**General Instructions of Mock Examination 2024 – 2025**

1. No ball games are allowed during the test/ exam period.
2. All desks must be cleared of books, notes etc. on or before 15 Jan.
3. All students should arrive at school at or before 7:55 am during the test/ exam period. You are required to switch off your mobile phone before entering the school campus.  
  
*\*In case you do not need to attend the first exam session on any day, you should arrive at the campus 30 minutes before the starting time of the second exam session.*
4. Fifteen minutes before the start of each test/ exam session, students should follow the instructions of the teacher-in-charge to proceed to the test/ examination room.
5. Once you enter the test/ examination room, you should put your mobile phone, smart watch and tablet under your chair.
6. You are not allowed to use erasable ball pens in tests/ examinations.
7. Do not leave the campus until you complete the last test/ exam session of each day.
8. In case school is closed on any day during the test/ exam period because of bad weather conditions, the tests/ examinations held that day will be postponed as follows. The rest of the tests/ examinations will be held as originally scheduled.
