POPE'S LETTER TO YOUNG PEOPLE

“Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you”

[Genesis 12.1].

My Dear Young People,

I am pleased to announce that in October 2018 a Synod of Bishops will take place to treat the topic: “Young People, the Faith and Vocational Discernment.” I wanted you to be the centre of attention, because you are in my heart. Today, the Preparatory Document is being presented, a document which I am also entrusting to you as your “compass” on this synodal journey.



I am reminded of the words which God spoke to Abraham: “Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you” (Gen 12.1). These words are now also addressed to you. They are words of a Father who invites you to “go,” to set out towards a future which is unknown but one which will surely lead to fulfilment, a future towards which He Himself accompanies you. I invite you to hear God's voice resounding in your heart through the breath of the Holy Spirit.

When God said to Abram, “Go!”, what did he want to say? He certainly did not say to distance himself from

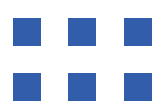
his family or withdraw from the world. Abram received a compelling invitation, a challenge, to leave everything and go to a new land. What is this “new land” for us today, if not a more just and friendly society which you, young people, deeply desire and wish to build to the very ends of the earth?

But unfortunately, today, “Go!” also has a different meaning, namely, that of abuse of power, injustice and

war. Many among you are subjected to the real threat of violence and forced to flee their native land. Their cry goes up to God, like that of Israel, when the people were enslaved and oppressed by Pharaoh (cf. Ex 2:23).

I would also remind you of the words that Jesus once said to the disciples who asked him: “Teacher . . . where are you staying?” He replied, “Come and see” (Jn 1:38).

Jesus looks at you and invites you to go with him. Dear young people, have you noticed this look towards you? Have you heard this voice? Have you felt this urge to undertake this journey? I am sure that, despite the noise and confusion seemingly prevalent in the world, this call continues to resonate in the depths of your heart so as to open it to joy in its fullness. This will be possible to the extent that, even with professional guides, you will learn how to undertake a journey of discernment to discover God's plan in your life. Even when the journey is uncertain and you fall, God, rich in mercy, will extend his hand to pick you up.



In Krakow, at the opening of the last World Youth Day, I asked you several times: “Can we change things?” And you shouted: “yes!” That shout came from your young and youthful hearts, which do not tolerate injustice and cannot bow to a “throw-away culture” nor give in to the globalization of indifference. Listen to the cry arising from your inner selves! Even when you feel, like the prophet Jeremiah, the inexperience of youth, God encourages you to go where He sends you: “Do not be afraid . . . because I am with you to deliver you” (Jer 1:8).

A better world can be built also as a result of your efforts, your desire to change and your generosity. Do not be afraid to listen to the Spirit who proposes bold choices; do not delay when your conscience asks you to take risks in following the Master. The Church also wishes to listen to your voice, your sensitivities and your faith; even your doubts and your criticism. Make your voice heard, let it resonate in communities and let it be heard by your shepherds of souls. St. Benedict urged the abbots to consult, even the young, before any important decision, because “the Lord often reveals to the younger what is best” (Rule of St. Benedict, III, 3).

Such is the case, even in the journey of this Synod. My brother bishops and I want even more to “work with you for your joy” (2 Cor 1:24). I entrust you to Mary of Nazareth, a young person like yourselves, whom God beheld lovingly, so she might take your hand and guide you to the joy of fully and generously responding to God’s call with the words: “Here I am” (cf. Lk 1:38).

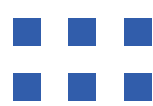

SUPERVISOR'S MESSAGE

While the school has started preparing for the 50th anniversary celebration, some rigorous evaluation and review exercises have been underway during the year. The exercise that has the most extensive and far-reaching effect on our school is the Viability and Vitality Study, followed by the External School Review.

The Viability and Vitality Study is a Lasallian East Asia District (LEAD) initiative. In Hong Kong, each Lasallian school formed a team to look into various aspects of the school, and devises a long term plan to achieve a preset position. The Hong Kong Lasallian family will then formulate a wider scope of plan for the development of Lasallian mission in Hong Kong. This is an important study conducted by the De La Salle Brothers for the East Asia region. Once the Viability and Vitality Study is completed, our school will embark on a journey to materialize its envisioned position.

After eight years from the last visit, the External School Review Team of the Education Bureau visited our school in December, 2017. It is a school-wide review conducted by some experts in the industry. The review included observations of class lessons and activities, and meeting with the IMC managers, teachers, parents and students. The report provided by the ESR team affirms the effort of our school in teaching and learning, and provides recommendations for our school to improve. We will value those suggestions that deem applicable and valuable, and implement in line with the Viability and Vitality Study.

STEM, a recently emerged acronym, stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics. Because of the change into New School System a few years ago, the number of students who enrolled in science subjects has been decreasing gradually over the years. With the promotion of STEM, the desire to pursue those science subjects with more practical usage has become stable. Hardware infrastructure including WiFi has been put in place in the school premises to facilitate e-teaching and learning.



