



# MESSAGE OF POPE FRANCIS FOR THE JUBILEE OF MERCY FOR YOUNG BOYS AND GIRLS

## “Merciful Like the Father”



Dear Young Friends,

The Church is celebrating the Holy Year of Mercy, a time of grace, peace, conversion and joy. It is meant for everyone: people of every age, from far and near. There are no walls or distances which can prevent the Father's mercy from reaching and embracing us. The Holy Door is now open in Rome and in all the dioceses of the world.

This grace-filled moment also concerns you, dear young people. I encourage you to take an active part in this celebration and to realize that each of you is a child of God (cf. 1 Jn 3:1). I would like to invite you, one by one, calling you by name, as Jesus does each day. For you know that your names are written in heaven (Lk 10:20), in the heart of the Father, that Merciful Heart which is the source of all reconciliation and kindness.

The Jubilee is a year-long celebration, in which every moment becomes a chance for us to grow in holiness. It is a time when we can discover that life together as brothers and sisters is like a great party, perhaps the most beautiful party we can imagine, the endless party that Jesus has taught us to celebrate by his Spirit. The Jubilee is the party to which Jesus invites us all, without excluding anyone. That is why I also wanted to have some days of prayer and celebration with you. I am looking forward to seeing many of you in April.

“Merciful like the Father”. This is the theme of the Jubilee, but it is also the prayer we make for all of you as we welcome you in the name of Jesus. To be merciful means to grow in a love which is courageous, generous and real. It means to grow physically and spiritually. You are preparing to be Christians capable of making courageous choices and decisions, in order to build daily, even through little things, a world of peace.

Yours is a time of life which is full of amazing changes. Everything seems possible and impossible all at once. I repeat what I said to some of your friends: “Remain steadfast in the journey of faith, with firm hope in the Lord. This is the secret of our journey! He gives us the courage to swim against the tide. Pay attention, my young friends: to go against the current; this is good for the heart,

but we need courage to swim against the tide. Jesus gives us this courage! ... With him we can do great things; he will give us the joy of being his disciples, his witnesses. Commit yourselves to great ideals, to the most important things. We Christians were not chosen by the Lord for little things; push onwards toward the highest principles. Stake your lives on noble ideals” (Homily at the Conferral of the Sacrament of Confirmation, 2013).

Here I cannot forget those of you who are living in situations of war, extreme poverty, daily troubles and loneliness. Don't ever lose hope! The Lord has a great dream which, with your help, he wants to come true! Your friends, young people your age living in less trying conditions than your own, have not forgotten you; they are working for peace and justice for everyone everywhere. Don't be taken in by the messages of hatred or terror all around us. Instead, make new friends. Give of your time and always show concern for those who ask your help. Be brave and go against the tide; be friends of Jesus, who is the Prince of Peace (cf. Is 9:6). “Everything in him speaks of mercy. Nothing in him is devoid of compassion” (Misericordiae Vultus, 8).

I realize that not all of you can come to Rome, but the Jubilee is truly for everyone and it is also being celebrated in your local Churches. You are all invited to this moment of joy. Don't just prepare your rucksacks and your banners, but your hearts and your minds as well. Think carefully about the hope and desires you will hand over to Jesus in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and in the Eucharist which we will celebrate together. As you walk through the Holy Door, remember that you are committing yourselves to grow in holiness and to draw nourishment from the Gospel and the Eucharist, the Word and the Bread of life, in order to help build a more just and fraternal world.

May the Lord bless your journey towards the Holy Door. I pray that the Holy Spirit will guide your steps and enlighten you. For you and your families, and for all who help you to grow in goodness and in grace, may the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of us all, be true Door of Mercy.

## ❧ SUPERVISOR'S MESSAGE ❧

Brother Robert Schieler, Superior General of the De La Salle Brothers, visited Hong Kong in December 2015. That was the first time Brother Robert visited Hong Kong after he has assumed the post. He was accompanied by Brother Ricardo, General Councillor for the Pacific Asia Region. During his packed schedule, Brother Robert, inter alia, met with the members of the Lasallian Education Council (LEC), visited Chan Sui Ki (La Salle) Primary School, and attended a Lasallian family gathering. The Superior General will normally re-visit a destination in seven years.

