## The English Learning Centre

The English Learning Centre is run by Mr. A. Beynon, (NET), and is designed to give our students the opportunity to practise their English in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere.

## New Senior Secondary Curriculum

Preparation for the implementation of the New Senior Secondary Curriculum is well under way. Apart from offering the core subjects that students have to take, our school will provide a choice of ten elective subjects which cover a wide range of interest and cater for various career needs. These elective subjects include Chinese History, Chinese Literature, Economics, Geography, History, Business, Accounting and Financial Studies (BAFS), Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Information and Communication Technology (ICT). Students will be required to take four elective subjects in SS1 and two to three elective ones in SS2 and SS3 depending on their academic ability and interest.
