

# SCHOOL HISTORY

In April 1967 the Chan family approached the Jesuits to ask if they would be interested in taking over the running of a secondary school and move to the building which they intended to contribute in memory of their father, Mr. Chan Sui Ki, a successful merchant and one time President of the Tung Wah Group of Hospitals, a well-known charitable organization in Hong Kong. Not wishing to accept the offer themselves, Rev. Fr. Cronin, the Provincial, proposed the offer to the La Salle Brothers. Eventually, it was decided that La Salle College accept the offer and transfer the existing evening school operating in La Salle College to the new building. The evening school under the supervision of Brother Herman Fenton operated from 3:00 until about 8:00 p.m. The government would provide the site and an 80% subsidy. The Chan family would donate HK\$500,000.

In December, 1968 work began on the site. In April 1969 the foundation stone was laid by the then Director of Education, Mr. Gregg, and on September 3 the school moved into the classroom block with 951 students and 34 teachers all together. All the while work on the school hall and the laboratories, library, Geography Room, Art Room, etc. and the Brothers' Quarters (which unhappily provide an accommodation for only four) continued until December 12 when the Building Authority inspected the completed building in preparation for giving the final occupation permit. The official blessing and opening ceremony was performed on February 12, 1970 by Rev. Fr. Colombo P. P. and the Hon. J. Canning, Director of Education, respectively.

Together with her, give thanks for the precious gift of faith that you have received from your elders, and entrust your whole life to her. She is a good Mother who listens to you and embraces you, who loves you and walks together with you. I assure you that if you do that, you will not regret it.

# SUPERVISOR'S MESSAGE

Brother Lawrence, after having served our school for more than twenty years, initially principal, subsequently supervisor, and lastly school manager, has decided to totally withdraw from all administrative work at our school. Brother Lawrence has been a figure head of our school for some years and his presence signified the dedication of the La Salle Brothers in providing quality education for us.

We have the honour to welcome Mr Eric Ku, former principal of De La Salle Secondary School, NT, as the new Sponsoring Body Manager from this year. Mr Ku is also supervisor of Chan Sui Ki [La Salle] Primary School, and a school manager of St Joseph's College. This year Ms Janis Lo is elected parent manager to the school IMC while she was alternative parent manager last year.

Our school joined the Voluntary Optimization of Class Structure Scheme in 2011 and while we have four classes in all six forms now, it is time to redeploy some of the resources according to the current number of students and the selection of subjects by different students, in the light of the Senior Secondary Curriculum. Some subjects are more favoured by the students than others, as a result teachers' specialty and classrooms need to be adjusted and re-arranged to accommodate these gradual movements.


Over 200 delegates from nine countries in Asia attended the 9th Asia Pacific Lasallian Educators' Congress held in Malacca, Malaysia in December 2016. Our school sent Ms Serena Leung and Mr TS Wong to attend the congress. The theme of the conference was "Lasallians Working towards Justice and Peace". The presenters and some attendees shared their views on how justice and peace could be promoted and implemented in Lasallian schools. As the song "We are Lasallians" writes, "We are one but we are many", these nine countries represent a rich mix of races, cultures and religions. On the last day of the trip, the Hong Kong delegates visited

St Joseph's Institution International Malaysia [SJIM] located in Kuala Lumpur, a newly opened Lasallian international school. The new school provides education from kindergarten to senior high level, infused with Lasallian faith and caring. The SJIM is headed by Brother Thomas Lavin, former supervisor of La Salle College, Kowloon, as Brother President.

Love is the greatest of all virtues. God, the source of life and goodness, has created everything out of love, and has called the whole human family to be His children. We teach our students to love God, to share God's happiness and to love their neighbours. The practice of all the virtues is to be inspired and motivated by love, so that all aspects of life and interpersonal relationship can be bound together.

This year our school achieved excellent results in some of the competitions we have entered. We finished as the champion at the Hong Kong Island and Kowloon Secondary Schools Tenpin Bowling Competition BOCHK Cup, beating some other 25 schools. It is envisaged that we will achieve outstanding results in the coming few years with the same strong team. Other champions for our school this year include the Hong Kong Secondary Schools Debating Competition (English section) - champion for Kowloon Senior Division 1 and champion for Hong Kong and Kowloon Division 1 Middle.