Mr Larry Leung, a 1990 graduate and currently president of the CSKOB, was invited to be a member of the LEC in September 2015. Mr Leung was also elected alumni manager in the IMC in October last year. Mr CC Or, our ex-vice-principal, was appointed a school sponsoring body manager in September 2015. Ms Cheris Louie and Ms Loretta Wong were elected chairperson and vice-chairperson of the PTA last October, while Ms Wong was elected parent manager for the IMC. Ms SY Leung was promoted to vice-principal after the retirement of Mr KC Wong. I welcome all of them to their new positions.

At CSK we need to stress the importance of the virtue of justice as one of the visions of Catholic schools. Justice is a moral virtue that we give to God and to our neighbours. When dealing with our neighbours it is a respect for the rights of others. We aim to teach our students to understand and appreciate the need to establish a harmonious relationship with their neighbours and promote equity to others. To achieve the well being of society, one needs to protect human rights and be responsible for one's own family and society.

In 2015 we started a new 3-year school plan. One of the major concerns in the new plan is to enhance students' motivation and learning atmosphere. This target is to be achieved by firstly developing a caring school environment and secondly helping students to be self regulated learners. We intend to realise our first goal by strengthening the bond among students, teachers and the school and our second goal by creating a proactive learning attitude in the students.

On one of the staff development days, school managers were invited to attend and share their views with the teachers. This



sharing session has promoted mutual understanding between the managers and the teachers. Thoughts of teachers were heard in the session and considered and discussed carefully. A class visit by the school managers was a response to the opinions collected at the sharing session. Such an experience has helped the managers to understand the problems faced by our teachers.

Our students are provided with extra-curricular activities which can help them attain academic achievements and maintain a healthy mind. Examples of such activities include the singing contest, overseas study tours, the Read to Feed programme, and the drifting reading room. These are examples of learning outside the classroom and have always been welcomed by students.

Our school welcomed the Watoto Children's Choir which visited us in December 2015 and performed two sessions of singing and dancing. Watoto is a holistic programme initiated to serve the dire needs of orphaned children and vulnerable women in Uganda, Africa. The visit provided an opportunity for our students to pay attention to what is happening in a remote land in another part of the world.

Lastly I would like to thank all those who have contributed to the publication of the school magazine. This is a magazine of good quality and worth keeping for life long.

# ❧ SPEECH DAY 2016 ❧

## Speech by Professor Roland T Chin President and Vice-Chancellor of Hong Kong Baptist University

Good afternoon.

Principal Lee, Council members, Supervisor Lau, teachers, students, and parents, I'm very honoured to be here today at your graduation ceremony. Congratulation to you all.

Today, I'm going to tell you my own story - my experience some 46 years ago. It happened when I left my secondary school, like you today. At that time, I was 17 years old. Although I was at your age, my experience was very different from yours. My story is just a simple story, nothing fancy, nothing earth-shaking, nothing glamorous. It is a true story. It is not about success. It is about failure, and that the failure has changed my life in many ways. The reason I choose this story is that I believe failures and setbacks are always underappreciated and are often misunderstood especially by parents. Parents do not want their children to fail and protect them very well. But I think setbacks and failures are very worthwhile experiences.

So let me begin my story. Unlike nowadays, the society in Hong Kong at that time was less affluent, and most families were poor, including mine. I was from a typical family. I had a relatively good childhood. Actually, I had a very happy childhood. My whole childhood was my school life. I enjoyed playing with my classmates very much and I liked many school activities. The three activities I liked most in school were: recess, lunch hour, and after school. Like many of you here, I like sports. I played soccer, table tennis, and badminton. Sometimes I skipped classes to go fishing, swimming, and hiking. I loved to read books, but not the

school textbooks. I loved to read comic books. Those are the books that your parents and your teachers would not let you read. I liked movies of all kinds. I liked to build and take apart electronic gadgets. The only things I did not enjoy were schoolwork, and many of the boring classes.



