# Chan Sui Ki (La Salle) College Launching the Golden Jubilee Fund

Chan Sui Ki (La Salle) College is going to celebrate its 50th Anniversary in the 2019/20 school year. I am delighted to announce the launch of the Chan Sui Ki (La Salle) College Golden Jubilee Fund. The goal is to raise \$20 million by the year 2020. The \$20 million target sounds like a lot but we would like to think of it as being like a climbing wall with 2,000 rungs worth \$10,000 each.

As a school established by the De La Salle Brothers in 1969, CSK's mission has thrived on providing a human and Christian education to young people, especially the poor. CSK does not have a large endowment or legacy which can fund school projects. Being an aided school, CSK's finances are mostly dependent on the government. While the government funds do sustain the operational needs, they do not cover the costs of the special projects we have identified to improve the learning environment of CSK.

We hope to equip CSK with adequate resources to improve the quality of teaching and learning and to improve the school facilities. This appeal for bona fide donations from old boys, parents and other stakeholders is essential if CSK is to maintain its status as a school of excellence.



### **Naming Rights**


As a way of recognising donors who contribute generously to the **CSK Golden Jubilee Fund**, the Incorporated Management Committee of the school has kindly consented to name certain parts of the school facilities after prominent donors. A donation may be made as an individual or group such as "Class of 19XX/ 20XX". These are great opportunities for you to put your name on the school premises and show your support. Below is a provisional list of school facilities available for the purpose of naming rights.

- Classroom Block, Special Room Block
- Special rooms e.g. English Centre, Laboratories, Library, Lecture Room and Conference Room etc.
- Playground, covered playground

#### Terms and conditions

Donors should complete the full pledged donations for naming rights within the agreed time frame.

Names proposed for specific school facilities have to be approved by the Incorporated Management Committee of the school.



## **Alternative Donation Options**

You can give a generic donation to the CSK Golden Jubilee Fund or alternatively you may specify the use of your donations. For this purpose, we have drawn up a list of project-specific donation options for your consideration.

Strategic planning over the past few years has identified the following projects to be undertaken to improve the school's resources in line with the vision to maintain CSK's status as a school of excellence.

#### Recurrent expenses per year

Target	Amount
Employing a native English-speaking teacher or Joining the Chatteris Native- speaking English Tutor (CNET) placement programme	HK\$500,000.00
Employing two associate teachers to support teaching and learning of English Language and Chinese Language	HK\$600,000.00

#### **Non-recurrent expenses**

Target	Amount
Renovating the school library	HK\$600,000.00
Replacing the computers in the classrooms and special rooms	HK\$300,000.00
Replacing the school chapel	HK\$300,000.00
Replacing the stage lighting and lifting system of the school hall	HK\$1,250,000.00
Replacing the school hall sound system	HK\$400,000.00