A pastoral assistant joined us three years ago, helping the school to organize religious activities. Over the past few years we saw more religious events, masses, and retreats being held for students. These activities provide environment for students to meditate for the meaning of a spiritual life.

Life is a priceless gift from God and is sacred in itself. Every human person is created by God and has the right to life, which must be respected from its conception to its natural end. Every person is entitled to have whatever is necessary for a decent and dignified existence. Only a society which respects human life can bring happiness to all.

This year our school has performed well in various sports competitions. Although we did not secure any major championship, we did well in some grades in individual competitions. Keep the good work up and we will come back next year.

This year we have to bid farewell to Mr KS Chan, our vice principal, and Ms Lily Leung, our religious subject head. Both of them have served CSK for more than 30 years and are retiring after this school year. I hereby wish them well and have enjoyable years to come. At the same time I would also like to congratulate Ms Fiona Lee who will be our next vice principal (pastoral).

Our school will be celebrating its 50th birthday in the 2019-2020 academic year. Various committees have been set up to carry out different functions in preparation for the celebrating events. There will not be too many events but everyone of them is important and sure to attract participants. Being set up concurrently is the Golden Jubilee Fund, which is an endowment fund and a long term commitment with an aim to provide additional funding to the school for undertakings beneficial to our students.

Finally I would like to thank all those students and teachers who have done a great job in the publication of this School Magazine.

EDITORIAL BOARD

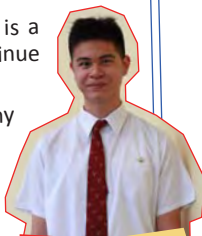
"Publication is a marathon, not a sprint. Writing the book is only the start."

SPEECH DAY 2018

Speech by Professor Tong Chong Sze

The Vice President (Administration & Development) of the Open University of Hong Kong



Principal Mr. Lee Ting Leung, dear supervisor, distinguished guests, teachers, parents, and most important of all, dear graduates,

Good evening. First of all, I would like to thank Principal Lee for your kind invitation. One of my best friends from Cambridge was a Lasallian. In fact, I would say he was my benefactor, as it was he who introduced my wife to me! I had always admired his energy and his commitment to the community and I always wanted to understand the Lasallian spirit better. So I am very happy and honoured to be invited to visit your school and to talk to your students.

Lessons from the World Cup

And today, I want to talk to you about the World Cup. This World Cup has been full of surprises. The top teams, including the reigning World Cup holder and world number 1, Germany, is out of the World Cup. Portugal, ranked number 3, with possibly the world's best football player, C. Ronaldo, is out. Argentina, ranked number 4, featuring Messi, 5 times FIFA world football player of the year, and some say the greatest player of all time, is also out of the Cup.

But today, I want to talk about the game between Spain and Russia. Spain, World Cup winner of 2010, and

currently ranked number 8 in the world was knocked out by lowly ranked Russia (number 65) in the round of last 16. How could that happen? For those of you who have watched the game, it was clear that man for man, Russia is no match for Spain. Every member of the Spanish team is a star, while hardly anyone on the Russian team is known. What do these results tell us?

As the saying goes, the ball is round and there are many surprises

in store. Things never go as "scripted" and results are never determined by rankings! But just how did Russia defied the odds and knocked Spain out of the World Cup? I think there were three important elements. Firstly, the Russian team had a lot of faith in their strategy. They don't have individual football skills so they focussed on their strength in defending, going for a draw and hoping to win in the penalty shoot out. Interesting, their goalkeeper had to work full time as Spain dominated the game and it probably helped him to be fired up and ready to become the hero in the penalty shoot out; by contrast, Spain's goalkeeper had virtually nothing to do and so he was not even warmed up for the penalty shoot out. Secondly, they played with zeal. They put their hearts and soul into their defending, challenging every ball, shutting





Spain down at every opportunity. Lastly, they had the entire Russian community behind them and that support was like the twelve man on the pitch, greatly lifting the Russian team into overdrive.

So the secret to the Russian success was faith, zeal, and community, precisely the three elements of the Lasallian spirit that I am sure you are all very proud of. So dear graduates, the HKDSE results will be released on the 11th July (5 days from now). Are you nervous? Are you worried about surprises? Don't be. Life is just like football. It will be full of surprises! But as you complete your secondary school and embark on the next phase of your life journey, please take note of these lessons from the World Cup: Have faith in yourself, not just in the performance in this one set of exams, but in your overall ability, perseverance, and resilience that your school has instilled in you. Focus on the long term outcomes, not the short term goals. Have passion, or zeal, in whatever you do. Don't worry about its practicality or usefulness, because any one thing you do with passion will be of great use and benefit not just to you but to the people around you. And no matter what happens, you will have a great time!

Remember your community: treasure the friends you have made in Chan Sui Ki and continue to support one another. Let your friends be the twelve man in your team. Furthermore, remember to make community part

of your long term goal, that is, to serve the community, not because it looks good on your CV (although it does) but because you want to. It will make you a better person and give meaning to your life.