Our school was founded by Brother Herman in 1969, and we are now two years away from our 50th anniversary in 2019. Amazingly we had full F.1 to F.6 classes when we opened the door in September 1969, because most students were transferred directly from La Salle Evening School. To commemorate this milestone event of golden jubilee of the school, a special anniversary organizing committee has been set up comprising various stakeholders to spearhead the celebration events. More details will be revealed when we approach 2019.

ethical IT users who are ready to take up challenges in the digital era.

The Lasallian Education Council is going to conduct a review of the long term viability and vitality of Lasallian schools in Hong

Kong. In this connection, our school is going to undertake an analysis of its strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats, and a critical examination of its positioning in future years and the strategies to achieve that positioning. Let us be tuned in to it.

The variety and creativity of the articles and events in this publication represent the talents of our students. A publication of this nature is often an intense effort. My special thanks go to the members of the Editorial Board and their teacher advisors for their endless energy in making the School Magazine possible. # SPEECH DAY 2017



## Speech by Br Edmundo Fernandez FSC Visitor of the Lasallian East Asia District

Brothers Patrick Tierney and Christopher Soosai; our principal Mr. TL Lee; Mr. Chan King-Luen, benefactor; Mr. Larry Fan, president of the Old Boys' Association; Ms Louie Wai-Fun, chair of the PTA; members of the LEC and the CSK Management Committee; honored guests; my colleagues in the teaching vocation; dear students.

In preparing for today I looked at your school website. Like most schools that trace its roots to our Founder St. John Baptist DLS, the Spirit of Faith and Love, and the Spirit of Zeal and Service are central to our pedagogical thrust and crucial to the educational experience we give to our students. And I was happy to see that in your mission and vision page.

To our graduating students allow me to share with you two things:

First, learn what failure is all about. Learn what failure is all about because failure and success are two sides of the same face. You will

not understand what it is to succeed if you have not failed. As one writer says, "have the courage to fail". But failure hardens us and teaches us a lot of things that success does not. It strips us of what is not essential. It forces us to come to terms with who we are and what we are or who we are NOT and what we are NOT. As the author of the Harry Potter series, JK Rowling, writes: "Failure gave me an inner security I had never attained by passing examinations. Failure taught me things about myself that I could have

learned no other way. I discovered that I had a strong will, and more discipline than I had suspected... you will never truly know yourself, or the strength of your relationships, until both have been tested by adversity. Such knowledge is a true gift, for all that it is painfully won, and it has been worth more than any qualification I ever earned."

So do not fear failure for it may be your best teacher yet.





Second, strive to be men and women of integrity. The quality of integrity implies honesty, truthfulness and having the capability to abide by strong moral principles and / or a set of core values. However one important and crucial aspect of integrity is consistency, the ability to always, under whatever circumstances, remain honest and truthful. A person of integrity therefore is not honest and truthful sometimes. A person of integrity is honest and truthful all the time, every time, with everyone and in whatever situation. It is interesting to note that the word 'integrity' derives its roots from the Latin word 'integer' which means whole. A state of Integrity thus implies wholeness and a state of being complete and undivided. We become wholly human, fully human, fully alive, whole and complete if we strive to live lives of integrity.

In a world where small lies and deceptions are accepted, where seemingly innocuous misconduct and indiscretions are brushed aside because everyone does them anyway, to be a person of honesty and truthfulness is not easy. It is not easy to say no to friends because we like to be liked and we need to belong but sometimes that's where it starts. Learn to say no to friends when you need to. We are neither asking you to be a saint (as none of us are) nor to be self righteous just to make an effort to be consistent about being honest and truthful. Perhaps our world may be a kinder and better place.

Let me end by going back to the first reflection on success and failure. Success doesn't mean having a lot of money or owning a lot of things. It is good to live a life of comfort to help us in our work and relations but I hope you never equate success with being rich. However, if you've made an effort to live a life of honesty and truthfulness; if you have made a positive impact on the lives of those you have come across; if you have shown kindness and love with those you have dealt with, and made your parents and your children proud of you—that is what I call a successful life!

I wish to congratulate all of you. You will be in our thoughts and in our prayers.