At that age I was fearless, and I did not worry about consequence. I only did what I loved and I did not do what I did not love. That was my problem. As a result, I had very bad grades. I did not pay attention in class, I did not spend time doing my homework, and I did not prepare for examinations for many many years. Very often, I was detained after school because I failed to turn in my homework. I repeated one year. In Form 2, I must have broken my school records in the number of failed subjects. After the final examination in Form 2, I had a total of 7 subjects in red. For those who might not know, at that time teachers used fountain pens. If you failed, they used red ink. If you passed they used black ink. So I have a total of 7 subjects in red. My secondary graduating grades were so embarrassingly poor that the principal called me into her office and told me : "You should not take the university entrance examinations." I was actually quite happy; no more examination. At that time there were only 2 university entrance examinations. One was The University of Hong Kong and other was The Chinese University of Hong Kong. The principal said: "You should not take those examinations," knowing that I would fail. She was right, if I were to take those examinations, I would have failed miserably. I'm sure that Principal Lee here would have done the same thing if I were a student here. So at 17, I finished my secondary school, and I was at the end of my rope, things looked hopeless.

Being a poor student and failing to get into a university in Hong Kong, I could have started my career and looked for a job. I did not see it then, but this failure had turned out to be the best thing that had happened to me. It changed my life.

As I mentioned earlier, my family was poor, so my father borrowed money and sent me away. He borrowed enough money for one year's worth of expenses and sent me away to the United States. With my poor examination grades in secondary school, of course no top university would accept me, and scholarships were out of the question. So I happily left Hong Kong. After finishing my first year of college in the US, I had only \$50 US dollars in my pocket. That's all the money I had left after one year of study.

My back was against the wall again. It was a do-or-die situation. So without any choice, I found a free ride to New York City where I found myself a job. I worked there for 3 months, 6 days a week, 12 hours a day, to save up enough money for my second year of university study. It was a restaurant job and it started my career in the restaurant business. For the next seven years in college, I earned my way through university education from my bachelor's degree to PhD, working full-time in the summer and part-time during the school years, in restaurants. I worked as a dishwasher, a waiter, a cook, and a bartender. I knew everything about restaurant business. To earn a living in the restaurant was hard work. Most of my college friends at that time spent weekends at parties or in front of a television, while I spent most of my weekends working until 1am.

I had earned more than just money. I learned to endure, I learned to be efficient, I learned to be disciplined, I learned to be flexible, I learned how to talk to people of all kinds, and I learned how to deal with all kinds of difficult situations. Even though it was hard work, I loved it very much. I loved what I did and I was very good at it. I earned enough money to pay for all expenses for all seven years of my university education. Looking back, I've only done two types of jobs. Being a university professor and working in restaurants. I think I am a better restaurant worker than a professor.

During that time, I started to discover what I loved to do. In high school I didn't know what I liked. I just knew what I did not like and I did not do what I did not like. So during that period in the university, I tried different things, and finally discovered what I loved to do. I love to daydream, I love to explore new things, and I love to innovate and create. I went into computer science and engineering. That was my new found hobby. It had taken me many years to find what I like. I entered into one of the most creative periods of my life. After my university education, I started my research career. First at NASA, and then as a professor at the University of Wisconsin

for about 14 years, followed by teaching and research in Hong Kong University of Science and Technology for about 18 years, then The University of Hong Kong, and now Hong Kong Baptist University. And that's all; that is the end of my simple story.

If there is one message I want to leave with you today, it is the following. Setback or failure is part of our life experiences. It is a very important part of our experiences. So students and parents, especially parents, please encourage your children to receive failure or setback with open arms. This precious experience helps them to explore new things that they would never dream to encounter. It builds strength and it builds character.

This is a proud day for all of you. I hope all of you would find what you love to do. It took me many years to find what I love, and if you are lucky you will find it sooner. If you don't know what it is yet, don't worry now. Don't just conform to your parents' wishes and blindly go into an area you don't like. I assure you that you will find it eventually. It may take you a few years so keep looking until you find it, but please don't settle for less. So remember, do what you love and love what you do.