You will encounter many more tests and trials and challenges in life. The HKDSE and admission to university is just one more test and challenge and there will be many more to come. Do not rest on your laurels. Your success in life will NOT be determined by your ranking, not the ranking of your school, or your HKDSE scores, or your future academic qualifications. What counts is your faith, your zeal, and your community for support -- you need to know your strengths and weaknesses and exploit them in all your future endeavours, just like how Russia turned their weakness into strengths and exploited Spain's strengths to engineer their downfall.

Lastly, be thankful for the love and support that you have received from your friends, your teachers, your school, and from your family, and I wish you all every success in the HKDSE and beyond. May God bless you all, and bless everyone here present. Thank you.

AN INTERVIEW WITH MR. BEYNON, OUR NATIVE-SPEAKING ENGLISH TEACHER (NET)



In our interview with Mr. Beynon, we talked about his personal life, his teaching career, some advice for our boys, and his future plans.

Regarding his personal life, he said that he enjoys playing the guitar and reading detective stories, especially Sherlock Holmes. He first arrived in Hong Kong in 2002. He was surprised when he arrived as he thought Hong Kong was a big island quite some distance from the mainland. Despite not ever having tried to speak or learn Cantonese, he understands some commonly used phrases. And tries to use them to communicate with Hong Kong people. He speak slowly, a little louder than usual, repeats a lot and uses body language. Sometimes, he might seek help.

Prior to teaching in Chan Sui Ki, he taught in a coeducational school. He says that girls are much more eager to please and are tidier and neater than boys. Despite not being too keen to teach boys, he was convinced by Ms. B Chan to teach in Chan Sui Ki, where he has taught both junior and senior form students various aspects of English. Having taught senior boys for 3 years, he now works mostly with the junior forms because he thinks that junior form students need more practice in using English.

Chan Sui Ki boys are not that willing to communicate with him or other teachers in English because their conversation skills are limited. They do not like to take

risks. To improve this, Mr. Beynon suggests students invest more time absorbing themselves in English.

Mr. Beynon has also invited students to participate in the English Section in the morning assembly every Thursday. Principal Lee first came up with this idea as he wanted to provide students with an opportunity to speak in front of an audience using their 2nd language. The aim was to allow them to overcome their fear in speaking English.

Mr. Beynon has some advice on how our boys can improve their English. He suggests surfing the Internet and watching YouTube videos, in addition to reading English books, in order to increase students' exposure to English in an interesting way. Mr. Beynon thinks that proficiency in English is necessary for those who want to enter university or have a career. He reminds us that girls are improving at a tremendous rate, so boys need to work much harder to close the gap.

As for retirement plans, when the time comes, he plans to go to Northern Spain to have a quiet life. He looks forward to his bicycle around town. He aims to do all his travelling by means of the television. "It's a lot less exhausting and you can go to sleep everynight in your own bed"

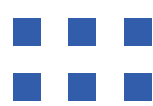

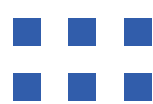

Read to Feed Reading Programme



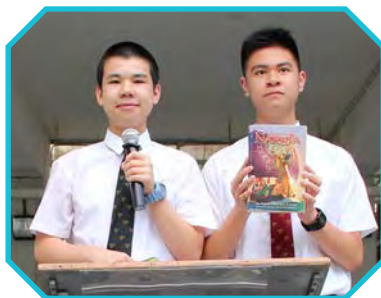
“Read to Feed” is an educational fundraising reading programme. This year, our teachers, students, and parents donated over \$12,000 to help families in need.

The Opening Mass reminded us that we should remember to praise our Father and our Founder.

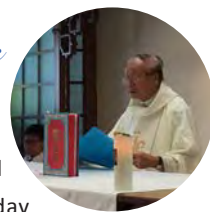
We held the Lenten Mass to commemorate the death and the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Joint School Volunteer Service (Oblate Youth Hong Kong) (16th March 2018)

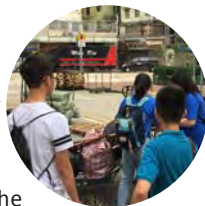

AFS EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

Interview with Benjamin Valere Bertrand Fontaine



R: In general, what is your impression of life in Hong Kong, especially your school life?

I: I find that the students in CSK are very helpful and I had a very good impression of my life in Hong Kong. With the help from the friends I have made in CSK, I have no problem in my daily life.

R: What do you think is the greatest difference between schools in Hong Kong and those in France?

I: The most significant difference between schools in Hong Kong and those in France is the school uniform, I think. While schools in Hong Kong have school uniform, there is no such thing back in France and students are allowed to dress casually. Another thing is that in Hong Kong, teachers move to different classrooms

for lessons but in France, students will change their classrooms for different lessons instead.

R: Do you think that the cultural difference between France and Hong Kong is great?

