, the Anniversary Dinner, the Thanksgiving Mass, and the Variety Show presented by the Student Association.

In line with our Lasallian spirit, the Organising Committee has chosen "Courage, Persistence, Empathy" as the theme for the 45th Anniversary. Embedded in it is the word "AIM". These traits are not some super natural powers but simple and basic human ingredients. Their impacts come only with time but they provide a strong foundation for our students to become confident leaders.



The celebratory events owe their success to the participation of staff, Old Boys, parents and students. Many thanks to them for the work, time and effort that they have put into these celebratory events. Anniversary is always a good opportunity to reflect on accomplishments and look forward to new challenges. 2014-2015 is the final year of the school development cycle. 2014-2015 is also a year of political unrest in Hong Kong. In a move seen as a curtain-raiser to the Occupy Central movement, students from universities and colleges staged boycott of classes in September 2014. To rally the college students, a student activist group also promoted class boycott among secondary school students. Some of our students joined the class boycott. We were glad to see them expressing their views in a rational and orderly manner. Participants gathered at the school hall and the lecture room. Staff and Old Boys took the opportunities to discuss the issues and share their views on civic mindedness with the students. After skipping lessons for two days, participants returned to the classroom and school resumed. Students should have learnt a lot during the class boycott, something that they can hardly get from textbooks.

The School Magazine reflects different aspects of school life. A big 'thank you' to the teacher advisors and members of the Editorial Board for producing this wonderful publication.

May our Lord Jesus Christ lead us and guide us as we move our way towards the 50th Anniversary.

SCHOOL 45TH ANNIVERSARY OPEN DAYS END ON A HIGH NOTE

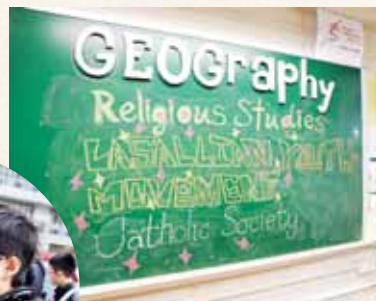

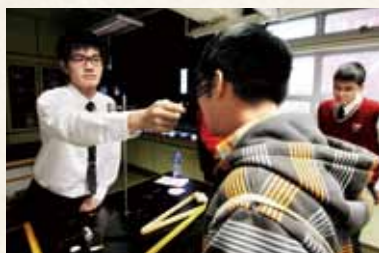

SUMMARY OF THE HOMILY GIVEN BY MOST REV. BISHOP STEPHEN LEE AT THE 45TH ANNIVERSARY MASS



Some seek happiness in food, in drink, in sex and in the quality of life. But sadly, they cannot find it. They do not know where it is. How many rich people, beautiful actors and actresses, with all the fame, committed suicide in the end? Some of them are involved in drugs and many scandals. These show us that it is not the right way to seek happiness.

Happiness is from the inside, from the hearts. That is why one of the visions of the school is “touching the heart”. This shows how important the heart is.

The second “No”

Happiness cannot be found in “pain-free” environment. We have to go through some sufferings, as taught by the Lord. We cannot grow up in an environment without difficulties, sufferings or pain.

The Gospel of the mass talks about “True Happiness” which is also called “the eight beatitudes” and “Be Happy Attitudes” by some spiritual authors as there are various translations.

What is “happy” to you? To many people, it is just a feeling. So, please earnestly ask yourself, are you happy? Are you happy with your family and your school? Are you happy to be a student, a son, a Catholic? Bishop Rev. Lee explained “happiness” in God’s words for us by concluding it into two “Noes” and three “Yeses”.

The first “No”

Our Lord taught us that happiness should not only be the pursuit of pleasure. It does not depend on who are you or what you own. Many people think that eating can bring them happiness. However, can people keep eating to sustain pleasure? No. The purpose of eating is to keep our health but not just for pleasure.

Recently, a parent sued the government because her daughter was hurt after tripping over and falling on the road during shopping. She said that the government should pave all the roads with carpets so that even if someone falls, he will not be hurt.

Most Rev. Bishop Lee also received a complaint from a parent in the Parents Association, claiming that the apples provided by the lunch box provider were too hard for her son to eat. She thinks that the provider should chop the apple into small pieces for the school children.

Can someone grow without pain or difficulty? No. If you want to seek happiness without pain, you will never find it.

The first “Yes”

Happiness comes from the fulfillment of the purposes in life. We should set targets, both short and long terms for all our actions.

If you enter the hall today, knowing that its purpose is to give thanks to God, you will find it meaningful and happy. If you do not know, you will be bored. Similarly, if you know the purpose of studying is acquiring knowledge to improve the human society, so as the Christian formation, you will enjoy it. Once Most Rev. Bishop Lee read an article about an injured soldier, he told the doctor to cure him so that he could go to the battlefield to fight for the country again as soon as possible. These are all about purposes.

The second “Yes”

We should help one another. The reason of setting community services as one of the goals of our school is because whenever we offer others love and care, we will be happy.

What will you do if one of your fellow students does not have enough money for lunch today? If you share half of your lunch box with him, you will be happy. Meanwhile, if you do social services, you will be happy too. However, if you only think about yourself, your health, your food, your drink, your study ... You will feel empty and unhappy. Therefore, happiness is found in caring for others.

The third “Yes”

The passion for God brings happiness. Our Lord taught us that

we have to be poor, pure and merciful. Why? God has shown Himself to us as an example and we have to act like him since we are made in God's image. If we act like Jesus Christ, we will be happy.

We should always remind ourselves the eight ways in the Gospel to keep ourselves happy. Always remember the two “Noes” and three “Yeses”. Do everything for God and follow our school motto, *Laus Deo Semper*, to praise God always. Through this, we can be always happy. Let's be happy in true Christian sense and see the blessing from God. Bless the future of the school.

10TH ASIA PACIFIC LASALLIAN YOUTH CONGRESS



The 10th Asia Pacific Lasallian Youth Congress (APLYC) was successfully held in Ipoh, Malaysia from 14th to 19th December, 2014, and its theme was “Revive the Spirit, refresh the world”.

Fortunately, Day Two of our Athletics Meet could be held on 10th October 2014 although we had to pack all the events in one day and all track events had to be conducted as straight finals. All Form 6 boys who took part in the 800m fun run received a medal as a souvenir to celebrate the 45th Anniversary of CSK. This year, we had great honour to have Mr. Sung Ka Chun, Gareth, our Old Boy team member, to present the prizes to the winners. Besides winning a lot of gold medals in the Inter-school Athletics (Division One) Championships for CSK in the 1980s, Mr. Sung has also set the Inter-school B Grade 400m record with an outstanding performance time of 52.19" and represented Hong Kong in many local and overseas competitions.