## 濟世為懷

## 甄偉政師兄專訪



甄偉政師兄於一九九七年入讀陳瑞祺（喇沙）書院，並在二零零一年原校升讀中六，期間擔任校刊中文部總編輯以及音樂學會副主席。其後在香港大學畢業，取得內外全科醫學士。畢業後接受為期六年的精神科專科培訓並取得精神科醫學執照，現於九龍醫院精神科擔任專科醫生。

## ◎ 從醫生活

甄師兄前後花十二年才成為執業精神科醫生，負責若八百多個個案，每日平均要看顧二至三十個病人。「工作雖然辛苦，但背後成功感卻與別不同。」甄師兄服務的對象大多是基層市民，需輪候多時方可得到治療，能夠服務真正有需要的人成為工作的原動力。在實習期間，甄師兄曾到懲教署轄下的小欖精神病康復中心為在囚人士提供精神治療，實習當中他看到精神問題較為嚴重的病人，甄師兄戲稱「比電影橋段有過之而無不及」，但他亦在實習中更確定自己成為精神科醫生的決心。

## ◎ 精神病迷思

「精神病不能根治、病情只會每況愈下、病患者有暴力傾向。」師兄指出一般人思想仍然停留在三四十年前，認為他們暴力、古怪，不應該施與援手，只要困住他們便可。「現時有不同的新式藥物，配合適當的輔導、治療，以及家人朋友的支持，便可以根治」。師兄認為大多數病患都是本質好的人，只是受病困擾而已，例如精神病與糖尿病都是長期病，而問題是精神病患被標籤，導致被社會歧視，是理解不足的問題。我們若能了解精神病，避免標籤病患，就已經能夠充分幫助他們。

## ◎ 學生生涯

師兄坦言自己於中一至中五「未開竅」，從未認真為自己作任何打算，在會考成績為二十三分（即五個乙等），到中六開始思考將來，發奮追回落後的進





度，最後得償所願，入讀香港大學內外全科。在課外活動方面，師兄在中六時參加中文辯論校隊、擔任校刊中文部總編輯及音樂學會副主席。他認為參加課外活動，能令自己對不同事物產生興趣，將自己的專注由玩樂轉向學習。「記得曾經有一條辯題為『己所不欲勿施於人』，而自己則站反方，比賽中需要逆向思維。」師兄認為在中學的生涯中，同學應嘗試參加不同課外活動，令自己留下回憶。

### ◎ 兄弟情

「長大以後最緬懷的是與兄弟的情誼。」甄師兄畢業多年，最要好的朋友仍是在陳瑞祺認識的朋友。此外師兄認為陳瑞祺最難能可貴的莫過於與兄弟之間的友誼。「中六至中七的時候，朋友之間會組成學習小組，互相分享筆記」他直言陳瑞祺的同學彼此大多坦誠相對，互相沒有猜忌之心。

### ◎ 讀書有法


現在很多人在課餘時會報讀不同補習課程，以提升學業成績，然而甄師兄卻有另一番看法。他認為補習的成本效益低，坊間補習社教授的內容與學校課程大同小異，不值得同學花費金錢和時間讀重複的內容。不如用這些時間備課溫習，使自己研習的進度比老師教授的快，並能誘發自己思考更多問題；反覆向自己提問能夠鞏固已有的知識，使得教與學效率事半功倍。師兄為了準備當年的公開試，曾完成過去超過十年的試卷，再背讀標準答案，分析當中出卷的規律，到了考試時能肯定自己的答題角度正確，減少失分率。甄師兄提點同學，背讀標準答案是在理解題目所問及清楚明白答案，而非單純背讀答案，死記硬背。師兄更提議同學可以組成學習小組，互相分享坊間筆記、解答其他同學的問題，利己利人。

### ◎ 給師弟的話

「我一直認為陳瑞祺的學生天資不比傳統名校差，只是不夠勤力而已。」甄師兄鼓勵師弟盡早找一個目標給自己追求，並且竭力追求，過後回首一望，自會發現辛勞是值得的，希望各位同學能夠加把勁朝向目標進發。

## 孜孜不怠

## 王嘉俊師兄專訪



**王**嘉俊師兄於一九八七年入讀陳瑞祺（喇沙）書院，並在一九九二年原校升讀中六，期間擔任校刊英文部總編輯以及風紀隊長。其後選讀香港大學電腦科學系，再於一九九五年轉至香港中文大學，取得藥劑科醫學士。畢業後於一九九九年獲得藥劑師的專業牌照，起初於萬寧任藥劑師，現為萬寧的行政人員。