I: At first, I expected a lot of challenges. But when I arrived here, the changes were not as great as I originally expected. Food and people, for example, are not very much different from those in France. I am not too shocked by the difference.

R: What is the greatest challenge you have faced then?

I: I would say that the greatest challenge is to get along with my classmates. Back in September, frankly speaking, I didn't really know how to speak English and I found communication complicated. But thanks to my friends in CSK, I am able to learn a lot more about English and after December, I started to communicate





much better and later, I am able to make a lot of friends.

R: What is the most unforgettable moment in these few months in Hong Kong?

I: It is really hard to decide as everything is unexpected, but speaking of the most unforgettable moment, I would say it is the LYM camp in December. It was completely new to me as there is no such camp in France.

R: What have you learnt during your stay in Hong Kong?

I: Learning to communicate in English is certainly one of the things I have learnt in Hong Kong. But aside from that, I have learnt to live independently as I have to do things by myself as my parents cannot help me.

R: What is your favourite subject and your least favourite subject?

I: My favourite subjects are definitely Physical Education and English. And my least favourite subject is Mathematics as the curriculum of Hong Kong is harder

than that in France. But when I was able to catch up with the lesson, I found it pretty interesting.

R: What do you think about your host family?

I: My host family is great. They care a lot about me, but unlike most parents, they are not overly protective and I have plenty of free time. And I am able to interact with my host family a lot and we do get along well. I could even visit Beijing with them during the Easter holiday.

R: Do you miss your family back home?

I: To be honest, I miss my family and my classmates in France pretty much, but thanks to the advances in technology, I am able to chat with them online and this has helped to beat homesickness.

R: Do you have any message for CSK students?

I: I certainly do. Despite the fact that exchange students may not know how to speak English, don't be shy to talk with them. In fact, I am glad that students here love to talk with me and I find it enjoyable.

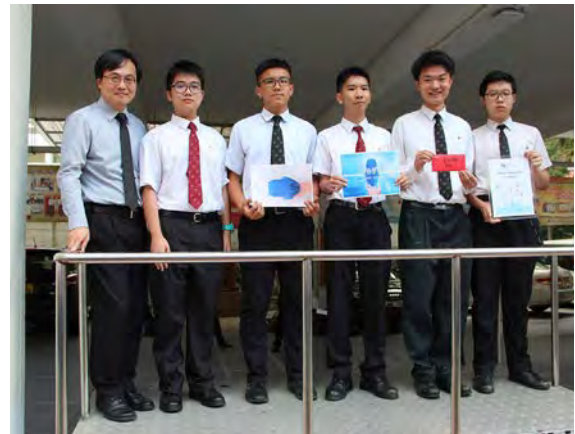

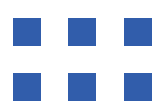

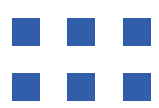

宅心仁厚 陳經綸先生訪談



校 刊編輯部於2018年1月14日陳經綸先生來校接受訪談作出感受以及記載當天的內容。

陳 經綸先生自小開始跟父親學做生意，他當時選擇承接父親的賣米事業，是因為他認為有需求才有商機。他後來以他父親的名義捐錢辦學，秉承陳瑞祺先生的精神，創辦了陳瑞祺喇沙書院。

陳 經綸先生在訪問中提到我們學校的學生很乖巧，校長和老師的教導也非常出色，令學生獲益良多。他認為「瑞祺仔」人才多，從前及將來對社會均有貢獻。陳先生不時提點學生：「讀書第一」，提點學生讀書是學生最大的責任，希望學生專心學業，千萬不要學壞，要做好人，多做善事。

在 整個訪問中，我們看得出陳經綸先生是一個虔誠的天主教教徒，他認為人一定要做好事、做好人，他的父親陳瑞祺先生也以「不做壞人」作家訓，因為他們深信上天一定會保佑好人。

陳 瑞祺先生為人嚴肅，在家管教子女亦如是，陳經綸先生指其忠孝，先父教導他們兄弟姊妹要仁義孝信兼得，待人接物都要誠



實，以誠信為本，要在能力範圍內做好事。陳經綸先生深受父親影響，時刻提醒自己做生意必定要誠實，不可以做壞事，他也以父親之名辦學，以記念父親的善德。

陳 經綸先生對善的追求，全面地反映在其子陳天賜先生身上。陳老先生指他一向無子，做善事後得陳少先生，就如上天賜給他的，因此命名天賜。

祖 業雖為米行，但陳經綸先生並無打算要求兒子承業，反讓其追尋理想，成為飛機師。陳經綸先生指時代和環境不斷變遷，祖業終有一天衰落，不如讓其兒子追求理想，追求快樂。

陳 氏父子的良好關係由此建立。不知是商人的眼光，還是自身的體悟影響，陳經綸先生沒有強迫兒子追求名成利就，反而造就出二人親密的關係。整個訪談中，由於父親聽力不佳，陳天賜先生一直作其父的傳話筒，不斷重複，不嫌其煩地向父親細心解釋。換轉別人可能因為面子的關係才故作溫馨，但我認為他們表現出來的是父子情深的表現。