More than ten Catholic schools joined the camp. Through playing games, participants could know about the church.




## *Retreat*


## *Lasallian Youth Gathering*

# DRAMA




The production turned out to be a great success although the preraration time was limited. Despite the grueling rehearsals and preparation work ,we enjoyed the time very much . We held one annual

# AFS EXCHANGE PROGRAM

## Interview with Arturo Villegas Lopez



### **R: How do you feel about your life in Hong Kong?**

**I:** My life here is undoubtedly very fruitful especially because I can experience traditional cultures of Hong Kong and meeting new friends. At first, I feel formidable to get used to the hectic lifestyle of HongKongers, but I began to get deeply immersed in it later on.

### **R: What do you want to share with our CSK family?**

**I:** I am much honored to be one of the "boys in red". In the first few months, I couldn't get along with my classmates because I am a bit shy. However, I feel great of being a CSK boy later on owing to the learning environment here. CSK boys take pride in themselves and do everything as one, as a family. That is what I can't experience in Mexico.

### **R: Is there anything you don't like about Hong Kong's education system, especially in CSK?**

**I:** I generally like here more than Mexico, because I feel much comfortable and relaxed studying by myself in the library. In contrast, Mexican

education system gives me great pressure stemming from my parents and teachers. Nonetheless, I need to go to school very early, which is totally different from Hong Kong—around 8pm. However, there is one thing I dislike. For instance, the schoolday period is too long for me.

### **R: Do you miss home?**

**I:** In spite of the fruitful life here, I also can't beat my homesickness sometimes. Once a week, I contact my parents and relatives by face-time apps. I'll share my experience and my current situation with them too.

### **R: What do you like about Hong Kong?**

**I:** Firstly, there are multifarious ready-to-eat snacks and a wide variety of delicious food in Hong Kong, I like dim sum most because they are tasty and nevertheless, a new thing to me. Also, I feel safe in Hong Kong. In comparison with Mexico, there are relatively fewer terrorist attacks and lower crime rate. It makes me feel warm and safe just like home.

### **R: Have you tried any traditional food in Hong Kong?**

**I:** Yes, I have tried many kinds of tasty food in Hong Kong and I love them very much as the taste of Chinese food is really different from that in Mexico. I especially like dim sum in the Chinese restaurant, as they are particularly delicious and I think it's the most unique food in Hong Kong.

### **R: What subjects do you choose to study in CSK this year?**

**I:** I have chosen Maths, ICT, English and Chemistry.

The contents here are easier those that in Mexico so I can handle the syllabus of different subjects with ease. Although I didn't choose Chinese, I think Cantonese and Chinese Language is very complicated to learn because there are so many words and it is really hard for foreigners to handle it.

**R: Do you like Hong Kong's education system and our students?**

**I:** Yes, as school starts at 6:50am in Mexico but I need to go to school at 8:00am in Hong Kong instead, so I think the students here need not rush to go to school. Also, I like the classmates and the learning atmosphere here because the classmates in CSK are kind and they are willing to teach me when I have difficulties. And I am glad to hear that there are regular tests in Hong Kong because I think students can have more opportunities to practise and familiarise themselves with the knowledge regularly. So, Hong Kong's education system is good for students.

**R: Where do you live in Hong Kong and how do you go to school in these days?**

**I:** I live in To Kwa Wan with my host family and I go to school on foot every morning, so it is very convenient for me to travel from my home to CSK. When it is raining cats and dogs, I will take a taxi.

**R: Do you enjoy studying in CSK?**

**I:** Yes, because I like the environment and the facilities in CSK, which give me a comfortable place to learn and live. Also, I am proud of being a CSK student as I like the feeling of community and big family. And the teachers here are patient when I have difficulties in different subjects.

**R: If you have another opportunity to study abroad, which country will you choose?**

**I:** I think I will choose Japan, because it is safe to live there and their education system is well-developed. The reason why I don't choose to study in European countries is that there are a lot of terrorist attacks and it's dangerous to stay there. Japan is a good place with their own traditions and they are really attractive.

Support from English and Chinese Debate Team

The English Debate Team was established 4 years ago. Recruiting debaters was an uphill battle at the beginning because students had no idea what an English debate was. Also, students were generally very busy with their studies and other extra-curricular activities. Therefore, there was only one senior team with 4 members that time. However, there are two teams now, 1 senior team and 1 junior team.