## 成為藥劑師

王師兄放棄當時甚有前途的電腦科，而重新選擇自己的興趣——藥劑科。他獲得藥劑師專業牌照後的首份工作是在於一家維他命公司銷售產品，其後於萬寧擔任註冊藥劑師，現在於寫字樓擔任售賣產品的行政計劃人員。

他表示作為藥劑師能夠幫助他人解決健康問題，獲得不少滿足感。他說見到病人病況有所好轉，覺得這份工作很有意義。工作中最難忘的事情是2003年沙士爆發期，他指出當沙士病毒剛出現時，市民對此並不以為然，其後市民開始搶購板藍根、口罩以及其他藥物。期間，公司都抱著助人的心態出售相關藥物及產品，未曾想過利用沙士恐慌賺取暴利，公司於顧客心目中的地位也提升了不少。

## 藥劑師與醫生

也許許多人了解藥劑師的工作。王師兄告訴我們藥劑師有很多種類型。

當中在醫院中最常見的藥劑師負責按照醫生的

處方配藥，亦要按照自己的醫學知識，跟醫生相討有關病人的病情，為病人作出合適的藥物治療；另外，亦有責任提醒病人如何注意日常生活健康，藥物跟食物或健康食品的相互作用等。至於藥房的藥劑師，於社區作第一道醫療防線，為病人一些簡單的病情評估，為病人調配適當的藥物，如需要，建議病人作進一步的轉介。

王師兄指出藥劑師對藥物的專業，可輔助醫生，兩者互相合作才能達到救助病人的最大效益。

藥劑師亦可以致力開發藥物，但這方面的發展，外國較為成熟，香港現正漸漸追近外國的步伐。

外國的醫療政策為醫藥分家，病人可在醫院或診所看病，並於藥房取藥。藥劑師的查詢是免費的，能夠幫助大部分的基層市民。

建議有心成為藥劑師的師弟，要多留意藥劑師的工作種類及範圍，亦要抱著助人的無私精神。

## 學生生涯：

王師兄表示十分緬懷過去在陳瑞祺生活的日子，當中不少於陳瑞祺發生的難忘事情仍然是歷歷在目。雖然畢業廿多年，他仍然惦記昔日運動課時於課室內換運動服所擋不住的寒風；惦記昔日與同學於飯堂共享洋蔥汁雞腩飯的溫馨；惦記昔日與同學踢足球、打波；上課溫習

的那種兄弟情。王師兄曾經擔任過明愛賣物會的風紀幹事代表，負責收集物資、安排當日的義賣流程，他認為這些經驗難能可貴，因而十分珍惜每次的活動。

他亦表示對於過去自己過於文靜而感到遺憾，他表示自己只曾擔任過校刊主編輯、風紀及學會幹事，而甚少參加運動比賽，現在回想起來，十分惋惜，失去了一些可以留下美好時光。

### 讀書有法：

王師兄認為最有效的學習方法是備課，上課留心，下課溫習，複習整天所學的知識，鞏固對知識的記憶。他指出平日放學後的學習習慣為將課程的第一章第一節溫習至當天所學的章節，可見其學習的心得為堅持及努力。王師兄表示曾經亦參加過補習社的課程，他認為適量的補習，能夠為同學提供考試的技巧，長遠亦有助同學提升成績。他曾報讀過英文及數學補習課程，他認為補習有效於短時間內，為自己提供大量的學習資源及考試技巧。他表示現今的教育制度較為著重考試的技巧，而非學習的本意，補習風氣是大勢所趨而無可避免。總括而言，王師兄認為學習的最基本條件為投入時間及投入心機，發掘學習中的樂趣，從而提升學習的自主性及動力。

### 歸屬感：

陳瑞祺一直以歸屬感強為名，當中同學兄弟與兄弟之間的情誼，以及對老師的敬重之情，是

形成強烈歸屬感的不二要素。王師兄表示事隔多年仍然記掛他們朋友之間的兄弟情，亦記掛不少幫助過他的好老師。

### 給師弟的話：

求學階段時不應只顧學習，而不參加各式各樣的活動。反而應該利用這段時間嘗試接觸不同範疇及領域的事情，以尋找自己的興趣及目標，並享受學習及活動帶來的樂趣。在許可的



情況下，出國留學是不錯的選擇，師兄以自身的工作經驗，指出普遍到外國留學回流的學生，都對事物有更加新穎的看法及精闢的見解。王師兄建議師弟要放眼遠方，並應該以興趣優先，而前途為次要，去選擇自己修讀的科目。