最 後，陳經綸先生寄語我校友輩出，貢獻社會。祝願我校能承陳老先生貴言，發揚陳瑞祺精神。

一心同體 梁潔儀老師專訪紀錄

梁 潔儀老師在我校執教多年，曾教授眾多科目，亦培育一代又一代瑞祺學生。如今梁老師即將退休，故一眾編輯特意為梁老師進行專訪，以紀念梁老師為我校作出貢獻。以下為專訪當天之內容。

問：為何從教授經濟轉為教授宗教？

答：除了任教經濟和宗教，我亦曾任教英文，歷史，地理及綜合人文科。由於校方人手調配關係，以往教師教授的科目較多，而近年則流行「專科專教」。宗教科其實是一科比較難教的科目，而「專科專教」成效較好。宗教科不同其他科目，除了一般的教師訓練，亦需要另外的宗教訓練，天主教明愛會更有進一步的訓練給宗教科老師。此外宗教科比經濟科更缺乏人手，亦要求教師有宗教信仰，課堂不只是教導聖經的內容，更要和日常生活結合，對社會的狀況作出一個反思，雖然我本身修讀宗教教育，我亦要不斷留意周遭的事物的發展，才可配合課程的要求。

問：在教授眾多的科目中，最喜愛或是最滿意的是哪一科？

答：我比較貪心，不同的科目也想教，而每一科都有愉快和不愉快的經歷。我個人比較喜歡閱讀，自小對宗教科很有熱誠，希望可以把知識傳授給學生。其實其他科目我也教得很愉快，例如英文科教同學如何講英文，而經濟科

則希望教導同學一種思考模式，而並非純粹投機炒賣，同時亦希望同學能把經濟知識運用在社會層面，關心社會的弱勢社群，也希望同學能宏觀看社會發展的各個層面。

問：剛剛到本校任教時對於本校有何印象？

答：開始時，我剛從女校轉到本校任教，從前女校的修女有比較多規矩需要跟從，教學及舉辦宗教活動時都有很多限制。喇沙會讓我用不同的方式自由地教學，舉辦宗教活動及做更多的事，讓我去探索不同的事物。

問：任教本校多年，有沒有什麼特別的感受或經歷可以與同學分享一下？

答：我認為同學需要多努力一點，專心去做每一件事。玩固然需要，我個人也喜歡玩樂，因為玩樂中也能學習。同學要嘗試「肯捱」，捱過痛苦之後的歡樂比起表面的快樂更深刻。深刻的快樂能陪伴人一生，有效發展自己的人生，回報亦更大。同學也要花時間靜下來，聆聽自己的聲音，追尋自己的夢想。

問：以前本校學生與現今本校學生有何分別？

答：現在學生比較多元化，有不同的特質。以往一班同學的性格比較相似，容



易使用單一的教學法。現在每一班同學的特質很不同，需要探索不同的教學方法。以往的學生有活力，獨立，十分尊重老師，同時老師也十分尊重他們，他們自己能夠統籌很多活動。現今可能因時代變遷，學生多元化，有些同學比較受保護，因而未能發展自己的潛質。

問：你是否認同以往的學生雖然比較頑皮，但同時比較有實力？

答：我認為昔日瑞祺學生「玩得又讀得」，成績稍遜的同學亦能後來居上。中期有段時間比較頑皮且心散，甚至有比較抗拒宗教的同學。由於時代不同，慢慢地也有比較頑皮的同學能夠發問一些深入的宗教問題。最近的現在，情況開始有改變，很多方面已改善：我認為不同學生在不同年代有不同的文化表現。

問：在眾多的宗教工作中，為何選擇教育工作？

答：我自小受到很強的感召要成為一位教師。現在很多人受到宗教的感召，也不一定是在教會裏服務，即使是在商人，在工廠工作，還是在速食店賣麵包，這也是主所安排的事。其實可以看闊一點，始終宗教是跟生活息息

相關的，也要去關心人，例如神父會到區內跟人接觸。

問：有什麼信念使你一直堅持從事教育工作？

答：有一種很強大的感召叫我去分享，去發展生命。幫助學生的生命發展十分重要，就如在學生心裏撒種。從事教育多年，見到其他老師認為現今的學生不聽教誨，但我洞察到我們撒種的動作十分重要。不論是身教，還是課堂上教授知識，學生看是不加理會，但記憶會深深烙印在學生的腦，他們的心，他們的靈魂，直至長大後的某年某日，他也許不記得是誰傳授他的，但他會記得這段記憶和知識。宗教科老師撒種的動作，學生可能不理會，甚至討厭，在背後痛罵你，但即使學生當刻未必明白，但只要對他的生命重要便要做。曾有學生十多年後回母校感激我所教授的知識和學問，畢竟學問是需要思考的。