Results for the Inter-class Athletics Meet were not encouraging. Only a small number of inter-school standards could be achieved in the track events. The situation was a little bit better for the field events. So Chak Pong (2C) set a new record in C Grade high jump and also got two bronze medals in the Inter-school Athletics (Division Two) Championships held later in February 2015, one in high jump and the other in 100m hurdles. Having been promoted to A Grade and the weight of

the Javelin had to be increased from 600g to 700g, Li Ka Ho (5E) still got the bronze medal in the Inter-school Athletics Championships. He has also improved his performance from 39.73m in the Inter-class Athletics Meet to 50.09m in the Inter-school Athletics Championships, and renewed Tse Bun's CSK record of 46.70m which was set in 1985.

Two champion athletes who are also worth mentioning this year should be Lam Tsz Fung (5E) and Leung Chun Yui (3A). Lam Tsz Fung switched to the high jump event last year and with his persistent hard work with Mr. K. V. Vong, he was the champion in the Inter-school A Grade high jump this year. He has also improved his performance from 1.55m in the Inter-class Athletics Meet to 1.78m in the Inter-school Athletics Championships. Leung Chun Yui started to train very hard after his disappointing Inter-school Cross Country Championships performance in November 2014. He trained two nights per week with some Old Boys in Shatin Sports Ground, hoping to do much better in the Inter-school Athletics Championships. Eventually, after having got a slightly disappointing second place in the B Grade 1500m final on Day Two, he won the championship in the 800m final on Day Three. Moreover, with the combined efforts of other team members, he also got another gold medal in the 4x400m relay on the same day. On the whole, our B Grade athletics team performed very well and got the 3rd place in the team result. However, our overall result was only 6th and was not good enough to go back to Division One.

Our performance in the Inter-school Cross Country (Division One) Championships this year was again disappointing. We were 12th (out of 14 schools) in the overall and we were at the margin of being relegated to Division Two.

For the ball games, there were both laughter and tears. While our basketball team got the 4th position in A Grade, the 2nd in B Grade, the 2nd in C Grade and the 2nd in Overall and would be promoted to Division One next year, our football team was 16th in the Overall and needed to be relegated to Division Three.

For the racket games, both our badminton team and table-tennis Team did quite well. Our A Grade badminton team was 2nd in team position while our A Grade table-tennis team was the champion. With the combined results of B and C Grade teams, our table-tennis team was 2nd in the Overall, and would be promoted to Division One next year. For the Jing Ying tournaments, Tang Ho Hin (5A) was 5th to 8th in the Secondary Schools Boys section of the HK Schools Jing Ying Badminton Tournament (Singles) and with his teammate Pang Tsz Kiu (6D), they were third in the doubles of the Tournament. For

table-tennis, Tsang Ho Yin (5A) and Chuck Yik Fung (5D) were also third in the Secondary Schools Boys section of the HK Schools Jing Ying Table-tennis Tournament (Doubles).

Pon Wai Chuen and Wong Tak Shing, two Old Boys athletics team members, took part in the Taiwan International Masters Athletics Meet held in April 2015 with more than 50 other team members. Many of them were Hong Kong representatives in the 1980s. Pon was champions in the 800m and 1500m races for the 45-year age group while Wong was champions in the 400m and 800m races for the 50-year age group. The Hong Kong team was eventually champion in the men's category and 2nd in the women's category.

To celebrate the 45th Anniversary of CSK, our school organized two Open Days on 5th and 6th December 2014. Our P.E.

Department set a counter with some fitness testing items and an online quiz in the school playground. All of the activities attracted quite a lot of visitors and we gave them a copy of our newsletter as a souvenir.

Having stepped into the 46th year, there is still much that can be done by our P.E. Department in the coming years. We are looking forward to starting the PE elective classes for the HKDSE. Our future development and achievements in sports competitions and in the academic area can only be assured with the continuous support of our students, teachers, Old Boys, and parents.

Before concluding this report, I would like to thank once again all CSK students, teachers, Old Boys, and parents for their contribution to our P.E. Department and sports teams.

MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT OF OLD BOYS' ASSOCIATION



The Old Boys' Association had a busy year. We served the alumni community, helped current students, supported the school as well as the PTA and connected with the Hong Kong and international Lasallian families. It will be a long list if I talk about all our programmes but some are definitely worth highlighting.

Collaborating with the school in assisting our students has been a priority since I became the OBA president. This year, we partnered with the school to launch the brand new "My Career" programme, in which a Saturday afternoon was designated to interaction between alumni and F.5 students. We gathered 19 old boys from 17 different professions. They brought practical insider information of professions including industrial prospects, career advancing tips, what employers are looking for as well as the sweets and bitters in career park. Such first-hand experience would be valuable reference for our students in their choice of profession.

Being run for the 6th time, the Old Boys Mentorship Programme was revamped basing on previous experiences. Changing from camping to an on-campus mode provided a more vigorous atmosphere while keeping the content rich. More than 20

recently-graduated "young Old Boys" took up the role of mentors. They used invaluable experience to coach our soon-to-be graduates on matters concerning the public examination and further studies.

As for the gatherings, the highlight was the CSK 45th Anniversary Dinner. I headed the Organizing Committee which was comprised of Old Boys, teachers and parents. We worked closely together to prepare a banquet in which over 600 guests had a memorable time. Former principals and La Salle Brothers celebrated the event while Old Boys, coming in school uniform, had a warm reunion with retired and current teachers.

To bring old sportsmen "home" to meet their successors, the OBA held a series of sport gathering in school. We expanded in scale to include football, basketball and cross country. Through the friendly matches, Old Boys, current school teams and staff showed their ability and demonstrated CSK's great tradition in sport.

During the past year, the OBA has made significant progress in communication through the social media. Subscribers kept adding to our Facebook fan page. The number soared to 738 from 453 a year ago, representing a remarkable yearly growth rate of 63%. The average audience reached by each post jumped 200% to 1278 Facebook users. This boosted our presence among the younger Old Boys. Students, teachers and parents also liked our fan page and got more aware of what the OBA is doing.