The debate coach for the senior team, Ms Y M Lee, and that of the junior team, Ms H K Wong, share the same vision as to how engaging students in English debates can help them sharpen their language skills and grow. The benefits debating bring to students are unquestionable. Students learn to think systematically and express themselves clearly in English. They have to read a lot to prepare for a debate. Once a debater in the team claimed that the reading he did for one debate was the same amount of reading he did in one year. The truth is the team was given only a short time to prepare for the debate. Topics can be related to very complicated issues like the Apology Bill, legislation against insulting the Police, e-waste, gender equality, etc. Through reading information regarding the topics, students learn a lot about the world around them. Another challenge for students is meeting deadlines. It is of paramount importance and all debaters should work collaboratively. Therefore, engaging in English debates is demanding. Students are pushed to their limits. Their English language ability is obviously enhanced with their efforts put. As English

is a second language of all our students, this makes it more difficult for them to win. In order to win a debate, students' perceptiveness is important. They have to listen carefully and correlate what they have prepared with the points raised by their opponents. Teamwork should also be displayed in a debate. All debaters should stand on the same ground when they are pointing their spears at the misconceptions or fallacies of the opponents. They have to be familiar with all the materials prepared in order to convince the adjudicators that their case is valid.

The most memorable moment this year was the debate against Diocesan Boy's School. As one of the debaters is a Secondary 6 student and he was

going to take the HKDSE examination, the debate coach offered to him that he could ask another debater to replace him. However, this S6 debater simply said he was in because he would like to defeat the opposing team. He said he had prepared very well for the HKDSE examination and he did not want to miss this once-in-a-life-time opportunity.

This immediately brought impetus to the whole team. Everybody worked extremely hard for the sacrifice of him. Team spirit was demonstrated to the fullest. Isn't he a role model for students? The team finally won the debate and the captain, Merton, got two awards – the Best Debater and the Best Interrogative Debater.

# HONG KONG OLYMPIAD IN INFORMATICS

Ten ICT students joined the Hong Kong Olympiad in Informatics 2016/17 and five of them entered the final. Finally, Yam Ho Kan (6D) received a bronze medal in the senior section. 

## 天行健，君子以自強不息

**陳**國明師兄在1971年於本校畢業，於約20年前發現患有慢性腎病，幸於09年半年前得到合適腎臟移植。近年陳師兄一直致力宣傳器官捐贈，貢獻社會。

「在 我讀書的時候，山坡上沒有建圍欄，同學可以直接在山上爬落球場。」闊別校園多年，今次重臨母校，陳師兄感嘆時光飛逝，學園的一草一木都和以往截然不同。在和陳師兄的交談中，我們了解到瑞祺以往的面貌，灰白的牆身、修士……但瑞祺傳統精神卻是不變。當被問到學生的印象，師兄說道：「男生活躍好動，一時搗蛋是難免的，不過瑞祺男兒熱衷運動，我加入過足球隊，班際、學界等都有參與過。當時班際長跑……」訪問中，我和同伴都發覺即使過了數十載，瑞祺仔的特質依然不變。

**問** 到最感激的老師，陳師兄坦言有兩位老師對他影響最深，分別是李炳強先生（李炳強先生曾任本校校長）和Ms. Tehmi。李炳強先生是陳師兄的班主任以及數學老師，師兄說李老師對學生關懷無微不至。而Ms. Tehmi則是一位印度籍英文老師，她對學生循循善誘，悉心教導，負責任教相對困難的外語科，令師兄印象深刻。

**陳** 師兄熱愛運動，尤其是跑步，大大小小、國內國外的馬拉松比賽師兄都曾參加，訪問數天前，師兄剛完成一項在澳洲舉辦的馬拉松。望着眼前健壯精神的師兄，誰又想到二十年前一次與兒子踢足球的意外，會令師兄發現身體的內在隱疾。「日常有持續鍛煉和運動，沒想到竟然會患有慢性腎病。」不過師兄並未因此氣餒，更在大約六年前，師兄幸運得到腎臟移植。