物多樣性亦在制訂政策的範圍內，已有足夠保障，因而反對辯題。評判讚賞雙方同學態度積極，能有效回應對方觀點，即使大家都為初中同學，卻為現場同學帶來一場精彩的比賽。最後，比賽由正方三乙班勝出，並由正方結辯吳家睿同學奪得「最佳辯論員」獎項。

高中組題目為「知識能改變命運」，由正方五甲班對戰反方五丙班。兩隊參賽者中不乏辯論隊的隊員，令比賽更有趣味。正方先指出知識是理解及學習的成果，並提出多個例子支持辯題；而反方則指出命運包括人的一切遭遇，對生死的領悟及貧富逆差，並指出現時有許多大學生即使擁有高學歷仍處於貧窮情況。評判讚賞雙方隊員均能從不同角度分析辯題，能令同學反思，思考社會現況。而反方對命運的三種解釋亦令人眼前一亮。高中組比賽情況激烈，各位同學都投入於比賽之中。最後，比賽由正方五甲班勝出，並由正方結辯關正林奪得「最佳辯論員」獎項。


# 班際水運會



## 徵文比賽高級組冠軍

### 「保存古蹟及經濟發展」

香港的古蹟遺址就像四海兄弟一樣散佈各區，同時也是前人興建保留至今的建築和文化。保存古蹟這種行為往往為經濟發展成為對立點，在搗台上勝方往往是經濟發展。我卻認為過分發展經濟只是短期上增強香港的硬實力，卻把保存古蹟拋諸腦後。因此我認為保存古蹟較經濟發展重要。

首先，古蹟是香港人共同擁有的集體回憶，不應輕易被其他事凌駕之上。深水埗的雷生春建於一九四九年，當年雷瑞德中醫師興建雷生春用作醫館之用，到現時經過數次翻新和修葺後，在外貌上雖然沒有什麼大改變，但醫館的服務依舊保留。雷生春經過六十年的洗禮，已經為深水埗的居民留下深深的烙印。正因為港府妥善保存雷生春，雷生春才能保留其原貌並成為香港居民的集體回憶。

古蹟是前人保留下來的，不應因現時的經濟發展而推毀前人的心思。古語有云：「前人種樹，後人乘涼」，如果後代因為發展經濟而忽略保存古蹟，實在是不孝之舉啊！此外，後代保存古蹟實無旁貸，是香港後代應有的責任。二零零七年皇后碼頭被政府因為中環填海計劃清拆，市民都因為渴望挽留皇后碼頭的集體回憶紛紛上街遊行，要求政府擱置拆卸工程。遊行上街請願的市民雖然有強烈保護皇后碼頭的意志，卻阻止不了政府破壞香港市民傳承皇后碼頭的意志。難道古蹟的價值就這麼一文

不值，必須讓步給經濟發展嗎？

不僅如此，經濟發展影響的不單是古蹟，還影響著市場的生活素質。古蹟就是集體的記憶，不僅陪伴不少香港市民長大，還是歷史的見證。尖沙咀的鐘樓在海港城外屹立不倒，陪伴香港成長，成為了香港獨一無二的地標之一。正因為這個地標在香港經濟起飛時促進了旅遊業，帶起了旅遊業的發展。故此，經濟發展與保存古蹟是息息相關的，不能有所欠缺。

有時聽見別人說：「為了讓經濟更進一步發展，拆卸古蹟是逼不得已的。」香港現時依靠四大行業——即金融、旅遊、貿易和物流業支撐整個經濟，加上香港有地少人多這個絕無僅有的「特點」，才會選擇拆卸古蹟這條路。不過，我想反問有這個觀念的人，古蹟不能作為一件促進經濟的工具嗎？港府在不遠之時有推行古蹟旅遊，目的是要吸引旅客透過實地探訪古蹟，了解香港的歷史和現時的差別。另外，既然說古蹟是一個可以作旅遊的目的地，為什麼要拆卸它們呢？正如山頂凌霄閣，被發展成為商場，既可促進山頂的零售業，還可以促進旅遊業的發展，一舉兩得。