We had an eventful year with plenty of warm and exciting moments to remember. I cherish them and am eager to have more in the future. I thank you for your support during the year. 雞蛋與高牆

我們除了是學生外，更加是社會的一分子。作為香港未來的主人翁，我們不但要學習課本上的知識，更應該積極參與社會事務。

普選向來是本港熱議的話題。由上世紀八十年代開始，不少人用不同途徑向當時的港英政府及現今的中央政府爭取一人一票選特首及立法會。然而，普選尚未能落實，中央政府的態度卻令不少人失望。亦因如此，學民思潮、學聯以及其他民主派組織於一四年九月中，舉行為期一星期的罷課活動，希望借此向政府施壓，表達學生的意見。

我校同學亦有參與其中。有中四、五同學自發在網上設立「瑞祺政改關注組」，並透過早會演講、民主牆等方式，向同學們講解有關「民主」的概念以及政改爭議的事情始末，藉此引起同學瞭解事件以及思考有關問題。而九月二十六日罷課當日，適逢學校水運會，不少同學在中午放學後趕赴金鐘集會現場參與罷課活動。

而在罷課當日晚上，學民思潮召集人黃之鋒呼籲在場人士衝入政府總部東翼前地，即「公民廣場」。警方隨即趕到，並包圍公民廣場，令廣場內學生缺乏支援。除此以外，警察亦施放胡椒噴霧以及催淚彈鎮壓示威群眾，令金鐘變得混亂。我校亦有同學及老師在金鐘現場，更有部分人被催淚彈所傷害。警方做法激發了市民不滿，有人衝出夏慤道，引發了為期三個月的「雨傘革命」。

「雨傘革命」爆發後的第一個上課日，即九月二十九日，「瑞祺政改關注組」以及學生會成

員在早上號召同學在操場靜座，以示對當局處理手法不滿；以及戴上口罩以模仿施放催淚彈的情景。亦有同學於早會期間上台演講，向同學講述有關事件。

除此以外，近二百名同學響應「瑞祺政改關注組」以及學生會號召，參與為期兩日的罷課行動。在罷課期間，同學本著「罷課不罷學」的理念，學習課本外的知識。「瑞祺政改關注組」以及學生會的同學邀請了不同人士分享，包括校長、曾到金鐘現場的老師、參與過其他社會運動的舊生以及本校社工等。在第二天罷課期間，不少師兄回校給予同學支持，並且參與其中。有關講課的內容廣泛，例如由「五四運動」去看學生在社會的角色、從「公民抗命」去看法治精神等，皆令同學獲益良多。「雨傘革命」為社會大事，而有線電視、香港電台等傳媒亦有報導我校的罷課活動。

在罷課期間，同學們都遵守秩序，沒有因為離開課室而忘記學生的本份，展現了陳瑞祺學生應有的質素。亦使罷課活動得



以順利進行，並省卻管理秩序的時間，將活動焦點放於「公民抗命」本身。然而，由於事出突然，校方無法要求所有同學出示家長證明，有少部分同學利用此漏洞「走堂」，忽略了罷課的意義。

「雨傘革命」或是罷課的力量皆是微小的。面對當權者，我們從來只是雞蛋與高牆的關係。然而，雞蛋看似一碰即破，卻象征生命與未來。公民抗命的意義除了直接的抗爭外，更希望令社會醒覺，有所關注。拿破崙曾說：「這個世界飽受摧殘，不是因為惡人帶來了暴力，而是因為好人的沉默不語。」意即大家的沉默、裝睡才是破壞社會的元兇。希望罷課運動能夠在各位同學心中埋下種籽，亦希望同學們都能多關心社會，接觸不同資訊並建立自己的想法，不要人云亦云，才可以貢獻香港。

日子久了，我們都閱讀了不少好文章。

晚宴當天，部份同學相約回母校參觀。一些同學更即興打了一場籃球友誼賽。當年建昌兄是我校籃球隊的主力，更曾奪標，贏取過丙組香港校際籃球賽的總冠軍。當年全校都非常興奮，更因而全校特別放假一天。

其實當年教導我們的好老師，多不勝數。記憶所及，當年讀中四時，有一位負責教世界歷史，真正的姓名已記不清楚，老師在上課時，講到中國歷史那部份時，講了「Right or Wrong, My Country」這句話，至今本人仍將這番說話牢牢的藏在心裏。

還有中三時教過我們的郭桂芬老師，她教「化學」這科多年，在校聲譽甚高。每位讀理科的同學都讚賞她。郭老師在校慶四十周年時所講的一番說話，記憶猶新。她認為畢業同學們應該多參加母校所舉辦的活動。校慶並不是祇為學業或事業有成的畢業學生舉辦的。參與者無分區別，不分職業。能夠再相聚都是一個恩賜。每個畢業生應多珍惜這份緣。

我們對母校的一些集體回憶

建昌學兄：

今年一月底學校舉辦了四十五周年的慶祝活動。一班老同學再有機會聚首一堂，在學校附近的酒家一起慶祝。母校的新校址建於一九六九年，距今已四十五年了。想當年，我們是陳瑞祺（喇沙）書院在何文田常和街建校後的第一屆學生，四十五年瞬間便過去了。但回想起我們曾在母校一起讀書時的情境，又好像猶如數個月前的事。

出席校慶的校友們都非常興奮，和多年的舊同學和老師們再相見，自然有說不盡的話題。雖然當年教導過我們的老師已全部退休了，但當天晚上很多已退休的老師都出席了這個盛會，師生人數達數百人。

建昌兄，你是否還記得我們讀中一時，當班主任的董桂子老師（69年），現時定居於法國。董老師當年除了悉心教導我們英文課外，亦鼓勵我們多看英文小說，和背誦英文字典。她深信學生們若能學好英語，對日後的學習和發展，有莫大的幫助和裨益。

大家敬愛的「朱古力」，中二時的班主任張俊明老師（69年），是位萬能戰士。他多年前已移民到澳洲定居及在當地大學教書。想當年，他除了教導我們數學科外，在其他學科方面，都有淵博的學識。「朱古力」對學生很嚴格。即使水運會和陸運會，他也不斷鼓勵全班同學報名參加，全民皆兵。他認為凡事要成功，努力是不二法門。中二最難忘的事，莫過於全班同學都能升上中三。相比於中一及中三時平均留班或被趕出



校的學生人數高達百份之二十五，當年全班能升級，實在是一個奇蹟。

我們的「占士邦」，中三時的班主任黃敬忠老師（69年），一直在校內很有名望，原因是在母校教書的數位老師，都曾是他執教於喇沙時的學生。但他為人沒有甚麼架子，上課時又很民主，採用的是積極不干預政策。「占士邦」的中、英文非常了得，教中文科時又喜歡吟唐詩。尤其是李白的「朝辭白帝彩雲間，千里江陵一日還。兩岸猿聲啼不絕，輕舟已過萬重山」，用來取笑我們上課時好像兩岸的馬騮般，不斷叫囂，幾乎下課的鐘聲也聽不到。他也喜歡吟蘇軾的「盆山不見日，草木自蒼然。忽登最高塔，眼界窮大千」——以此鼓勵我們要有新的眼界，才有新的天地。他也經常提醒我們要進食豐富的早餐，才能夠有足够的體力和精神去爭取較好的學業成績。昌兄還記否當年我們測驗中文時，總有

相信你一定記得中四那年的施健群老師。當年他剛來母校任教便當我們的班主任，及任教經濟及公共事務科。施健群老師是一位很嚴肅的老師，教書也非常認真。但那一年，我們文科班的同學成績並不特別好，上課紀律也很差。相信施老師第一年的教學體驗應該不好受。但他教導我們的知識，相信對同學有莫大的幫助。施老師可算是教導我們了解商業社會的啟蒙老師。而他之後也當上陳瑞祺（喇沙）書院的校長，可算是實至名歸。