「**器** 官移植後，一切要從頭開始學習，如行路、飲食……」手術後陳師兄




對健康更加著重，而且更燃起貢獻社會的心志。師兄直言有幸得到器官移植，使生命得以延續，令他感到器官捐贈的偉大。「以往做運動，參加比賽，為求鍛煉突破自己，而現在則同時想社會大眾多關注器官捐贈。」

本年4月，58歲的陳師兄與另一位換腎者吳俊霆及香港移植運動協會創會主席黃炎華一同踏上登珠穆朗瑪峰之路。師兄說登山前需要接受一些相關課程，旅程中每日需步行約6個小時，登山時更遇上了曾燕紅老師等人。而最難忘的則是高山反應，「有人因為高山反應缺氧而要中途下山……高山反應更令人思想緩慢，說話要經過思考，亦有點呆滯，挺有趣的！」

妻子的支持加上日常的鍛煉，陳師兄終與同伴登上5334米的珠峰基地營，作為本港首位器官移植後登上珠峰者，師兄坦言無論對個人抑或宣傳器官捐贈而言都是一大突破，師兄亦望此事能令社會看見接受器官移植者康復後的生活色彩。

訪問尾聲，陳師兄說腎病令他有著諸多不便，但卻為他帶來了更充實的人生和目標，師兄亦寄語瑞祺仔不論現在或將來，都要不忘貢獻社會。

## 黃獎先生專訪



**黃** 獎先生於一九七八年入讀陳瑞祺（喇沙）書院，並在一九八五年離開本校，其後在香港理工大學設計學院畢業。畢業後一直從事廣告行業，於二零一一年開始出版工作，創辦《萌動雙月刊》，其著作更有玄俠小說《首誌封神》、歷史揭祕《潮讀4000年》等。

### 瑞祺回憶

**黃** 師兄坦言入讀男校的確會比男女校較為沉悶，但入讀陳瑞祺卻令他忘記這個感覺，各式各樣的活動令他忘記了自己正在就讀男校，以聯校活動為例，「那時手機還沒有普及，因此不能像現在隨時隨地發訊息。」科技尚未普及及師兄凡事也會親力親為，例如寫信

給鄰校女生，他笑言這也是當時的解悶方法。師兄更說當時曾找漫畫家王司馬（著名漫畫牛仔的作者）。而最令師兄難忘的事莫過於曾在中五時留班，而且更是他要求校長讓他重讀追回進度，最後成功入讀香港理工大學。

### 從事廣告

**大** 學畢業後，黃師兄先是從事廣告製作，師兄直言廣告工作雖然收入甚佳，亦令他遇上不少特別人士，但卻十分忙碌。「市場需求大，收入自然多了。而廣告業亦令我遇上不少名人，記得有一次與詹瑞文合作……不過此行業真的很繁忙，特別是旺季時，要不停加班！」

### 投身文壇

**因** 為多年從事廣告創作令黃師兄有着不俗的積蓄，加上上述廣告業的繁忙，使師兄於近年毅然投身文字創作行業。「當人到了有一定年紀而物質生活又許可，便會嘗試一些新事物。」師兄更坦言寫作一直是他的興趣，並於二零一一年創辦《萌動雙月刊》讓學生投稿，並同年創作玄俠小說《首誌封神》，翌年更獲倪匡先生授權，續寫《非人協會》。