問：有沒有後悔任教本校？

答：與其說後悔，倒不如說掙扎。我在這所學校的際遇很奇怪，有種特別的感覚叫我總能回到這所學校去。傳播喇沙精神，宗教信仰都

令我有一種使命感，去支持這所學校的宗教發展。雖然路上有掙扎，但一直走下去使我知道這是我該走的路。

問：如何面對人生的困難和逆境？

答：人生路上總有困難，但我會靜下來，祈禱，求天主去保護，保守靈魂。我的信仰亦使我在逆境中感受到喜悅，讓我經歷主的愛，主的喜悅。我的朋友也給予我支持，我們會互相祈禱。同學要聆聽身邊的聲音，去豐富自己的資源和知識。

問：有沒有在學生身上學到什麼？

答：我在教學當中當然有辛苦，有失望，甚至有夢想破滅的時候，但學生給予我很多，有一種特別的成功感，例如看見學生在學問上的成長，令我感到喜悅。我十分重視學生的獨立思考，曾有學生在考試中失利，但依然告訴我會繼續追尋知識，讓我感到自己能成功點燃他們心中追尋知識的一團火，所以十分滿足。令我更加開心的是看見學生的成長，我曾經培訓學生由粗心大意的人轉變為獨當一面的領袖，之後跟我一起培訓新晉的教徒，這令我很有滿足感。尤其是看到每一個學生發展自己不同的潛質，展示他們有創意的一面的時候。

問：覺得自己是感性的人還是理性的人？

答：小時候我是比較感性的，但長大後我認識到一羣天主教徒的朋友，他們關心國家大事，社會現況，十分理性，我受到的衝擊很大，也影響到我變得理性。知識及學習可以從不同層面獲得及進行，學習自己不太理解的事物是一種挑戰，同學和朋友亦會影響到你，如果你能

夠把知識學以致用，你就能在你的行業開創一片新天地，所以不能只學習考試範圍內的知識，而是不斷擴大學習範圍，消化自己所學並進行創新。

問：退休後有何打算？

答：我會繼續努力讀書，吸收不同的知識，因為學海無涯。我喜歡不同的學科，我會繼續去認識很多不同的事物以及思考許多問題。我亦會發展不同的興趣，我會寫書法，同學可能不知道我會唱粵曲，跳舞我也很喜愛。舞蹈其實是以身體語言去表達自己的情感，我尤其喜愛現代舞及中國古典舞的結合。可能受我的朋友影響，加上以前我喜歡周遊列國，試過背着背包到處走，到世界各地認識不同的朋友。我們會隨心聊天，亦會定時分享學問，這些都會給我很大的啟發，例如學習如何欣賞畫作，如何理解一些深奧的理論。

問：有沒有給本校同學的勉勵說話？

答：真的要靜下來，聆聽自己內心的聲音。每一個同學也是很尊貴的，要愛惜自己，珍惜自己，要努力讀書，但是你的價值不是建基於成績之上。尋找自己的夢想不一定做一個出名的人，不要怕別人看不起你，要懂得追尋自己的理想，我相信每個人都有自己人生的感召，所以要靜下來聆聽自己內心的聲音，你會對人生路有更明確的方向。

歐舞風情 謝宏璣訪談

簡介

謝 宏璣先生是陳瑞祺（喇沙）書院一九七六年的畢業生，在八十年代初，他開始在港學習舞蹈，其後移民澳洲，至1998年初創立了專門研習匈牙利和特斯雲尼亞（Transylvania）舞蹈的「藝摯歐洲民族舞蹈組」，集編舞家、導師及舞蹈員於一身。在2018年3月，謝團長榮獲匈牙利國家邀請，於2018年5月到布達佩斯接受匈牙利國家金十字徽襟（章），以表揚他長期以來在香港積極推廣匈牙利文化。

對興趣的熱誠

謝 師兄對一位來自馬來西亞的學生，印象尤深。該位學生在一年內來了香港八次，特意向謝師兄學習了八套舞蹈。他在舞蹈中得到滿足感。謝師兄十分欣賞他對舞蹈的熱誠，覺得這麼

專注做一件事的人非常罕見。所以謝師兄當時覺得那位學生很有潛質去當團長，結果後來他真的成為了一位舞蹈團團長。



樂於聆聽

問 中謝師兄會與團員旅遊，在課餘時間與他們談天，教授舞蹈以外的知識——人生態度。他會希望學生能夠參考他所說的道理，因為有些道理是恆久不變的。如果覺得道理是正確的，就可以採納。

保持謙虛

談 到現今社會，謝師兄認為現今很多年輕人進了大學就覺得自己了不起是不對的，年輕人應該保持謙虛，多點聆聽，冷靜分析。到自己投身社會已經十年八年事後，就應該對自己有信心，否則事事謙虛，不夠堅定的話，又難以進步。

能力與責任

謝 師兄強調做人一定要有足夠的認知能力去判斷是非，要有責任去做一個正當君子。加上我們讀了那麼多書，始終都為自己行為負責，要做一個品格好的人。其次，他也認為每人都需要為這個社會作上貢獻，因為當自己在這個世界上生存了一定的日子，有一定的能力時，就應該有責任回饋這個社會，他認為自己這個說法不一定是對的，但至少會令自己快樂很多。