中五那一年的班主任「Brother Columbus」已「還了俗」，不再當修士了。他的兩位小朋友相信現在也已經長大成人。當年他負責教我們英文科和聖經科。他上英文課時很獨特。建昌兄應該還記得每次上英文課時，「Brother Columbus」都預備一篇簡短的文章要我們讀默。



name, surname及family name都是指姓。至於名字, first name, second name, middle name及given name都是指名。歐美人士一般較多用first name稱呼較熟的對方, 較陌生的則用姓稱呼, 跟我們的習慣接近。Second name或middle name平日則較少用到, 因此常用middle initial, 例如John Fitzgerald Kennedy就通常把Fitzgerald縮成F。

也有一些英文字既是姓, 又是名, 例如阿凡達、鐵達尼號大導演 James Cameron, Cameron是姓。大明星Cameron Diaz的Cameron是名。在中國人的姓名裏, 把陳李張黃何做名字的情況則較少見。「秀娜」、「千語」這些名字很少會弄錯。

如果把中國人的姓名由歐美人士去唸, 往往會鬧出笑話來。加拿大之旅後, 我到了美國登上郵輪, 船公司把我的名字 Lau Po Wah Chris, 理解成 Wah Chris 是我的複姓 (compound surname), 解釋了半天才把問題弄清楚。其實歐美人士也有把姓氏放在前面的時候, 例如在電話簿(好像已經成為古董)這類指南, 就是由姓氏放在前面排序的。

回到課堂上的事。記得有一次測驗後, 伍太以座位排序逐個叫到講台取回測驗卷, 成績差的當然又會相贈幾句。當從最後派到我後面一位的同學時, 伍太說我這一直行整行都沒有人合格, 我以為今次一定凶多吉少了。輪到我取測驗卷時, 伍太望望我, 又望望我的試卷, 說整行就只得我一個測驗合格, 然後把試卷交給我, 我當時的感覺就真的如釋重負。

還有一位已移民多倫多又不能不提的老師是曾當訓導主任的劉志堅老師, 當年是我中三時的班主任, 教授經濟及公共事務及地理等科目。他雖然外型威武, 但內心善良, 是一位做事認真、誠心愛護學生的好老師。前一陣子跟一位已移民新加坡, 年長我幾年級的師兄在新加坡會面時談起劉志堅老師, 他也很感激劉志堅老師當年對他的激勵, 令他在學業上及以後的人生道路上都改變不少。

四十五年來陳瑞祺來過很多很有愛心和責任心的老師, 在一篇短短的文章裏並不能逐一談及。但作為學生對老師們多年來的付出在許多年後仍然會銘記於心。

後話: 伍太在是次敘會後大半年左右於多倫多病逝, 曾受業於她的陳瑞祺舊生無不深感惋惜, 嘆世事無常。

屋後的櫻桃樹

楓話隨筆

每隔數年，我會與太太到加拿大多倫多走一趟，探望移民加國多年的岳母。岳母年事已高，有時間總得抽空去探望。當母親的每次見到兒女到來探望，面上總掛著喜出望外的笑容。每次我們到來的日子，她每天都準備了許多美食，唯恐我們在多倫多會吃不飽。

五月的多倫多比香港的天氣涼快得多，陰天的日子氣溫往往維持在十度以下，白雪則完全溶化了。從家中廚房往後院望去，櫻桃樹已結出白色的小花，菓實則要到七、八月才結出鮮紅色又鮮又甜的櫻桃來。加拿大的五月總是充滿希望和喜悅，經過半年的漫長嚴冬，迎來的是色彩繽紛的春天。多倫多初春的天氣很適合種植鬱金香，因此家家戶戶的門前都種有各種顏色鮮豔的鬱金香，預告春天的來臨。

八、九十年代大量香港人移民加拿大，頗多聚居於安大略省多倫多新開發的東、西及北面，形成幾個華人社區。這種現象稱為「Diaspora」五方雜處。很多的華人商場在社區中建成，售賣很多跟香港有關聯的物品，例如「壹」週刊、波蘿飽、車仔麵等令人懷念的東西。

很多很有水準的廚師從香港來到多倫多，令到多倫多的中餐館水準足以媲美香港的酒樓。一天岳母帶了我們到一間裝修得美侖美奐的海鮮酒家晚膳，其中一道菜就叫了一隻接近十磅重的加拿大龍蝦，雖然肉質及鮮味比不上澳洲龍蝦，卻比在香港食到的一般波士頓龍蝦滋味，而且價錢比香港便宜得多。由於加拿大和美國均是魚農產品大國，在這裏進食，可算是極之安心。

數位早年在我校任教的老師亦於八、九十年代移民多倫多，我這幾次前往多倫多均有與他們相敘。曾任我中四時班主任的陳錦新老師移民多倫多已二十多年，子女均已長大，現在正享受優悠的退休生活。陳老師在我校時任教高年班中國語文及中國文學，對中文書法頗有研究，數年前出版了一本書法的合訂本，並贈予學校的各位老師收藏。我曾到訪過陳老師在多倫多的家，偌大的地庫是一個藏經閣，極具「書卷味」，這是在彈丸之地的香港一個不可思議的奢望。

這次在多倫多相約一起午膳的老師還有伍太 Mrs Ng 夫婦。原先亦相約了從喇沙夜校（陳瑞祺的前身）起已經在本校任教的老廖顯樹老師，但這次因其他事的緣故廖老師未能赴約。Mrs Ng 當年任教我低班時的英文，EPA (Economics and Public Affairs，近似現時的 Integrated Humanity) 及 Geography。Mrs Ng 當年出名嚴厲，較傳神的則稱作「惡死」。上堂問書學生假若答不上來就肯定捱罵。我則很欣賞 Mrs Ng 對教書的熱誠。Mrs Ng 中學時是唸中文中學的，竟然可以於一所英文中學教英文，完全是靠自己的努力和堅持。我問及 Mrs Ng 如何練就這麼好的英文本領，她回答說中學時期常常跟同學用電話聊天，即「煲電話粥」，但又不想父母知道談話內容，於是轉台，用英語跟同學交談，自己主動創造英語環境。Mrs Ng 說英語時字正腔圓，娓娓動聽。

對 Mrs Ng 印象較深刻的有幾件事。她常常教我們「Name」的正確讀法，因為香港可能超過一半人讀了「lan」；另一個字是「game」，今時今日仍然有很多人讀了「gan」。記得 Mrs Ng 有一次上英語課時問一位同學「What is your surname?」，同學誤以為是 Christian name，或我們平日指的英文名，於是回答「No surname」，氣得 Mrs Ng 七竅生煙，這位同學當然只有捱罵的份兒。