### 給師弟的話

**近** 年黃獎師兄致力於不同學校間，推廣閱讀和寫作心得，鼓勵學生多讀多寫。於訪問尾聲，師兄不忘提醒師弟們「不要因為資歷不足，經驗不夠就寫不出好文章，學生很多時只是不適應考試制度的作文科而已，緊記多嘗試便會有進步！」

## 范文豪老師專訪

**說** 起范文豪老師，我們必定想起他瀟灑時尚、瀟灑可親的一面。關於他在母校的經歷，我們又會認識多少呢？范老師在一九九五年於母校預科畢業，完成學位課程後不久就返回母校任教英文科和經濟及公共事務科，現今主要教授英文科和綜合人文科。

### 校園點滴

**范** 老師記起從前在母校就讀時的校規比現今簡單。「從前學校規條不多，沒有學生手冊、沒有學生會、沒有留堂班，甚至學校通訊也不常有。」范老師認為母校校風比其他學校簡單、自由。

**范** 老師記起那年的秋季旅行，同學做了一些頑皮的事，結果被老師責罵。現在范老師和同學敘舊時也必提起，實在令他畢生難忘。

**范** 老師自謙地提及他在中學時期的成績尚可，尤對語文科目甚感興趣。他感激當時受到一位任教英文老師啟導，令他對語文產生了興趣。「他能深入淺出說道理，言簡意賅，而任教也十分有效率，他是我的恩師」。

### 回到母校任教

**范** 老師沒有料到自己會投身於教育界，能夠擔任老師只是一場機緣巧合。「當時我正從事推銷工作，適逢學校一位老師引薦到母校任教。我亦放膽一試，遞交了履歷表，結果幸運地就被學校取錄了。」范老師更笑言自己性格內向，一直來都不想轉變工作環境，結果就擔任了老師十七年。

**然** 而，老師這份職業並不是他的夢想，當然會帶給他沉悶的感覺。「身為一位老師，每天都要依循工作規律，遊走於課室授課，批改作業，因此工作上並沒有甚麼驚喜。」凡事都要兩面看，雖然老師這份職業讓他感到無趣，但卻為他帶來一種安穩的感覺。「從九月至六月，陸運會的時間，定好了；考試的時間，已定好了；假期的時間，也定好了。我只要看着學校所編制校曆表工作便可，沒有甚麼事情要我憂慮。加上學校較少有突發事件發生，最多只是頑皮的同學弄破課室的空窗、搗碎課室門上的玻璃等，因此當上老師給我的感覺是安全的。」范老師亦盼望著，假如再一次轉業的機會，他想他應該選擇從事表演行業，因為他認為這些行業比老師更為有趣，而且也是他的夢想。

### 瑞祺的轉變

**范** 老師記起以往校規沒有像現時般嚴謹，例如可以穿著貼身的校褲。而且當時老師十分親切，關心和留意同學的日常大小事，令關係融洽，亦師亦友。

**范** 老師亦指出，隨着社會轉變，學校對學生都多了關顧。為了使家長安心及加強教育。所以現在的校規比以往嚴謹。

**范** 老師感歎現今瑞祺學生比較被動。回想當時學生十分主動，例如他們會主動地處理班務、班衫的設計、決定旅行地點的選擇，完全不用老師的協助。可是，現在的同學可能比以前害羞，不敢主動安排，所以經常需要老師多一點的照顧。

### 在瑞祺中的得著

**陪** 伴着范老師七年的中學生涯，到現在已是第十七年頭在母校渡過的教學生涯。當老師提及在母校的得著時，他說：「瑞祺不僅教授我知識，而且還教導我正確的人生觀，現在還給我一個安穩的工作和生活，讓我把握這份情和愛及至我從前所學到的，一一傳授給我們的師弟！」

### 工作的苦與樂


**范** 老師談及工作的苦澀時，苦笑地指出現時我學校學生的質素參差，受到派位組別的影響而有所下降。他又指出同學缺乏主動，懶得幫助構思活動，老師往往要主導學生的事務，間接為老師增添了不少的工作量。

但當話題轉移至工作的快樂時，范老師表現得十分積極。「當我回顧我任教過的學生成長時，喜幸他們有明顯改變，一些原本資質平庸的學生，最終也能夠踏入大學、一些學生更在大學的研究院工作。我最近亦參加了不少婚禮，看見學生們有所成長，有些更已經生兒育女，成為了好爸爸。我希望可以教授他們的下一代，把陳瑞祺一代傳一代，感覺十分奇妙的。」

除了教學外，范老師也負責安排海外遊學團，例如參觀台灣、英國等。范老師認為這除了能夠令他看到同學的別一面之外，還能和學生一起遊玩、探索，及認識不同的國家，建立良好的師生關係。