興趣與利益

提 到興趣方面，謝師兄以電競行業做例子，他說近年電競行業漸漸蓬勃起來，有不少年青人以打電競作職業。但他希望我們不要把功利與興趣完全掛鉤，否則自己會被利益所限而放棄不少曾經想做的事。

給學生的話

讀 書與興趣在謝師兄眼中都視為重要，他提點師弟們均衡地發展興趣和學業，認為當讀完書之後已經失去發展興趣的黃金時期，繁忙的時候就暫時放下興趣，但不要完全放棄。他以鋼琴作例子，如果你自小就學鋼琴，你可以為了準備公開考試而停止一兩年習琴，但倘若你完成中學和大學後才繼續學鋼琴，你的手指就變得僵硬，難以追回進度，到时就浪費了自己天份。他也認為有良好的時間安排可以幫助我們平衡學業及興趣。

連陳並席 連子豪老師專訪

獨 特的聲線，披上黑色西裝外套的身影，步過高年級學生的課室，遊走於三樓教員室，地理室及501室的陌生面孔。連子豪老師是我校新入職的地理科老師。短短一年間，連老師憑著精簡的筆記，對試題深入的了解，學富五車的地理知識以及生動有趣的教學方式，加上平易近人的性格及良好的師生關係，深受我學校學生的尊敬。



中學生涯

連 老師就讀觀塘瑪利諾書院，與我校同為男校。連老師回想剛升上英文中學使他更不適應，亦由於英文成績未如理想，中二時更被編入英文輔導班。當時的他與同學都不愛上課，時常在課堂聊天玩耍，對自己的成績也不甚關心。

人生轉捩

連 老師漸漸對無聊日子感到厭倦，開始發奮學習。當時連老師的地理科謝老師經常在課堂上寫下重點，連老師則把重點製作成筆記，在考試前重溫一遍，於期中考試奪得地理科全級首名，自此連老師重拾希望，專注在地理科的學習，使他在會考及高考地理學科考試中奪得最理想成績。

大學生活

高 考過後，連老師到香港大學修讀地理。當時畢業要求為三年來修讀八個課程，但連老師修讀21個課程，看見連老師對地理的熱愛。在他修讀的21個地理課程中，20個為自然地理，只有一個為人文地理。老師指比起主觀的人文地理，他更喜愛客觀的自然地理，加上自己喜作「分數奴隸」，自然偏向選擇自己熟悉和容易掌握的自然地理。在所有自然地理

課程中，連老師均以最高級別通過考核，更獲獎學金資助。

投身教育

畢 業後，連老師首先到英皇教育日校教授會考及高考地理，但在知曉自己水平不足後，隨即到香港中文大學修讀地球系統科學碩士課程，兩年後修畢課程，之後到新法書院就任地理科科主任，教授文憑試課程。隨著新法書院停辦及由於時代變遷，未有修讀教育文憑的連老師只好回到香港大學就任助教。老師指雖然助教的待遇好，同事相處融洽，但終日在書桌前不見天地地批改學生的作業，工作性質沉悶，因此一年後便離職，嘗試到其他中學任教，輾轉便來到我院校任教。

任教瑞祺

連 老師在我校前曾到不同學校任教，見識不同學校的校風。連老師坦言雖然不忘如天堂般的新法書院，但我校也屬伊甸園。由於中學就讀男校，因此很快適應在我校的生活。連老師指在我校工作，同事間相處融洽，合作愉快，上司亦對他不薄，事事以解決問題為首要目標，加上得到信任，覺得能在我校工作是一種福份。

瑞祺學生

連

老師指我校學生有禮，且尊師重道。連老師坦言我校學生均有潛質，是可造之才，唯獨欠缺一份努力。連老師一再贊我學生對他好，使他能夠教學順心，也是一種福份。

西裝情懷

連

老師慣常穿着一件黑色西裝外套，不論聖誕音樂會，陸運會，水運會，甚至平日上課日子皆如是。連老師解釋原因有二：一，懶。連老師自己平常將日常用品都放在西裝外套的口袋中，加上上班時較晚出門，故出門前隨手披上外套便輕鬆上班。二，身體差。連老師指自己身體狀況欠佳，怕冷怕病，因此必定要有西裝外套護身。

目標與夢想

連

老師指兒時自己並無夢想，加上家庭並無施加壓力，目標亦只於高考及會考的好成績，直至中六中七時才有志投身教育工作。連老師認為好老師對學生極其重要，好老師能改變學生的命運，加上連老師的興趣是製作及修改筆記，因此更加強他對從事教學的熱衷。