這次到加拿大，入境時要填寫表格，身旁的乘客問 last name 抑或 first name 是姓？英語系人士一般把姓氏放在最後，例如 John F. Kennedy，Kennedy 就是姓，由於放在最後，所以 last name 就是姓。英國人習慣用 surname 或 family name，全家人都有同一個名字的就是姓。因此，last

香港工程師學會流動裝置遊戲程式設計 比賽2015中學冠軍有感

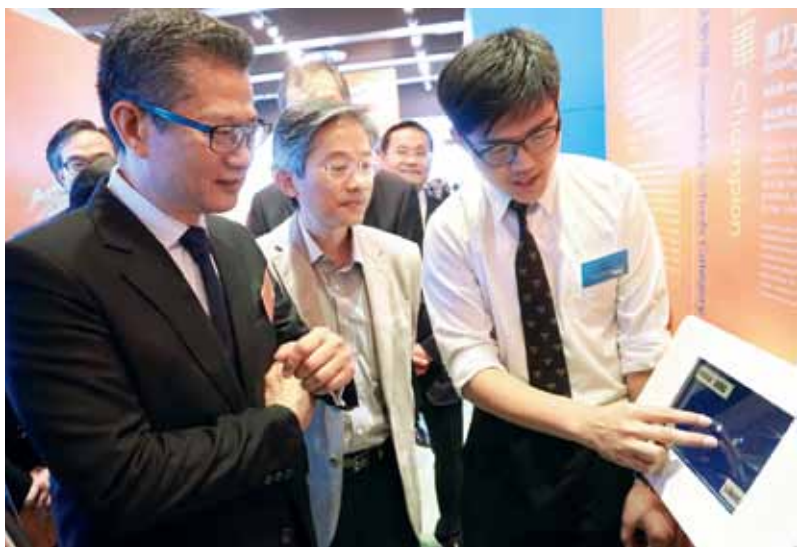


給師弟的話：

我是五丙班的黃建緻。今年我有幸參加「香港工程師學會流動裝置遊戲程式設計比賽」，幸運地得了冠軍。大會除了在科學館舉行頒獎典禮外，還把我的作品「Gravity Trip」於科學館展出，這是一個很難得的經驗。而今次比賽的獎金亦不少，是港幣一萬五千元。不過，我參加該次比賽前是不知道有獎金的，初時怕影響學業而考慮不參加，但最後都選擇參加了，而結果卻出乎我意料之外。

今次的比賽令我學會一個概念，對日後的我可能是一個重要的提醒。從前猜不透為什麼我要讀一些連自己都不喜歡的東西，認為只要鑽研自己喜歡的學科就行了。因此當時只沉醉於電腦編程中，甚至不上學，日以繼夜地編寫程式。「成

績差，反叛……」種種的貶詞都是用來形容我的。但思想慢慢成熟後，重新回到學校，開始接觸當初很抗拒的科目，發現他們都不是我想像中的洪水猛獸。今次比賽的主題是「工程與你」，巧合地物理科說到引力的課題，靈機一觸便成就



了今天的「Gravity Trip」。這遊戲讓玩家在不懂物理公式的情況下，也能感受到重力實驗。玩家可以調教火箭的發射角度和力度，目的是令火箭藉著不同的星球和引力場到達終點。我把日夜鑽研的編程技術和物理科的知識一起放到遊戲中，並在評審面前運用了我在辯論隊學到的演說技巧。這樣令我明白到學習不是單一的，不是一個強項就能讓人成為「專家」。不同的學科和學習經歷都令我們成長，都值得我們學習。有些人會把「我不是數學家，為什麼要學數學？」和「我不是科學家，為什麼要讀物理？」這類句子掛在口邊，跟我從前的想法一樣，因此我十分清楚他們的心態。但比賽後，我發現所學過的一切都不會白費。無論是當初不太感興趣的物理，還是鑽研很多個日與晚的程式，它們通通都是成就今天的因。我們永遠不會知道那一個時候需要使用「它們」，但機會就只會留給有準備的人。你可能也有不喜歡的東西要學、要忙，但希望你閱讀過我的經歷後能明白「它們」是會令你有不同的東西，不要離棄你的「好朋友」。

瑞祺中辯——赤紅的傳承之心



「辯論」不單是一門技巧，更是一門學問，甚至是一種語言藝術。瑞祺中辯並不像其他校隊般高調，反而一直在默默耕耘，只想為校爭光。同學們對瑞祺中辯又有多少認識呢？

辯論界闖出名堂

陳瑞祺中文辯論隊雖然於零六年才成立，但同學自發參與校外辯論比賽已有超過三十多年歷史，可算是與學校共同成長。他們見證了不少學校輝煌成就，亦親歷了一代又一代的辯員誕生。一九九七年「星島全港校際辯論比賽」冠軍、二零一一年「學思杯」季軍、二零一四年「華辯杯」季軍等，一個又一個的獎項確立了瑞祺中辯於學界的地位。

運作方式

瑞祺中辯有別於其它學校的辯論隊，他並沒有教練。辯論隊現時主要由中五的同學帶領，而對師弟的培訓及指導工作則大多是由中五的師兄或舊生負責。教授的內容主要圍繞思辯技巧和分享比賽經驗。老師多會擔任指導的角色，於辯論隊有需要的時候才加以協助。

學界的參與

而辯論隊的訓練多以練習賽或友誼賽為主，令雙方辯員能互相切磋，為辯員們吸取最多的經驗。以往曾與其他學校進行比賽。

辯論隊成員表示，每年的中文辯論界都會舉行大大小小的不同盃賽，辯論隊除了會參加「聯校中文辯論比賽」、「基本法盃」、「星島校際辯論比賽」三大學界辯論比賽外，近年亦活躍於各規模較小的學界辯論比賽當中，例如「奇趣盃」、「華語辯論盃」、「學思盃」等等，當中的比賽成績亦相當理想。能於不同的校際辯論比賽上看到我校辯論隊的蹤影，可見我校中文辯論隊於學界絕對是活躍一員。

主動·熱誠

他們表示現時中文辯論隊的入隊要求很簡單，只求主動和熱誠，無需過五關斬六將。他們亦指出往日招收新辯員的媒介並不多，主要是透過老師和同年級同學的推薦或是選拔班際辯論中表現出色的同學。但近年為擴大辯論隊的規模，新辯員主要是透過「課外活動招生日」吸納，讓有興趣及有熱誠的同學能主動報名。

對於中辯隊員而言，中辯隊不只是普通校隊，反而像一個大家庭。以下是他們的感想：

葉家豪：四年的中辯旅程來到尾聲，固然充滿不捨和遺憾，但很高興見到一班初中的隊友能夠將中辯隊引以為傲的傳統傳承下去。期望你們能夠帶領中辯越過荊棘挑戰，挑戰一個又一個的高峰。感謝中辯隊給了我不同機會，例如參與公開比賽、甚至成為聯校中文辯論學會的幹事，讓我獲益良多。