### 對同學的寄語

近年來，范老師經常聽到學生說「中興瑞祺」這四字詞，因此特別對此有感。他認為學生要言出必行，否則一切的宣傳也是徒然。「我們不能單靠喊口號或製作旗幟，我們必須有宏大的決心，例如運動隊要勤力練習，重上甲級組別；同學要努力學習，提高學校入大學率。」在現今學校成績倒退的情況下，范老師仍樂觀面對事實，希望同學能做好自己本份。學校是為學生提供教育的地方，是大型補習社不能做到的。這種教育非單指訓練學生在考試中爭取好成績，還要培養學生責任感、誠實等品格。培養學生成為一個好人，日後為社會作出貢獻。」因此，范老師不希望「中興瑞祺」只是回復二十年的光輝的時候，還要學生有良好的品格。



最後，他盼望著母校莘莘學子們要有自信，不要妄自菲薄。「現時瑞祺學生較為粗枝大葉，不論是行為或態度，也經常給別人的壞印象。學生穿上了校服就要是一個有教養的人，應給別人覺得是有自信的，而不是粗俗鄙陋之感。因此，同學須注重自己的言行，做一個有品德的人。」

# 成功在望獎勵計劃2016

GE 麥嘉棟——優異獎，獲得書券\$2000  
GC 黃建徽——卓越獎，獲得「成功在望獎勵金\$10,000，並晉身最後20強，於來年競逐「生涯規劃大獎」，有機會榮獲「成功在望獎勵金\$30,000」。

## 韓流在香港

韓

港只有電子藝術值得欣賞，因為這只是整個韓國文化的冰山一角。韓國流行文化之所以能在香港成功，是因為它的背後有整個韓國政府支持。政府每年都投放大筆資金於資助這些資訊傳媒上，於是電視台或製片公司就能製作出精巧的電視劇和電影。除了政府的資金援助外，韓劇的影星知名度也同樣重要，而韓國人也確實在樣貌上不可挑剔。一般明星都要有潛質，例如是人品或是樣貌。韓國還有著數以萬計的美容院，而很多明星都是在那裡誕生。所以說，機構有了政府的支持，韓星又有出眾的相貌，韓流在香港怎能不成功？

韓

國流行文化的引入豐富了我們的見識，擴闊我們的視野，充實了我們的生活。我們得到了精神上的滿足，也被這些千變萬化的東西迷得眼花繚亂。生活中處處都是人們沉迷於韓流的例子：巴士車殼上印著的巨幅韓國歌星演唱會海報、街上各式各樣的韓式小食店、學生們日常的打扮；日常聽的歌曲、電視上放映的韓國愛情電影和韓星代言廣告、衣舖裡售賣的韓式服裝，甚至有時候也成為街坊鄰里討論的話題。我們居住的地方被各種各樣的「韓潮」所沖刷著，誇張的說可以用「沒有看不見的，只有想不到的」來形容。

## 「韓」

是韓風是一把雙刃劍。它能提升你的生活品質，自然也能腐蝕你的心靈，使你的內心變得空虛。我每每在大街上都能遇見那些急匆匆去演唱會的支持者。有一些不那麼理智的學生在聽了幾首韓國歌曲後就無法自拔，就急著要去演唱會買門票支持偶像。在我看來這是莫名其妙的悲哀。因為追隨文化雖然值得稱許，但也不應該走火入魔。為了看到偶像一面，不少青少年就不顧家人或朋友的勸阻，就這麼花掉了成百甚至上千元，在我看來這又是多麼的不值！藝術這種東西感受一下就很足夠了，實在不應該花錢。

## 另

外，韓國潮流和歐美潮流、日本文化等，都是在較短時間內就深深紮根香港，獲得不少同輩的熱烈追捧。但「韓流」的獨特風格今年才興起，會不會被其它新興的潮流文

化所取代？新潮只是會維持一段時間的潮流而已，不能代表一個時代，相信大家都有清晰的認識。香港現在流行的韓風只會紅極一時，猶如曇花一現般，終究還是會過去。以後的香港人還會如此熱烈地推崇韓風嗎？答案是不太可能的。

## 聽

著韓語流行歌曲，我一邊抄寫作業。我想：「韓風」距離自己是這麼的近，又那麼的遠。放下手中緊扣著的原子筆，我感慨了：現在的日本動漫和韓風這麼新潮，以後又有什麼動漫或什麼風來取以代之呢？韓國流行文化在我們的心中日益重要，伴隨著韓流周邊產品的日益增多，使用的人也多了。再深層思考一下：