教學原則

連

老師指他比較自由開放，因此上堂規矩不多，同時歡迎學生任意討論。老師影響學生一生，所以連老師堅守以他所知範圍內

絕不能出錯，同時教授知識要比考試合格多，最少足夠學生奪五等級以上。雖然連老師指自己不會教授考試範圍外的知識，但若有關課題有助學生理解考試考核的知識，即使不在範圍內也會教授。另外，連老師指政治黑暗且無分對錯，他不建議學生接觸政治，因此上堂時也盡量不提及。連老師認為教育工作最重要「有料」，以免誤人子弟，同時要「有心」，因為要對學生和家長負責。

教育與未來

連

老師直言不看好香港的教育制度。連老師2008年入職，指教育界生態改變大，也曾有不愉快的經歷。以前，教師比較着重教學，教好學生為首要，但現在增添各類行政工作，使教學的重心轉移。亦因對政治前景的憂慮，連老師討厭社會把教師政治化。以往只要有實力，有熱誠就可投身教育工作，現今着重資格，實力反而不再是最重要的一環，也使到教師的生存空間收窄。基於性質不同，連老師亦不同意把高考制度改變為文憑試制度。

老師寄語

連

老師指陳瑞祺的學生底子不差，勤力一定做得到，要給自己一點信心。「成績固然重要，人品更加緊要」，連老師指做人要坦蕩蕩，不要做偽君子，要做到做事認真，對人寬大，能珍惜大家之間的緣份就最好。

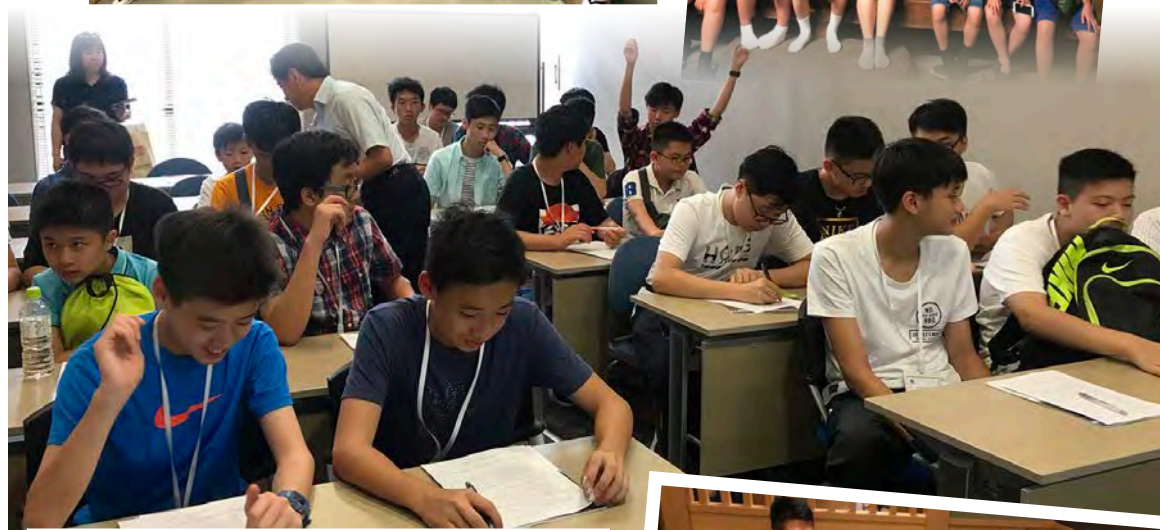




日本關西歷史文化藝術遊學

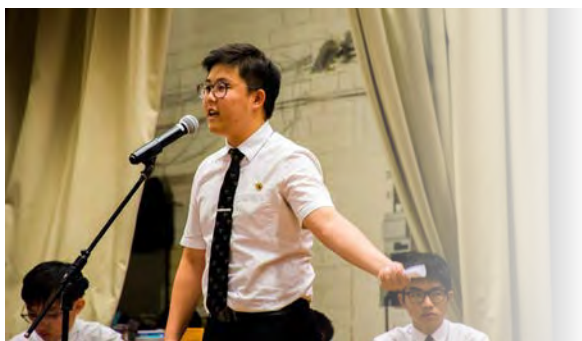


班際辯論比賽

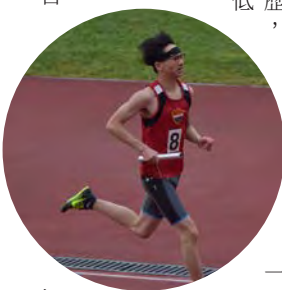


田徑奇妙之處

童軍運動亦是一個國際性的活動，過去一

為紀念白浪島實驗營的111週年及世界童軍成立110週年，本旅特於二〇一八年七月二十八日至八月五日遠赴英國，舉辦為期九天之「尋找貝登堡足跡」之旅及相關之交誼活動，期間亦會拜

訪貝登堡故居，前往倫敦市郊童軍訓練營地：基維爾營地，童軍運動發源地：白浪島及格林威治子午線，大英博物館和自然歷史博物館等；有關活動不但能探古尋源，更能令各成員溫故知新，啟發未來。