敬業與樂業，以教與學為本

徐師兄身為全職的補習老師，工作量大及壓力很大，但是他亦能樂在其中；「看到學生進步，那一份喜悅及滿足感是無法形容的。雖然我的要求比較嚴格，亦有不同的功課及筆記供同學溫習，但我一直相信只要持之以恆，便是進步的不二法門。只要學生進步，工作的辛酸都會一掃而空。」由此可見，當職業符合自己的興趣及個性，縱使心力交瘁，也會因其滿足感而樂在其中。

徐師兄認為補習的效益與常規的課堂相輔相成，相得益彰，徐師兄進入補習的行列是一心一意為社會的教育出一份力，並非沽名釣譽，因此向來也十份低調，從不矯揉造作，但是身為一個敬業的補習老師亦有背後苦不堪言的辛酸。「其一是壓力，特別是語文科，不但在筆記上務求要一絲不苟，而且在課堂上的演繹講求清晰，但又不可以太沉悶，更不能講解時出現錯誤，壓力成為其主要的苦處。其二是工作量多得讓人喘息不來。因為補習老師背後需要與助教開會、批改學生功課、解答學生疑問、編寫及整理講義及試卷、定時備課及上課、推測考試趨勢……特別是臨考試的時間，每天最多只能睡三至五小時，因為我深信我的付出能真正以學生為本，令他們學業進步。」徐師兄亦坦言身體也捱不住，間中受疾病的侵襲。即使他面對精神上的壓力及體力上的透支，他亦事必躬親，務求關顧每位同學的需要及盡自己在教育這一環上的己任；不會因重重的困難而虎頭蛇尾，反而有始有終，當考慮到學生因他的拼搏而得到啟發後，便會認為自己活得有意義，而且樂在其中。徐師兄亦借此帶出只要是得到滿足感及有意義，希望各位師弟也能發揮瑞祺精神——永不言敗。

工作時難忘的事

當筆者提到徐師兄工作難忘的事，他雀躍萬分的向我們娓娓道來：「工作最難忘的事莫過於去年放榜見證學生努力得到回報。去年我其中一名學生在中文科中全卷五顆星，令我感到十分欣慰。最後他成為我的大學師弟及助教。而且學生的進步是對他們努力的一種肯定，更是對我的肯定。多年前我有一名重讀高中的學生，中化科升至乙等，口試更奪得甲等，雖然總分不太完美，但順利取得大學的入門券。由此可見不一定是高材生才能令老師滿足，只要學生努力，我相信所有老師也會感到安慰。時至今日，我在一間展覽館舉辦的模擬試見到所有學生聚首一堂努力應試，那一份感覺非常震撼，因為整個會堂的學生都專心致志為自己的目標奮鬥，為師者之樂莫過於此。」

對母校不捨之情

在訪問的尾段，徐師兄在談吐間露出絲絲的笑容。「首先捨不得是會考及高考一群『出生入死』的患難之交，在公開考試猶如洪水猛獸撲向來前，徐師兄憶述沒有一群兄弟並肩作戰是不能堅持到底，『獨學而無友，則孤陋寡聞』，他最嚮往與同學交流，互相鼓勵的時光。再者，我也不捨得母校的老師，因為他們也沒有架子，大家打成一片，師生正是中國文化中屬朋友一倫，正如我與朋友交流學術知識，只要同學尊重老師，老師必定傾囊相授。」

對同學的期盼

「最後，希望師弟能在中學生涯中尋找到自己的人生目標，不管自己善於運動、琴棋書畫、唱歌……在畢業後也能在自己喜歡的範疇一展所長，因為生活中充滿自己的興趣是人生一大樂事。除此之外，也希望師弟們前程錦繡，長大後

能為母校這大家庭發光發熱，回饋社會，因為每個水記仔也是獨當一面，切記要爭氣、爭氣、爭氣。別人問你畢業於那一所中學，你也能自豪地回答：「我畢業於何文田的陳瑞祺（喇沙）書院！」

後記

為何筆者要為徐師兄作一個專訪？其一，徐師兄在中學、大學乃至就職也與中文有莫大的淵源，是一個頗特別的師兄，想與各位分享他的往事與他成功的微妙關係。其二，徐師兄去年在事業上得到重大突破，筆者想藉此鼓勵他，希望他在教育界繼續努力。其三，筆者發現徐師兄身上有不少「瑞祺精神」例如：勇於嘗試新挑戰、致力傳承瑞祺精神等等，一方面能回應學校四十五週年的主題：「勇氣和承傳」，另一方面，希望各位同學能向他借鑒，以他作榜樣，甚至比他做得更好更佳，從不同方面貢獻瑞祺！

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星星之火，可以承傳

徐永豪師兄專訪

徐永豪師兄畢業於二零一零年（中七），二零零八年（中五）於會考中文科取得優異成績，隨即原校升讀中六，並擔任校刊中文總編輯及中文學會會長。其後畢業於香港大學中文及教育學系，並以優異的成績取得榮譽學士學位。在大學未畢業時，徐永豪師兄已獲得香港大學文學院優先取錄，將會完成中國語文及文學碩士學位。在學士期間，徐永豪師兄是全港最多中學生選報的大學生導師。大學畢業後，更成為大型補習社的首席中文科導師。

正確的中學生生活——建立多元化的技能

「初中時我覺得學業成績是中學生生活唯一的意義，所以孜孜不倦地讀書，成績亦名列前茅。但是，眼見周遭的同學也參加林林總總的活動，於是決心向不同方面的課外活動嘗試：徵文比賽、朗誦、足球隊等等。甚至在徵文比賽中，以『嘗試』心態參加便取得獎盃，心中有一份難以言喻的激動及滿足感」在訪問時，徐師兄也不禁莞爾一笑。在那一個時候，他才知道原來中學生活是要多元化發展，才能樂在其中，只有多元化的活動才能建立美好的中學時光。

徐師兄投身教育界，為中學生的其中一個大敵——學好中文出一分力。原來他在高中時已經與中文結下千絲萬縷的緣份。在中四及中五的時候，徐師兄與他的戰友在老師的薰陶下參加中文辯論比賽，是發展中文的第一步，也是其中一件

徐師兄深刻的事。在準備辯論的過程中，他學會了原來凡事應該以兩面來看，亦明白批判性思維的重要性，是建立思考的必需技能。而且在比賽中，與一群戰友群策群力，互相協作下連續兩年也贏取冠軍，與一群歷盡艱辛的戰友坐上二連勝的寶座，成為一時佳話。為會考前留下一個不論事隔多年也會會心一笑的往事。