古人云：「以地事秦，猶抱薪救火，薪不盡，火不滅。」此句原本為貶義，薪代表侍奉秦的地，火代表秦國的慾望。但我們換個角度，換成褒義，薪代表保存古蹟，火代表傳承古蹟，

喻意將香港古蹟薪火相傳，就如我校的意志和理念一代一代傳承下去一樣。因此學校應舉行遊覽古蹟的活動，吸收古人的學問意志，再行動加以保存古蹟，達到薪火相傳的效果。不論學生或是老師都人人有責，你們還等什麼？快來行動保護前人的心血吧！

## 陳瑞祺(喇沙)書院 論證反駁有力致勝

■陳瑞祺(喇沙)書院提出合理反駁，成功推翻辯題。

正方王肇枝中學先指出香港回歸前，港督兼任大學校監旨在避免及防止行政及其他勢力干預大學。特區行政長官是由中央政府任命，特首必然有一定政治背景。如果校監政治背景不中立，大學自主權會被干預，有礙學術自由。

反方陳瑞祺(喇沙)書院表示，特首兼任大學校監並無衝突。廢除特首兼任大學校監制度，無非擔心特首會濫用校監之位濫權或達到某些政治目的，削弱校監權力便可解決問題。毋須一刀切廢除制度。再者，特首是香港首長，兼任大學校監是出於對大學的重視及尊重。

正方引用鍾庭耀與發達達華曾向港大校長及副校長施壓，要求停止有關行政長官及政府的民

意調查，例證特首兼任大學校監會窒礙學術自由；又提出亞洲地區例如日本、台灣及新加坡，當權者都不會兼任大學校監。反方反駁指即使不是特首兼任大學校監，如何確保校監的政治背景中立而不會干預校學學術自由。既然制度存有問題，理應修改而不是廢除。

評判表示，正方雖提出外國資料作例子，但未能詳盡闡述制度及效果。若能說明其他國家做法，可令論證更飽滿。反方能提出合理反駁，如將找政治背景中立的人的可能性及可行性，最終勝出。



## 第六屆政策青年研究高峰會

由香港中文大學學生會政治與行政學政策舉辦的第六屆政策青年研究高峰會，於二零一五年九月五日，香港中文大學鄭裕彤樓六號演講廳舉行。政策青年研究高峰會(Polyquest)為一項促進學生對時事認知的比賽，而這一年的比賽分為社會融合、長者福利以及廢物處理三個分類，參賽隊伍要選取其中一個分類，參加合共三次的工作坊及撰寫報告，並於各中學及大學隊伍，以及大學講師、博士以及教授面前前作報告，並需要回答各方隊伍的質問。而我校派出一組隊伍參加比賽，成員包括五乙班譚兆駿、五丙班李支民、五丁班侯爵丞、五丁班梁澤琛、五丁班任浩勤，並且於比賽中脫穎而出，獲得中學組第二名的佳績。



這次比賽，我們選取了「廢物管理」作為我們探究的議題，並且撰寫參加比賽的報告。現時，廢物問題於香港為迫切性極高的問題，香港人普遍欠缺前期減廢及後期回收處理的習慣，而且政府亦未有推行有關政策舒緩廢物問題；而透過參加有關工作坊及撰寫報告，使我們更為明白現時香港的廢物問題，了解廢物處理的不同出路，以及使我們對此作出關注。

最後我校成功躋身決賽，與其餘兩所中學同場較量。面對其餘高質素的中學生及大學生的報告，使我們能夠得悉到除了對議題的熟悉程度以及了解之外，演說技巧及匯報技巧亦是相當重要，缺一不可。匯報的形式亦仿如大專生及大學生一樣匯報，與平日於校內的匯報情況是南轅北轍，而是次比賽的得著除了是增加我們對於廢物管理的認識之外，還讓我們了解到天外有天，人外有人，參與是次長達半年的活動實屬難得，希望我校能參加更多公開的比賽，使同學能增廣見聞、拓闊視野。