「會考後，我原校升讀中六後擔任中文學會的主席及校刊中文部的主編，在中文的範疇上進一步發展。」徐師兄憶述在中學生涯中最大的體會就是擔任以上的兩個角色。因為徐師兄認為在中文學會辦的每一項活動也能真正體會到何謂「台上一分鐘，台下十年功」，每項活動（班際演講比賽、班際辯論比賽、四十周年校慶攤位活動等等），也包含了很多的功夫、心機、時間、精神……絕非易事；而且他身為學校四十周年校慶的校刊中文部主編，更加

之明白到要完成一本大型的集體創作絕不簡單。平日隨手拈來的一份刊物，驟眼看好像平平無奇，但要經過不少人力物力的資源完成：計劃、分配工作、尋找編輯、寫稿、校對、排版等等。以上兩項任重道遠的職務也令他明白到團體是唯一的力量。但是這兩份任務也令他學會生活中不同的技能，對他日後的发展開啟了先河，因此徐師兄也十分的鼓勵各同學積極參與課外活動。

在徐師兄的中學生涯中，擔任及參與不同職位及活動有助建立多元化的技能，對事業及升學上起了重大的作用。由此可見，生活中的技能往往就在身邊，特別是成長中的同學，「莫待無花空折枝」，要把握現有的機會，珍惜自己一去不返的光陰。

為何投身教育界？

「作為一名中文系及教育系的畢業生，選擇教育事業是理所當然。當年我在總編輯的話中曾經說過教育是最偉大的事業。今日，我依然尊重兩大行業：杏林與杏壇，即是醫學界及教育界。杏壇一詞，是指孔子講學的地方。我覺得任何工作，只要對社會有貢獻或者可以幫助他人都是好工作。」徐師兄亦記述他曾經教過初中、高小、初中及高中，不同經驗令他畢生難忘。他對高中的教學情有獨鍾，希望傳授自己的經驗予以幫助同學戰勝公開考試。



製作新書的過程。從收到新書開始和李老師商議新書展覽，到整理書本資料，再到包書、製作條碼等，整個過程我都會興致勃勃。當看到同學們對這些新書展露出興趣時，我便感到十分高興，感覺一切都沒有白費氣力。」

整體而言宋老師喜歡這份工作，雖然每天都要面對各式各樣的挑戰，但始終在學校其實並不會發生什麼大事件，甚至可以說這樣的工作很平靜和輕鬆。不過這並不代表沉悶，反而在一次次解決問題的過程中讓她趣味盎然，獲得了一份滿足和成功感。「我覺得自己和工作尤其匹配，但其實這個工作要找到合適的人並不容易，因為圖書館的工作較為文靜而留堂班的工作卻需要嚴厲的人，兩者的工作性質南轅北轍。可能我很喜歡看書也很喜歡聊天，因此能夠兼任。」

難忘的人與事

宋老師對於和學生之間建立關係的橋樑最難以忘懷，她仍記得第一年來到我校時遇到幾位對中文辯論滿腔熱忱的學生。「那時候這幾位中辯成員隔三差五便會相約留在學校圖書館討論辯題，每每他們都會很晚才離開，有時甚至我驅趕他們也照樣留下熱切地討論。我只好捨命陪君子，留下來陪他們加班。不過他們很喜歡問我意見，即使我沒有辯論的經驗他們也不計較，幸好有時我能夠助他們一臂之力。直到現在，我們依然保持聯絡。」

離別

在談論這個話題的時候，宋老師不禁聲淚俱下，哽咽著地表達她對我依依不捨之情。「我很遺憾我未能在校留待到第四年的學期尾，在中途被迫不得已離開。在這裡工作我很開心，不論校長、同事、學生都待我不薄，特別是校長願

意給予我機會和自由，讓我在這裡工作得輕鬆自在，我由衷感謝他們。」宋老師對於大家對她的不捨感到受寵若驚，她不曾想到原來自己不過做好本份也贏得別人的愛戴和讚賞。學生、同事為她舉行的歡送會讓她熱淚盈眶，畢生難忘。「我是一個重感情的人，離別，讓我猶豫不決，尤其在學校每年見證同學們成長，畢業，離開。這種感覺就好像離開了一個家一樣，無奈顧及事業的發展，離開是必然之事，坦白地說對於離開我很不情願。」

對同學的寄語

宋老師對於我誠心忡忡，她冀望自己的諄諄告誡能夠幫助同學醒悟。「首先在我職責範圍當然是交齊功課，功課對於學業真的是不可或缺，它能夠幫助你在成績上獲得進步，你怎能和自己作對而不做功課呢？第二，學校的閱讀氣氛不濃厚，我希望同學們能夠多閱讀。我也難免老生常談，閱讀真的能夠幫助人提升閱讀速度，而且閱讀對於個人修養的培育同為重要。第三，是關於貢獻瑞祺。在我入行這幾年我見證學校的一些起伏，我覺得要貢獻瑞祺不能只依靠高年級的師兄或學生會。不論師兄或師弟每個人都應該做好自己，每個人都肩負其力有所及的責任。」

訪問至此已經接近尾聲，宋老師欲透過這此良機說出自己的一些心底話。她感謝校長在她和家長發生爭執時能夠從教育者的角度對她予以認同；對於一樓這班最熟悉的同事，他們的接納和鼓勵讓她感激不盡；大抵因為二樓的同事都是老師，她覺得自己宛如他們的學生，受到他們的關懷備至；至於學生，她說自己其實只是他們成長階段中的過客，若有緣的話，她希望友誼長存。

後記

宋老師曾經問過筆者為何她是專訪的對象，其實這裡我出了點私心。在平常的接觸中我覺得宋老師的為人很友善，且對工作兢兢業業，但包括筆者在內很少人認識她，因此筆者希望藉此讓大家都接觸她。在訪問期間，筆者由衷感受到宋老師對我校的熱愛和不捨，亦看到宋老師將其很多不為人知的想法展露出來。相信讀畢這個專訪，同學們也必然認識到這位「大姐姐」。

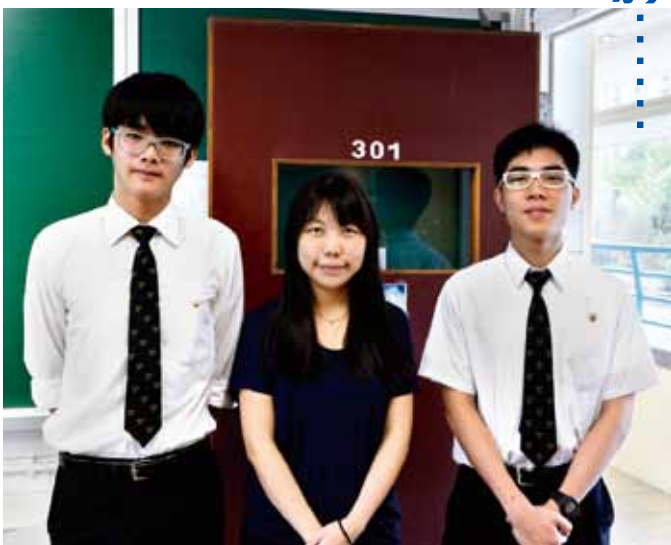
既熟悉又陌生的身影 宋恩雨老師訪問

水記的莘莘學子或多或少都曾看見這樣的景象——她在早會前追查同學時的身影、在圖書館整理書籍時的身影、在留堂班管理秩序時的身影……在校園整天都可以看到她奔波勞碌的樣子。對此我們都習以為常，然而你有否留意到她的身影悄然消失得無影無蹤？或許這時候你才發現你知道她卻不認識她，你會稱呼她「宋小姐」，但你可能對她的姓氏以外一無所知。認識她的同學寥寥無幾，更多的和她只有數面之緣，或萍水相逢。因此，這次我們有幸邀請宋老師進行訪問，為大家展現其不為人知的一面，讓大家更了解這位眾同學的大姐姐。

對水記的初印象

到校上班前宋老師曾在網上蒐集關於學校的資料，「我在網上得知陳瑞祺是一所男校，一直以來在學術、體育方面都出類拔萃，而我亦看到同學們躊躇滿志，所以我覺得這所學校很了不起，心感佩服。」不過對於宋老師而言，到本校工作卻頗具挑戰性，因為這不僅是她畢業不久後的第一份工作，而且要在男校擔任管理的角色，她笑言有種「男校女生」的感覺。其後她坦言自己初時對於如何管理學生是一竅不通，同學們對她的說話亦充耳不聞，因此那時候她要 and 男生說話已經感到恍然，更遑論要責罵男生。

宋老師是基督教徒，和我校的宗教背景大相逕庭，她覺得在天主教學校任職讓她大開眼界，她鮮少接觸天主教，亦不曾接觸像我校一樣每天需要唸經三次的學校，她認為這個舉動對於同學在宗教方面受益匪淺。



轉變

相較於初入行，在日漸習慣和累積經驗後，宋老師認為這份工作對她而言已經游刃有餘。她克服了如何管理學生，「我覺得自己的膽子與日俱增，不再害怕責罵他們，亦開始懂得如何與同學們溝通，這可是一大進步。」；在學校這個環境的薰陶下，她覺得自己重拾了一種東西——是非之心和正義感。「我以前修讀市場學，某些事情在耳濡目染下，或經歷後開始覺得世界無奇不有，因此對是非的看法不再執著，覺得這個世界有什麼人都理所當然。不過在學校看著同學們成長的同時，我好像倏地出現教育者的心。在同學們成長的階段中，有些事情的對或錯必然要分得清清楚楚，而這個想法出現後我開始轉變，希望

可以將這些想法灌輸給你們，讓你們學懂分別是非黑白。」

工作的苦與樂

原來宋老師在任職前只是一心一意希望管理圖書館，沒有料到還需要管理留堂班這些工作。她說第一天管理留堂班時的情景記憶猶新，她不曾料到竟有多達一百多人需要留堂，人數之多甚至要開放禮堂容納，這對她來說十分震撼。「其實後來圖書館的職務反而不太繁重，我花了不少心機和時間在留堂班。對我而言管理留堂班並非易事，每天早上便要開始責罵同學，但很多時同學們都不太清醒，讓我有種對牛彈琴的感覺。另外這也和我的性格不符，事實上我不太喜歡責罵別人，因此第一年的工作讓我有点苦不堪言。」

然而，這些事情對於宋老師來說都仍未是困難所在——在後來這些事情已經駕輕就熟，反而和家長溝通才艱難。她覺得有些家長過份溺愛小孩，令她有時感到好夕也說不過去，她自問自己並不「長氣」，所以這些溝通便變得很痛苦。不過宋老師很感恩有留堂班這份工作，因為這樣她才能每天充實地工作，可以有機會和同學聊天或教導他們一些學業上的問題，她認為沒有留堂班的日子可能會枯燥乏味。

有同學間或會向宋老師請教一些關於學科上的問題，這令她十分驚喜。「我很樂意幫助他們。我曾經考慮過報讀教育文憑，不過最終三思一番後覺得不適合便放棄了，沒想到還有教導學生的機會。」

在管理圖書館方面，宋老師認為沒有困苦之處，她認為圖書館是一個能讓大家愉快、尋找知識和輕鬆閱讀的地方，因此沒有什麼需要她格外分神的事情。她享受在圖書館的工作，「我喜歡

「無論讀書和工作都不要感到害怕而逃避，因為每一件事皆有解決辦法。再者，針對喜愛設計的同學，應該經常拓闊眼光，接觸新鮮的事物。」他原本以為修讀關於電腦的知識是沒用的，但現在的網上購物可以運用到這方面的知識，謹記接觸新事物，因為這些事物的衝擊，可以帶來創作靈感。

選擇自己的路向

顧師兄當時已經決定修讀時裝設計，因此他在中六暑假時申請英國大學的基礎課程，要是成績優秀就可以銜接到該大學的時裝設計系，這間大學在此科目位列全球第五，遠遠超過香港理工大學，所以他便離開了香港，修讀自己喜愛的時裝設計。

對時裝設計的興趣

顧師兄從小就接觸時裝設計，他的父母從事製衣行業。不久他對時裝設計產生興趣。再者，他長大後經常從電視上看見明星衣著，研究他們怎樣才能穿得更漂亮，令他的興趣更濃厚。

參加課外活動對工作的好處

顧師兄曾經是紅十字會的總隊長及主席，學生會外務副主席和音樂學會委員。他認為參加這些活動有助於訓練領導才能，在他管理公司的工作上有莫大的裨益。

工作及創業心得

職業上的定位

師兄除了曾經擔任時裝設計的工作，還擔任過時裝買手，現在更成為老闆。但在職涯上亦曾經感到迷茫，不知道個人的定位，心中存有的問題：「自己是否適合擔當時裝買手的工作呢？」但在成立了個人品牌後，發現當時裝買手的工作有極大的幫助，不但認識到顧客衣著的喜好，還明白到計算成本和收入的重要性，學懂如何營運一間公司。談到最喜愛的職業，「我還是喜歡成為一位時裝設計師！」因為他可以從零開始，到完成製成品，再見到別人穿著自己的心血，那一份的成功感和滿足感是難以言喻的。

現實與夢想

他直言，「如果現在是打工的，那麼我便可以安眠。」有人認為成為老闆是很輕鬆，十分理想的一件事，但許多人沒有考慮到往後需要面對的問題，他清楚明白這些問題，更會花盡一切的辦法都要堅持到底。因為成為老闆，設立個人的時裝品牌是他的夢想。
